Eligibility criteria for admission to the M.Phil. programme: 2.1 Candidates for admission to the M.Phil. programme shall have a Master's degree or a professional degree declared equivalent to the Master's degree by the corresponding statutory regulatory body, with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) or an equivalent degree from a foreign educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any	Adopted for all M.Phil programmes

	other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions. 2.2 A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC (non-creamy layer)/Differently-Abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time, or for those who had obtained their Master's degree prior to 19th September, 1991. The qualifying degree marks of 55% (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and the relaxation of 5% to the categories mentioned above are permissible based only on the qualifying degree marks without including the grace mark procedures. Eligibility criteria for admission to Ph.D. programme: Subject to the conditions stipulated in these Regulations, the following persons are eligible to seek admission to the Ph.D. programme: 3.1 Master's Degree holders satisfying the criteria stipulated under Clause 2 above. 3.2 Candidates who have cleared the M.Phil. course work with at least 55% marks in aggregate or its equivalent grade 'B' in the UGC 7-point scale (or an equivalent grade in a point scale wherever grading system is followed) and successfully completing the M.Phil. Degree shall be eligible to proceed to do research work leading to the Ph. D. Degree in the same Institution <u>in an integrated programme</u>. A relaxation of 5% of marks, from 55% to 50%, or an equivalent relaxation of grade, may be allowed for those belonging to SC/ST/OBC(non-creamy layer)/differently-abled and other categories of candidates as per the decision of the Commission from time to time. 	3.3 A person whose M.Phil. dissertation has been evaluated and the viva voce is pending may be admitted to the Ph.D. programme of the same Institution; 3.4 Candidates possessing a Degree considered equivalent to M.Phil. Degree of an Indian Institution, from a Foreign Educational Institution accredited by an Assessment and Accreditation Agency which is approved, recognized or authorized by an authority, established or incorporated under a law in its home country or any other statutory authority in that country for the purpose of assessing, accrediting or assuring quality and standards of educational institutions, shall be eligible for admission to Ph.D. programme.	, from a Foreign Educational Institution for admission to Ph.D. programmes.
4. 5	Procedure for admission:	

