Ph.D. Programme in Hindi, 2026

Applications are invited for admission to the Ph.D. programme in Hindi, University of Calcutta for the session 2026. Reservation of SC/ST/PH/OBC etc. will be as per 100 points roster and applicable as per the rules of the "West Bengal Higher Education Institutions (reservation in admission) rules.

Eligibility Criteria

Candidates having MA in Hindi with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (relaxation will be given as per norms) are eligible to apply. Admission to the Ph.D. programme will be done through a Research Eligibility Test (RET) followed by an interview. However candidates exempted from the RET are required to appear for the interview only.

Details about RET

The list of eligible candidates to appear in the Written Research Eligibility Test (RET) will be notified on notice board of Room no. 216 on 17.04.2026. The RET will be held on 21.04.2026 Time: 1:00- 3:00pm, Duration: 2:00 hrs. Marks: 50 Candidates must obtain qualifying marks-50% for General category and 45% for SC/ST category to qualify for interview. The venue of the RET is the classroom of the Department of Hindi, Room number- 316, 2nd Floor, Asutosh Building, Asutosh Shiksha Prangan, 87/1, College Street Kolkata-700073).

Research Eligibility Test (RET) Exemption

Candidates with MA in Hindi / Hindi with M.Phil or NET/SET/SLET are exempted from RET. All other candidates are required to appear for the RET.
