Centre for Translation and Literary Geography, University of Calcutta, invites applications for the appointment of Project Fellows under the **Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR)-ERC**, sponsored project, entitled, "**Translating and Documenting Toto Cultural Texts**".

Project Director: Dr. Mrinmoy Pramanick, Founder Coordinator, Centre for Translation and Literary Geography, University of Calcutta.

Details of the Vacancy, Qualification, and Emoluments: Project Fellow - Two (2). Candidates with MA in any Humanities/ Social Science subjects with minimum 55% marks in aggregate are eligible to apply for the posts. Candidates with prior experience of field work and knowledge of digital archiving and computer applications will be preferred. Candidates are required to have very good communication skills in Bangla and writing skill in Bangla and English.

Monthly fellowship is 12,000/- (Twelve Thousands Only) per month. All the posts are purely temporary in nature and recruitment will happen initially for two months likely to be extended for one month or more and so on based on the availability of funds and/or performance of the research staff. TA/DA will be provided to the Project Fellows if they require to leave the station for project related works. No other allowances are admissible.

Candidates are required to submit a covering letter along with their latest updated CVs with one passport size photograph during the time of interview. As this is a walk-in interview there is no provision for submission of early application. The Project Director reserves the right to increase or decrease the number of research staff and in absence of competent candidates the position may be converted into hired services mode.

Date and Time of Personal Interview: Walk-in interview will happen on 8th August, 2025, at 12:30 pm, at the Room No. 122, office of the Centre for Translation and Literary Geography, Ground Floor, Asutosh Building, College Street Campus, University of Calcutta.