	5.1 All Universities and Institutions Deemed to be Universities shall admit M.Phil /Ph.D. students through an Entrance Test conducted at the level of Individual University/Institution Deemed to be a University. The University /Institution Deemed to be a University may decide separate terms and conditions for Ph.D. Entrance Test for those students who qualify UGC-NET (including JRF) / UGC- CSIR NET (including JRF) /SLET/GATE/teacher fellowship holder or have passed M.Phil programme. Similar approach may be adopted in respect of Entrance Test for M.Phil programme. 5.2 Higher Educational Institutions (HEIs) referred to in sub-clause 1.2 above and Colleges under them which are allowed to conduct M.Phil. and/or Ph.D. programmes, shall: 5.2.1 Decide on an annual basis through their academic bodies a predetermined and manageable number of M.Phil. and/or Ph.D. scholars to be admitted depending on the number of available Research Supervisors and other academic and physical facilities available, keeping in mind the norms regarding the scholar- teacher ratio (as indicated in Para 6.5), laboratory, library and such other facilities; 5.2.2 notify well in advance in the institutional website and through advertisement in at least two (2) national newspapers, of which at least one (1) shall be in the regional language, the number of seats for admission, subject/discipline-wise distribution of available seats, criteria for admission, procedure for admission, examination centre(s) where entrance test(s) shall be conducted and all other relevant information for the benefit of the candidates;	Adopted. The external supervisors are not allowed. However, Co- Supervisor can be allowed in inter-disciplinary areas from other departments of the same institute or from other related institutions with the approval of the Research Advisory Committee. 6.3 The allocation of Research Supervisor for a selected research scholar shall be decided by the Department concerned depending on the number of scholars per Research Supervisor, the available specialization among the Supervisors and research interests of the scholars as indicated by them at the time of interview /viva voce. 6.4 In case of topics which are of inter-disciplinary nature where the Department concerned feels that the expertise in the Department has to be supplemented from outside, the Department may appoint a Research Supervisor from the Department itself, who shall be known as the Research Supervisor, and a Co-Supervisor from outside the Department/ Faculty/College/Institution on such terms and conditions as may be specified and agreed upon by the consenting Institutions/Colleges. 6.5 A Research Supervisor/Co-supervisor who is a Professor, at any given point of time, cannot guide more than three (3)<u>M.Phil. and Eight (8) Ph.D. scholars.</u> An Associate Professor as Research Supervisor can guide up to a maximum of two (2) M.Phil. and six (6) Ph.D. scholars and an Assistant Professor as Research Supervisor can guide up to a maximum of one (1) M.Phil. and four (4) Ph.D. scholars. 6.6 In case of relocation of an M.Phil/ Ph.D. woman scholar due to marriage or otherwise, the research data shall be allowed to be transferred to the University	Only regular Fulltime regular Faculty/Scientists of External Centres will be Co-Supervisors only. 7	Course Work: Credit Requirements, number, duration, syllabus, minimum standards for completion, etc. 7.1 The credit assigned to the M.Phil. or Ph.D. course work shall be a minimum of 08 credits and a maximum of 16 credits. 7.2 The course work shall be treated as prerequisite for M.Phil./Ph.D. preparation. A minimum of four credits shall be assigned to one or more courses on Research Methodology which could cover areas such as quantitative methods, computer applications, research ethics and review of published research in the relevant field, training, field work, etc. Other courses shall be advanced level courses preparing the students for M.Phil./Ph.D. degree. 7.3 All courses prescribed for M.Phil. and Ph.D. course work shall be in conformity with the credit hour instructional requirement and shall specify content, instructional and assessment methods. They shall be duly approved by the authorized academic bodies. 7.4 The Department where the scholar pursues his/her research shall prescribe the course(s) to him/her based on the recommendations of the Research Advisory Committee, as stipulated under sub-Clause 8.1 below, of the research scholar. 	7.5 All candidates admitted to the M.Phil. and Ph.D. programmes shall be required to complete the course work prescribed by the Department during the initial one or two semesters. 7.6 Candidates already holding M. Phil. degree and admitted to the Ph.D. programme, or those who have already completed the course work in M.Phil. and have been permitted to proceed to the Ph.D. in integrated course, may be exempted by the Department from the Ph.D. course work. 8	Research Advisory Committee and its functions: 8.1 There shall be a Research Advisory Committee, or an equivalent body for similar purpose as defined in the Statutes/Ordinances of the Institution concerned, for each M.Phil. and Ph.D. scholar. 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	9.6 The M.Phil. dissertation submitted by a research scholar shall be evaluated by his/her Research Supervisor and at least one external examiner who is not in the employment of the Institution/College. The viva-voce examination, based among other things, on the critiques given in the evaluation report, shall be conducted by both of them together, and shall be open to be attended by Members of the Research Advisory Committee, all faculty members of the Department, other research scholars and other interested experts/ researchers. 9.7 The Ph.D. thesis submitted by a research scholar shall be evaluated by his/her Research Supervisor and at least two external examiners, who are not in employment of the Institution/College, of whom one examiner may be from outside the country. The viva-voce examination, based among other things, on the critiques given in the evaluation report, shall be conducted by the Research Supervisor and at least one of the two external examiners, and shall be open to be attended by Members of the Research Advisory Committee, all faculty members of the Department, other research scholars and other interested experts/researchers. 9.8 the evaluation report(s) of the external examiner(s) on the dissertation/thesis is/are satisfactory and include a specific recommendation for conducting the viva-voce examination. If the evaluation report of the external examiner in case of M.Phil. dissertation, or one of the evaluation reports of the external examiner in case of Ph.D. thesis, is unsatisfactory and does not recommend viva-voce, the Institution shall send the dissertation/ thesis to another external examiner out of the approved panel of examiners and the viva-voce examination shall be held only if the report of the latest examiner is satisfactory. If the report of the latest examiner is also unsatisfactory, the dissertation/ thesis shall be rejected and the research scholar shall be declared ineligible for the award of the degree. 	13.1 Following the successful completion of the evaluation process and before the announcement of the award of the M.Phil./Ph.D. degree(s), the Institution concerned shall submit an electronic copy of the M.Phil. dissertation /Ph. D. thesis to the INFLIBNET, for hosting the same so as to make it accessible to all Institutions/Colleges. 13.2 Prior to the actual award of the degree, the degree-awarding Institution shall issue a provisional Certificate to the effect that the Degree has been awarded in accordance with the provisions of these UGC Regulations, 2016. 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In addition to the above, the following regulations shall govern the M.Phil/Ph.D. courses of study:

Attendance:

A student shall be deemed to have pursued a regular course of study in a subject provided that he has attended atleast 75% of the classes actually held in each subject and do to the satisfaction of the School/Department/Centre, such seminars, sessional and practicals as may be prescribed.

Provided that the Dean of the School concerned on the recommendation of the Head of the Department/Centre may condone the shortage in attendance not exceeding 5 per cent for valid and convincing reasons.

Provided further that students deputed by the University to take part in the extra co-curricular events be given a concession of upto 5% attendance, if necessary, in addition to the relaxations in the attendance requirement as provided above. Such concession would be available for the days of actual participation in the event, including journey time with the prior approval of D.S.W.

