It is notified for information of all concerned that the Syndicate in its meeting held on 19.05.2025 approved and confirmed by the Syndicate dated 16.05.2025, Vide Item no.33, approved the matter regarding 5 year B.A. LL.B., 5 year B.A. LL.B.(Honours) courses and the following measures to address the following issue:

1. Issues:

- (a) Admission without the approval of the Bar Council of India since 2018.
- (b) Mid-Semester transfer of Students – the Department of Law has been allowing students to take admission in the 6th semester, through fresh admission notification which is against University Policy.

2. Decisions adopted by the Syndicate:

- (a) From the session 2024-2025 no fresh admission in the 6th semester will be allowed.
- (b) The students who qualify for Honours in the 5th semester will be allowed to take the 6th semester at their respective colleges and the department of Law, University of Calcutta subject to the following conditions:

- Affiliation of Honours Courses: The Colleges and Department of Law must have been granted affiliation for Honours course by the Bar Council of India (BCI).
- Eligibility Criteria: Students must meet the eligibility criteria set by the University and BCI for pursuing Honours Courses.

The above shall be effective from the academic session 2025-2026.

It is notified for information of all concerned that the Syndicate in its meeting held on 19.05.2025 approved and confirmed by the Syndicate dated 16.05.2025, Vide Item no.32, has adopted the following decisions in the matter of granting yearly affiliation for all Law Colleges including the Department of Law to ensure compliance with the regulation of the Bar Council of India (BCI) the proposals of the concerned section run as follows:

1. The law entrance test for admission to Law Colleges and the Calcutta University Law Department shall not be held until the yearly affiliation renewal process with BCI is completed.
2. A policy shall be framed that the Department of Law under University of Calcutta must obtain permission from the University before conducting admission test in every academic year:

To obtain the necessary permission, the following steps may be taken as proposed:

- Yearly Affiliation with Bar Council of India (BCI) :

Must obtain a copy of the affiliation letter with the BCI from all Law Colleges including the Department also.

- Permission from the University:

Submit those copies of the affiliation with the BCI to the University in every academic year & obtain permission to conduct the admission test.

3. All affiliated Law Colleges and Department under University must complete the affiliation renewal process with the BCI before the Law entrance test is conducted.

The above shall be accepted and approved from the academic session 2025-2026.
