This notice is in connection to the notice dated July 14, 2025 published in the University of Calcutta website regarding Advertisement for the Enrolment to Ph.D. Programme in the Department of Buddhist Studies, University of Calcutta 2025.

Details of the Entrance Test are given below:

- 1) The Written Examination of Two-hour duration shall comprise 30 Multiple Choice Type Questions of 1 mark each and an essay of 20 marks, from the core and allied subjects prescribed for CU MA Buddhist Studies Syllabus. There will be no negative marking.
- 2) Long Questions and MCQ would be based on the general theme of the Buddhist Studies.
- 3) Qualifying marks for Entrance Test will be 50%.
- 4) Successful candidates in the written examination will be called for an interview of 50 marks.
- 5) Candidates who have already passed NET/ SET/ MPhil examinations/ obtained DST-INSPIRE Fellowship or under Teacher Fellowship can directly appear in the interview skipping the written examination.
- 6) Interview of the eligible candidates would take place in the office of the Buddhist Studies 2nd Floor Chatra Bhawan on 28th August 2025 at 1.00 pm. Candidates must produce a well-structured research Proposal during the interview (not more than 1500 words or four A4-size papers).
- 7) The list of qualified candidates for enrolment to the Ph.D. Programme would be displayed on the Departmental Notice Board as well as on the University website by the 15th September 2025.

Relevant National/State Reservation policy shall be strictly followed.