Ph.D. Programmes

1. The qualifications and other conditions for admission to a course of research leading to the Degree of Doctor of Philosophy (Ph.D) shall be as approved by the Academic Council from time to time.
2. The procedure for receiving applications for admission to the course shall be laid down from time to time by the University.
3. The School/Department/Centre concerned shall appoint a teacher of the University as a Supervisor or Supervisor (s) to guide and supervise the work of the candidate within a month of his/her admission. The School Board shall ratify the recommendation of appointment of supervisor(s) in the immediate ensuing meeting. Provided that the School Board may, on the recommendation of the School/Department/ Centre concerned, appoint joint supervisors in any particular case.
4. School Board shall on the recommendation of the School/Department/Centre concerned approve the topic of the proposed thesis leading to the award of the Ph.D degree.
5. Immediately after the admission of the candidate/s for Ph.D course, the School/Department/Centre concerned shall constitute a 'Research Advisory Committee' for each of the candidates admitted and put forth the same for approval of the School Board. The Committee shall consist of three members with the Supervisor of the student as Convener.
6. The Doctoral Committee will be responsible (i) to endure periodically that the candidate's work is progressing satisfactorily, and (ii) to prescribe necessary course work that the candidate may have to take.
7. No candidate admitted to a full time course of research for the Ph.D degree shall undertake any employment while being on rolls of the University.
8. The School Board may cancel the admission of a candidate for a breach of the clause 7 or on account of his unsatisfactory progress, in the manner prescribed by regulations.
9. A candidate shall submit his thesis for the Ph.D degree in the manner prescribed by Regulations. Any original paper (s) pertaining to the area of specialization published by the candidate during the course of work leading to the Ph.D degree and/or the dissertation submitted by him for the Master of Philosophy degree may be submitted as subsidiary or supporting material in favour of his candidature for the award of Ph.D degree.

10. The thesis submitted by the candidate for the award of the Ph.D degree shall be examined by three examiners consisting of the Supervisor of the candidate and two external examiners not in the service of the University, to be appointed by the Academic Council and the Executive Council on the recommendation of the School Board of the School.
11. Each examiner after examining the thesis submitted by the candidate for the award of the Ph.D degree, shall submit a report containing a clear recommendation whether, in his opinion:
 - a) the VIVA VOCE examination of the candidate should be held; or
 - b) the thesis should be referred back to the candidate for revision; or
 - c) it should be rejected.
12. A student whose thesis has been sent back by one of the examiners for revision is required to revise the thesis in the light of the concerned examiner's report. Such revision is to be carried out by the student in consultation with his/her supervisor/s.
13. A thesis which has been re-submitted shall normally be examined by the original examiners unless any one of them is, or both of them are, unable or unwilling to act as such, in which case another examiner(s) may be appointed.
14. No candidate shall be permitted to re-submit his thesis for the award of the Ph.D degree for more than once.
15. The VIVA VOCE examination of the candidate shall be conducted by a Board comprising of the following members :
 - i The Head of the Department/Centre or the Dean of the School (if there is no Head of the Department/Centre).
 - ii Supervisor of the student

Note: In case the supervisor is the Head of the Department/Centre or the Dean of the School, there will be one member less in the viva voce board.

iii Two external examiners – atleast one of them should be present for the Viva Voce.

Note: a) In case neither of the external examiners is able to conduct the Viva Voce, another examiner shall be appointed in his place.

b) In view of the existing financial constraints only one of the Indian external examiners (where both examiners are from India) may be invited for conducting the Viva voce examination. The Vice-Chancellor was authorized to approve the name of the examiner for conducting the Viva-Voce from the approved panel of examiners at the time of fixing the examiners for evaluation of thesis. (AC: date 19.4.1993 item 5.9)

16. a. At the VIVA VOCE examination, the Viva Voce Board shall satisfy itself :

i that the thesis submitted by the candidate is his own work; and

ii that the grasp of the candidate of the broad field of his study is satisfactory

b The VIVA VOCE Board may on the basis of the unanimous opinion recommend either:

i that the candidate be awarded the Ph.D degree OR

ii that the candidate may appear for the VIVA VOCE examination again after a stipulated time.

17. The manner in which the VIVA VOCE examination is to be conducted shall be prescribed by the VIVA VOCE Board itself.

18. In case the School Board is satisfied that the VIVA VOCE Board recommend that the candidate be awarded the Ph. D degree it shall recommend to the Academic Council that the Ph.D degree may be awarded to the candidate.

