Submission Guidelines

- Abstracts must be original, unpublished, and not under consideration elsewhere, in English, including a brief introduction, objectives, methodology, key findings/arguments, and reference (as per APA style 7th ed.), with a word limit of 1200.
- The abstract must be accompanied by 4–5 keywords and the author(s)' name(s), institutional affiliation, designation, and contact details (email and mobile number).
- Co-authorship is permitted up to a maximum of three authors per paper; each participant may submit only one paper as first author.
- Abstracts must be submitted in MS Word format (Font style: Times New Roman, Size: 12 pt, line spacing: 1.5) with the subject line: 'Abstract Submission – International Conference 2026' to intconfecon2026@gmail.com
