The Moodle-based LMS used by BML Munjal University fully complies with UGC parameters for online programme delivery. It offers an intuitive, mobile-responsive interface with multi-device access, secure cloud storage, and rich multimedia content. Features include live classes, discussion forums, interactive assessments, learning analytics, peer-group collaboration, and mentor support. The system provides dashboards for students, faculty, and administrators, along with Al/human-based online proctoring, plagiarism checks, and secure payment integration. It supports the four-quadrant SWAYAM model, adaptive learning, and scalable cloud architecture. CIQA oversees quality assurance through periodic reviews, training, feedback, and MIS reporting, ensuring regulatory compliance and academic rigor.

Assessment mechanism

The BMU Online LMS follows a UGC-compliant 30–70 assessment framework ensuring continuous and summative evaluation. Continuous Assessment (30%) includes assignments, quizzes, forum participation, and projects, supported by automated quizzes, rubric-based grading, and plagiarism checks. End-semester exams (70%) are conducted through secure, Al-assisted online proctoring with locked browsers, identity verification, session recording, and timed auto-submission. Question banks, randomization, and evaluator review ensure fairness. The gradebook displays continuous assessment scores, exam marks, weighted averages, GPA, and question-wise performance. Strict academic integrity protocols, re-evaluation mechanisms, and complete transparency ensure rigorous, credible assessment aligned with UGC norms.