- b) In case the Viva Voce Board's recommendation is for re appearing of the candidate for the Viva Voce examination after a stipulated period, the School Board may consider this recommendation and advise the candidate accordingly.
- 19. A member of the teaching staff of the University may submit his thesis for the award of the Ph.D degree of the University in the following manner :
 - i) He shall intimate to the School/Department/Centre the topic of his research work leading to the award of the Ph.D degree;
 - ii) If the School/Department/Centre concerned is satisfied that :
 - a. research on one proposed topic can be profitably pursued, and
 - b. research work can be suitably undertaken at the University it shall:
 - c. recommend to the School Board that he may be permitted to submit his thesis for the award of the Ph.D degree of the University.
 - d. prescribe for him course or courses, if necessary, as a partial requirement for the award of the Ph.D degree, and
 - e. appoint an Supervisor to generally guide him/her in the completion of his thesis.
 - iii) The School Board if so satisfied shall permit him to submit his thesis in not less than three years from the date of his obtaining the permission to undertake research work leading to the award of the Ph.D degree.
 - iv) The VIVA VOCE Board, as provided in Clause 15, shall be the same even for the teaching staff pursuing Ph.D Degree in the University.

20. The Teaching and Evaluation Regulations of the University, as mentioned in the Prospectus shall apply to M.Phil/Ph.D. students.

मार्गदर्शक सिद्धान्त:

डिग्रियों को सामुदायिक/वर्गगत रूप से विनिर्देशित किया जाना चाहिए तथा उनकी नामावलि ऐसी हो जिसे सामान्यतः पहचाना जा सके, वैश्विक रूप से जिसे स्वीकारा जाए तथा विस्तृत रूप में स्वीकार्य है तथा जो उन डिग्रियों के स्तर को तथा प्रमुख/विषय/धारा/ज्ञान क्षेत्रों से संबन्ध विश्वविद्यालय/संस्थान पाठ्यचर्या के नवोन्मेषी रूप को सूचित करने वाली हो तथा ऐसे विश्वविद्यालय/संस्थान विनिर्देशित जातिगत/वर्गगत डिग्रियों के विरुद्ध-चाहे अनियमित रूप से ही सही अपनी अपूर्वतायुक्त/विशेषज्ञता का संकेत देने के लिए स्वतंत्र होंगे।

विश्वविद्यालय/संस्थान समेकित एवं दोहरे डिग्री पाठ्यक्रम को न्याय संगत रूप से सावधानी पूर्वक प्रस्तावित कर सकते हैं। किसी भी दोहरे पाठ्यक्रम में एक से अधिक पाठ्य विषय सम्मिलित होता है जो अधिकांशतः अनुप्रस्थ स्थिति के होते हैं। जबकि कोई भी एकीकृत पाठ्यक्रम प्रगतिशील एवं संचित (एकत्रित) होता है। ऐसे पाठ्यक्रमों को प्रस्तुत करने के पीछे जो अकादमिक विचार धारा/तर्कणा है उसका लक्ष्य पाठ्यचर्या अनिवार्यताओं को संक्षिप्त करना अथवा गतिशीलता के आधार पर दोहरी डिग्रियाँ प्रदान करना नहीं होना चाहिए तथा उसके विपरीत किसी भी एकीकृत दृष्टिकोण को ऊर्ध्वाधार/अन्तर विषयक लेखा विवरण से संलिप्त रहना चाहिए। किसी भी दोहरी डिग्री का बहु आयामी परिप्रेक्ष्य में सम्बद्ध अध्ययन विषयों का अधिक श्रेष्ठ विस्तार होना चाहिए। इस प्रक्रिया/विचारणा के अन्तर्गत यदि इसके अधिक न भी हो तथापि इसके समान ही पाठ्यचर्या अवधि एवं पाठ्यचर्या सम्प्रेषण के नवीन दृष्टिकोण होंगे। अतः दो या दो से अधिक अध्ययन विषयों को संयोजित करने वाले एकीकृत/दोहरे डिग्री पाठ्यक्रम की अनुमति केवल उसी स्थिति में होनी चाहिए यदि पाठ्यचर्या की अनिवार्यताओं नामतः अवधि, प्रश्न पत्रों की संख्या एवं पाठ्यक्रमों, की सघनता पर, अध्यापन/अधिगम घंटों, क्रेडिट इत्यादि के बारे में यदि किसी प्रकार का कोई समझौता नहीं होता है। अतः विश्वविद्यालयों संस्थानों द्वारा एकीकृत एवं दोहरे डिग्री पाठ्यक्रम प्रस्तावित किए जाएँ, जो कि निम्न शर्तों के अधीन होंगे:-

अ) एकीकृत/दोहरे पाठ्यक्रम उन मानकों को क्षीण न बना दें जिन्हें विनियमों के माध्य से यूजीसी एवं अन्य सांविधिक संबद्ध प्राधिकरणों ने पाठ्यविवरण, पाठ्यक्रम अवधि एवं परीक्षा अनिवार्यताओं के लिए निर्धारित किया है।

