Engagement of Additional Research Fellows (Category–II)

Applications are invited from eligible candidates of the University of Calcutta for engagement as **Additional Research Fellows (Category–II)** under **RUSA 2.0 (Component–10)** in the thematic areas of **CenSISA (Centre for Scientific Innovations and Societal Applications)** and **CPH (Centre for Public Humanities)**.

Category–II: PhD Registered / PhD Awarded Candidates

Eligibility

Applicants must satisfy the following conditions:

1. Be registered for the PhD programme of the University of Calcutta and have completed the PhD registration process; **or**
2. Have already been awarded a PhD degree by the University of Calcutta, subject to the requirements of the concerned thematic area.
3. Not be receiving any fellowship, scholarship, assistantship or financial support from UGC, CSIR, DST, DBT, ICSSR, ICMR, INSPIRE, PMRF or any other funding agency.
4. Submit an undertaking declaring that they are not availing, and shall not avail, any fellowship during the tenure of engagement under RUSA 2.0.

Fellowship

Selected candidates will receive a fellowship of **₹32,000/- (Rupees Thirty-Two Thousand only)** per month, subject to the availability of the fund.

Tenure of Engagement

The engagement shall be **purely temporary and project-based** under **RUSA 2.0 (Component–10)** for the period: **08th July 2026 to 30 September 2026**

Continuation during the tenure shall be subject to:

- Satisfactory performance;
- Regular attendance; and
- Submission of monthly progress reports through the concerned Thematic Area Coordinators and RUSA 2.0 Campus In-charges.

The engagement may be terminated at any stage in case of unsatisfactory performance, misconduct, suppression of facts, or closure/completion of the project. The engagement shall not confer any claim for regular appointment, absorption or continuation beyond the approved project period.

Number of Positions

Additional Category–II Research Fellows will be engaged in various thematic areas of CenSISA and CPH depending upon project requirements and availability of approved positions.

Selection Procedure

Selection will be made through a **Walk-in Interview/Interaction** before a duly constituted Selection Committee.

The recommendations of the Selection Committee shall be placed before the competent University authority for approval.
