Centre for Translation and Literary Geography, University of Calcutta, invites applications for the appointment of Research Staffs under the **Indian Council of Social Science Research (ICSSR)**, Odisha Centre sponsored grant under the scheme of “Multi-Disciplinary Studies on Particularly Vulnerable Tribal Groups (PVTGs) of India (2024-25)”, for the two years long project entitled, **"Community Partnership-Based Research on the Lodha Community in West Bengal and Odisha: Advancing Sustainable Development, Language Documentation and Policy Formulation"**.

For all the above mentioned positions candidates from the Lodha community will be given preferences and in exceptional cases desirable qualification may be relaxed. All the posts are purely temporary in nature and recruitment will happen initially for three months for the position of Research Associate and Assistant, and for two months for the position of Field Investigators, likely to be extended for one month or more and so on based on the availability of funds and/or performance of the research staff. TA/DA will be provided to the research staff if they require to leave the station for project related works. No other allowances are admissible. Candidates in service or enrolled in any degree programme at any institution must submit a No Objection Certificate from the concerned authority during the time of personal interview. Interviews will happen in person mode, however, candidates from the Lodha community may be interviewed in online mode based on their request. The Project Director reserves the right to increase or decrease the number of research staff and in absence of competent candidates the position may be converted into hired services mode.

Date and Time of Submission of Application: Eligible and interested candidates are requested to send a covering letter and detailed Curriculum Vitae to ctlg@caluniv.ac.in with email subject “Application for Research Staff, ICSSR-PVTGs”, on or before 11:59 pm on 22nd May, 2025. Any application incomplete or received after the due date will be summarily rejected. The Cover letter should be addressed to the Project Director and the candidate should mention the position/s they are applying for. However, candidates must submit one copy of complete application profile with a covering letter, curriculum vitae and all the relevant marksheets and certificates duly signed by the candidates, and one recent passport size photograph at the reporting time on the day of interview at the office of the Centre for Translation and Literary Geography, at the Room No. 112, Ground Floor, Ashutosh Building, University of Calcutta, 87/1 College Street, Kolkata- 700073; failing which the candidature will be summarily rejected.