ब) यदि एकीकृत दोहरे डिग्री पाठ्यक्रम, एक अन्तरिम निर्गम अथवा पारिषद प्रवेश के विकल्प के साथ दो पृथक प्रस्तुत रूप करने का लक्ष्य रखते हैं तो एकीकृत/दोहरे पाठ्यक्रम की अवधि उन दो डिग्रियों की कुल निर्धारित अवधि से कम नहीं होनी चाहिए जिनकी एकीकृत/दोहरे डिग्री पाठ्यक्रमों में यह नामावली दर्शायी जाएगी बशर्ते ऐसे समस्त पाठ्यक्रमों को "एकीकृत/दोहरी डिग्री की नामावली प्रदान की जाएगी (प्रथम डिग्री का नाम)-(अन्तिम डिग्री का नाम)" बशर्ते इसके साथ ही एकीकृत/दोहरी डिग्री पाठ्यक्रम के अन्तर्गत प्रदत्त दोनों डिग्रियों को वैयक्तिक एवं पृथक रूप से एकल एकीकृत डिग्री न मानकर, समानुरूप डिग्रियों के समतुल्य माना जायेगा।

स) यदि एकीकृत पाठ्यक्रम, निर्गम अथवा पारिषद प्रवेश की अनुमति के बिना एकल डिग्री प्रदान करने को प्रस्तावित करता है तो ऐसे पाठ्यक्रम की अवधि में दी जाने वाली छूट, संयोजित की जा रही उन दो डिग्रियों की कुल निर्धारित अवधि की 20 प्रतिशत सीमा तक की होगी जिन्हें एकल डिग्री के रूप में बनाया जा रहा है।

सामान्य अनुदेशः

1. जैसा इन अनुदेशों में अधिसूचित किया गया है, डिग्रियों की नामावली में किए गए समस्त परिवर्तन, सरकारी राजपत्र में उनकी अधिसूचना जारी होने की तिथि से प्रभावी होंगे।
2. उपरोक्त विनिर्देशित डिग्री को कोई विश्वविद्यालय जो किसी केन्द्रीय अधिनियम द्वारा उसके किसी प्रान्तीय अधिनियम अथवा राज्य कोई मानित विश्वविद्यालय के रूप वाला संस्थान जो धारा (3) के अन्तर्गत अथवा एक ऐसा संस्थान जिसे संसद द्वारा, यूजीसी अधिनियम 1956 के अनुच्छेद 22 के अन्तर्गत डिग्रियों प्रदान अथवा स्वीकृत करने के लिए विशेष अधिकारों द्वारा समर्थ बनाया गया है, केवल वही विश्वविद्यालय इन डिग्रियों को प्रदान कर सकता है।
3. कोई भी विश्वविद्यालय इस अधिसूचना के प्रावधानों के उल्लंघन की स्थिति में कोई भी डिग्री प्रदान नहीं करेगा। जैसा कि इसके आगे निर्धारित किया गया है, विश्वविद्यालयों को डिग्री प्रदान करने से पूर्व उन डिग्रियों की नामावलियों का पालन अधिदेशात्मक रूप से करना होगा तथा अनुदेशों के न्यूनतम मानकों का पालन सुनिश्चित करना होगा।
4. अनुमोदित नामावली को विशेषज्ञता के उस विशिष्ट क्षेत्र के अनुसरण में प्रतिबिम्बित किया जाए जैसा वाक्यांश/वाक्य में दर्शाया गया है।
5. विश्वविद्यालय अध्ययन के ऐसे नवीन पाठ्यक्रम प्रारम्भ करें जो कि सामयिक एवं नवीन रूप से प्रकट होने वाली सामाजिक आवश्यकताओं के प्रति सापेक्ष हैं तथा ऐसे नवोन्मेष अथवा विशेषज्ञता को उस वाक्यांश/वाक्य में दर्शाया जाए, जो उन मुख्य विषयों/विषय क्षेत्रों में उन विनिर्देशित डिग्रियों में से किसी भी एक की नामावली में सम्मिलित हो।
6. विनिर्देशित डिग्रियों को समय-समय पर यूजीसी द्वारा पुनरीक्षित एवं अद्यतन किया जाएगा तथा विश्वविद्यालयों को इसकी जानकारी दी जाएगी।

नवीन डिग्रियों का विनिर्देशन

7. आगे से विश्वविद्यालय डिग्रियों की कोई भी नवीन नामावली प्रस्तावित नहीं करेंगे जब तक कि इसके लिए कोई अत्यन्त सशक्त एवं तर्कपूर्ण कारण न हो। यदि किसी भी स्थिति में कोई विश्वविद्यालय एक नवीन नामावलि प्रस्तावित करने का इच्छुक है तो ऐसे विनिर्देशन के लिए इस डिग्री पाठ्यक्रम के प्रारम्भ करने के न्यूनतम छः माह पूर्व उसे यूजीसी से सम्पर्क करना होगा तथा उस डिग्री के प्रारम्भ करने के लिए निर्धारित अध्ययन पाठ्यक्रमों का विवरण प्रदान करना होगा जिन्हें विश्वविद्यालय/संस्थान के संबद्ध अकादमिक निकायों द्वारा जैसे कि अध्ययन बोर्ड, अकादमिक परिषद एवं शासी परिषद अनुमोदित किया गया है।
8. समस्त विश्वविद्यालय (उनसे सहसंबद्ध महाविद्यालयों सहित) डिग्री प्रदान करने के लिए उन न्यूनतम अनुदेशों के मानकों एवं निर्धारित मानकों का पालन करेंगे, जिन्हें विधिवत रूप से अर्हता प्राप्त शिक्षक/स्टाफ द्वारा प्रदान किया गया है तथा इन मानकों के अनुसार प्रदत्त उपयुक्त अकादमिक भौतिक अवसंरचना सुविधाओं का पालन करेंगी जिन्हें संबद्ध सांविधिक/नियामक निकायों, जैसे विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग (यूजीसी), अखिल भारतीय तकनीकी शिक्षा परिषद, (ए.आई. सी.टी.ई.) भारतीय चिकित्सा परिषद (एम.सी.आई.), भारतीय फार्मसी परिषद (पी.सी.आई.) भारतीय वास्तु शिल्पकार परिषद (सी. ओ.ए.), भारतीय विधि परिषद (बी.सी.आई.), शिक्षक प्रशिक्षण भारतीय परिषद (एन.सी.टी.ई.), भारतीय दन्त चिकित्सा परिषद (डी. सी.आई.), भारतीय परिचर्या परिषद (एन.सी.आई.), इत्यादि द्वारा उनकी क्रमिक अधिसूचनाओं/विनियमों में निर्धारित किया गया है।
9. किसी विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा प्रदान की जा रही विनिर्देशित डिग्रियों तथा संबद्ध सांविधिक/नियामक निकायों द्वारा निर्धारित अनुदेशों के न्यूनतम मानकों एवं सह संबद्ध महाविद्यालय विनियमों को उस विश्वविद्यालय की प्रवेश विवरणिका पुस्तिका में प्रमुखता से प्रकाशित किया जाएगा तथा इसे वेबसाइट पर भी उपलब्ध कराया जाएगा।

यूजीसी द्वारा निरीक्षण

10. उपरोक्त अनुदेश/मानकों के प्रति सम अनुरूपता के विषय में प्रत्येक विश्वविद्यालय (अपने सह सम्बद्ध महाविद्यालयों सहित) समस्त सूचना यूजीसी को प्रेषित करेगा।

11. विश्वविद्यालय अनुदान आयोग उस विश्वविद्यालय एवं उसके सह सम्बद्ध महाविद्यालयों—विस्तार केन्द्रों/क्षेत्रीय/अध्ययन केन्द्रों एवं डिग्री स्तर तक की सुविधाएँ प्रदान करने वाले सभी संस्थानों का आवधिक निरीक्षण करा सकता है।
12. ऐसे निरीक्षण के पश्चात यूजीसी, चूक करने वाले दोषी विश्वविद्यालयों/सह संबद्ध महाविद्यालयों द्वारा अपनी विनित्त कमियों/गैर अनुकूलन को सुधारने के लिए पर्याप्त सुअवसर प्रदान करेगा।

इन अनुदेशों के अनुसार विश्वविद्यालय द्वारा अनुपालन करने में असफल होने के परिणाम:

13. दोषी विश्वविद्यालय/सह संबद्ध महाविद्यालय किसी भी अ—विनिर्देशित डिग्री प्रदान करने के लिये कोई पाठ्यक्रम प्रस्तुत करने के लिए निषिद्ध होंगे।
14. इस अधिसूचना के उल्लंघन में प्रदान की गई कोई भी डिग्री एक अविनिर्देशित डिग्री मानी जाएगी तथा यूजीसी द्वारा विधिवत संतुष्ट होने के उपरान्त, कि इस अधिसूचना का उल्लंघन किया गया है, इसे इस रूप से घोषित किया जाएगा। जन साधारण की सूचना के लिए यूजीसी, उल्लंघन कर्ता विश्वविद्यालयों/महाविद्यालयों एवं उनके द्वारा प्रस्तुत की जा रही अविनिर्देशित डिग्रियों का आवश्यक प्रचार प्रसार करेगा।
15. संबद्ध विश्वविद्यालय का यह दायित्व होगा कि वह स्वयं एवं उसके सह संबद्ध महाविद्यालयों द्वारा निर्धारित नियामकों के अनुपालन पर नजर रखे तथा किए गए उल्लंघनों के अनुसार उल्लंघनकर्ता महाविद्यालयों को असम्बद्ध कर दें।
16. उपरोक्त अनुच्छेद 14 के अनुसार पारित आदेश की एक प्रति यूजीसी द्वारा सम्बद्ध आदेश में विनिर्दिष्ट अध्ययन सामग्री के संबंध में जिस दिन जारी की जाएगी, उसी दिन से उस संस्थान की सहसंबद्धता समाप्त मानी जाएगी। ऐसी संबद्धता की समाप्ति की तिथि से तथा उसके पश्चात आगामी तीन वर्षों तक के लिए उस संस्थान को ऐसे या इसी प्रकार की डिग्री अथवा स्नातकोत्तर डिग्री पाठ्यक्रमों के प्रारम्भ करने के लिए स्वीकृति प्रदान नहीं की जाएगी।
17. उपरोक्त अनुसार डिग्रियों के विनिर्देशन के उल्लंघन के कारण दोषी विश्वविद्यालय एवं सहसंबद्ध महाविद्यालय, यूजीसी द्वारा उचित मानी गई कार्यवाई के लिए उत्तरदायी होंगे।

अ—विनिर्देशित डिग्रियों का विवरण

18. दिनांक 23.5.2009 की गत सूचना में जो डिग्रियाँ विनिर्दिष्ट की गयीं थीं परन्तु जिन्हें अब विनिर्देशित कर दिया गया है, उन्हें उन छात्रों के मामलों में वैध माना जाएगा जो छात्र ऐसे डिग्री पाठ्यक्रमों में इस अधिसूचना के जारी होने से पूर्व ही नामांकित किए गए थे।

F. 5-1/2013 (CPP-II)--In exercise of the powers conferred by sub-Section (3) of Section 22 of the University Grants Commission Act, 1956 (3 of 1956) and in supersession of all earlier Gazette Notifications pertaining to specification of degrees, the University Grants Commission (UGC) with the approval of the Central Government hereby specifies the nomenclature of degree for the purposes of the said section.

SPECIFIED DEGREES

Broad discipline-wise nomenclatures of degrees at all levels of higher education should be taken as the specified degree, which the universities/institutions must adhere to, are given below. Alongside the nomenclature of the degrees, minimum entry-level qualifications and duration of the programmes have also been indicated. The information is presented in a tabular form for clarity. In the bottom-most row of each table, nomenclatures of degrees that are presently in vogue in some institutions were found to be neither conventional, nor reflective of a real innovation in knowledge and are de-specified with the suggestion that the same may be restructured/changed as suggested therein.

The universities shall be free to write English equivalent of these degrees, if they so desire in the mark sheet/degree certificates either in parentheses or slash.

Guiding Principles:

Degrees should be specified in generic terms and their nomenclatures should be such that are generally recognised, globally acknowledged and widely accepted and are indicative of the level of the degrees and the broad subject/ discipline/ knowledge area universities/institutions, in curricular innovation, shall have the freedom to indicate uniqueness/ specialisation in parentheses against the specified generic degrees.

Universities/institutions may introduce Integrated and Dual Degree Programmes judiciously and with caution. A dual degree programme combines more than one subject, mostly in a horizontal spread, whereas an Integrated Programme is progressive and cumulative. The academic philosophy/rationale behind offering such integrated programmes should not be for economising on course requirements or award of double degrees in a fast track; on the contrary, an integrated approach should involve a vertical/inter-disciplinary discourse. A dual degree should aim for a better comprehension of the related subjects of study from a multi-dimensional perspective. This would necessarily entail an equal, if not more, course duration and a newer approach of curricular transaction and additional interactive courses. Thus an Integrated/Dual Degree Programme combining two or more disciplines shall be permissible only if there is no compromise on any of the course requirements, viz. duration, number of papers and intensity of courses, teaching/learning hours, credits, etc. Integrated and Dual Degree Programmes are therefore, be introduced by the universities/ institutions subject to the following conditions:

- a) The Integrated/Dual Degree Programmes must not dilute the standards as prescribed under the Regulations made by the UGC and other Statutory authorities concerned in terms of syllabi, programme duration and examination requirements.
- b) If the Integrated/Dual Degree Programmes intend to offer two separate degrees with an option for an interim exit or lateral entry, the duration of the Integrated/Dual Degree Programme must not be less than the duration equal to the sum total of the prescribed duration of the two degrees that are being combined in the Integrated/Dual Degree Programme. Provided that all such programmes would carry the nomenclature of "Integrated/Dual Degree (name of the first degree) - (name of the final degree)". Provided further that both the degrees awarded under the Integrated/Dual Degree programme shall be individually and separately recognised as equivalent to corresponding degrees and not as one single integrated degree.
- c) If the Integrated Programme intends to offer a single degree without permission to exit and lateral entry, the programme duration may be relaxed by not more than 20% of the sum total of the prescribed duration of the two degrees that are being combined to make the single Integrated degree.

General Instructions:

1. All the changes in the nomenclature of the degrees, as notified herewith will come into effect from the date of their notification in the official Gazette.
2. The above specified degrees shall be awarded by a University established or incorporated by or under a Central Act, a Provincial Act or a State Act or an institution deemed to be a University under section 3 or an institution specially empowered by an Act of Parliament to confer or grant degrees under section 22 of the UGC Act, 1956.
3. No University shall confer a degree in violation of the provisions of this notification. It shall be mandatory for the Universities to adhere to the approved nomenclature of the degree(s) and ensure the observance of the minimum standards of instructions before award of a degree as hereinafter prescribed.
4. The approved nomenclature may be followed by the specific area of specialization to be reflected in parentheses.
5. The universities may launch new programmes of study relevant to the contemporary and emerging societal needs and such innovation or specialization may be indicated in the parentheses within the nomenclature of any of the specified degrees in the broad discipline/ areas.
6. The specified degrees shall be reviewed and updated by the UGC from time to time under intimation to all the universities.

Specification of New Degrees

7. Henceforth, the Universities shall not introduce any new nomenclature of degrees unless there is a very strong and genuine reason. Should a University intend to introduce a new nomenclature, it shall approach the UGC for its specification at least six months prior to starting the degree programme along with the details of the courses of study prescribed for the degree as approved by the respective academic bodies of the university / institution, such as – Board of Studies, Academic Council and Governing Council.
8. All the universities (including affiliated colleges thereto) shall observe the minimum standards of instruction and prescribed norms for the grant of a degree which shall be imparted by the duly qualified teaching staff and appropriate academic physical infrastructure facilities as prescribed by the concerned statutory / regulating bodies, such as University Grants Commission (UGC), All India Council for Technical Education (AICTE), Medical Council of India (MCI), Pharmacy Council of India (PCI), Council for Architecture (COA), Bar Council of India

(BCI), National Council for Teachers Education (NCTE), Dental Council of India (DCI), Indian Nursing Council (INC), etc. in their respective notifications/ regulations.

9. The specified degrees offered by a University and the minimum standards of instruction and norms prescribed as laid down by the concerned statutory / regulatory bodies shall be prominently published in the admission brochure of concerned University / affiliated College and shall also be made available in their website.

Inspection by UGC

10. Each University shall furnish information relating to the conformity to the above standards of instructions (including its affiliated colleges) to the UGC.
11. The UGC may cause periodic inspection of the University and its affiliated colleges including extension/ regional/ study centers and such other facilities offering the courses leading to a degree.
12. After such inspection, the UGC may give reasonable opportunity to the defaulting Universities / affiliated colleges to rectify the identified deficiency/ non-conformity.

Consequences of failure of Universities to comply with these instructions:

13. The defaulting University / Affiliated College shall be prohibited from offering any course for the award of unspecified degree.
14. Any degree awarded in contravention to this notification shall be deemed to be an unspecified degree and shall be declared as such by the UGC after duly satisfying itself as to the violation of this notification. The UGC shall give due publicity regarding the defaulting Universities/ colleges and unspecified degrees offered by them for the information of the general public.
15. It shall be the responsibility of the respective University to keep a watch over the observance of prescribed norms by itself and by the affiliated colleges and disaffiliate the defaulting colleges to the extent of violations.
16. The UGC shall forward a copy of the order made under clause 14 above to the university concerned, and on and from the date of receipt of a copy of such order by the university, the affiliation of such an institution, so far as it relates to the course of study specified in such order, shall stand terminated. On and from the date of termination of such affiliation, and for the period of three years thereafter, approval shall not be granted to that institution to start such or similar degree or post-graduate degree programme.
17. Contravention of the provisions relating to the specification of degrees as above shall also render the defaulting university and affiliated colleges liable for action as deemed fit by the UGC.

Status of De-specified degrees

18. The degrees which were specified in the earlier notification issued on 23.5.2009 but have now been de-specified, shall be treated as valid in case of the students who have already been enrolled in such degree programmes prior to this notification.
