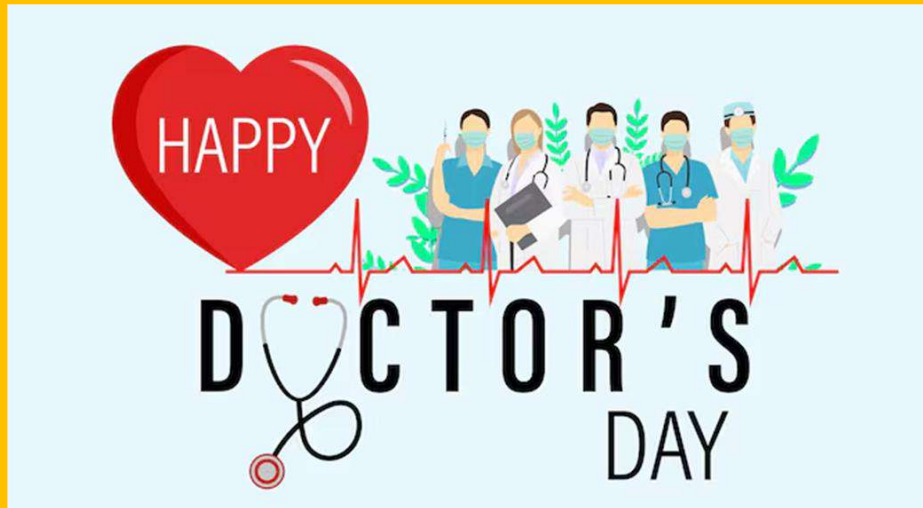

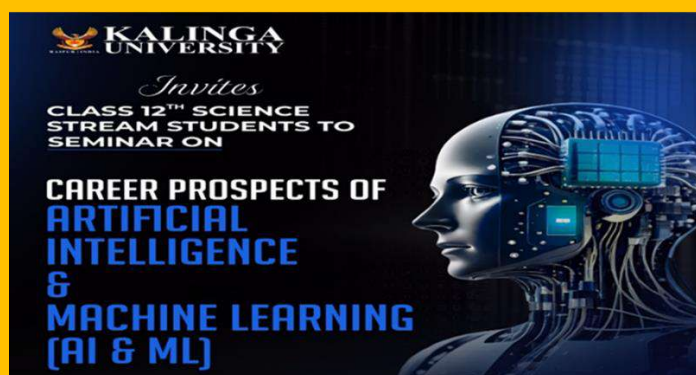

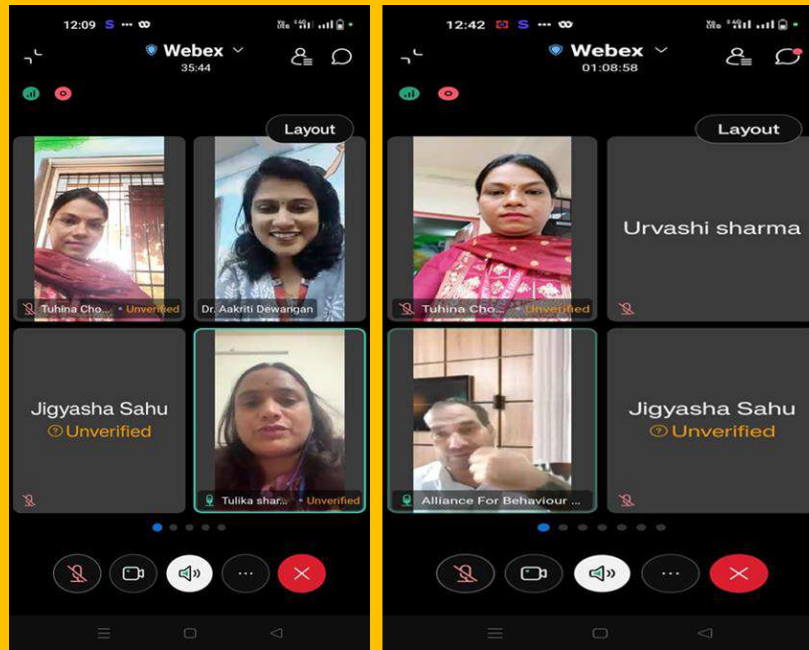

वैश्विक स्वास्थ्य में फार्मासिस्टों के योगदान को कलिंगा ने दिया सम्मान

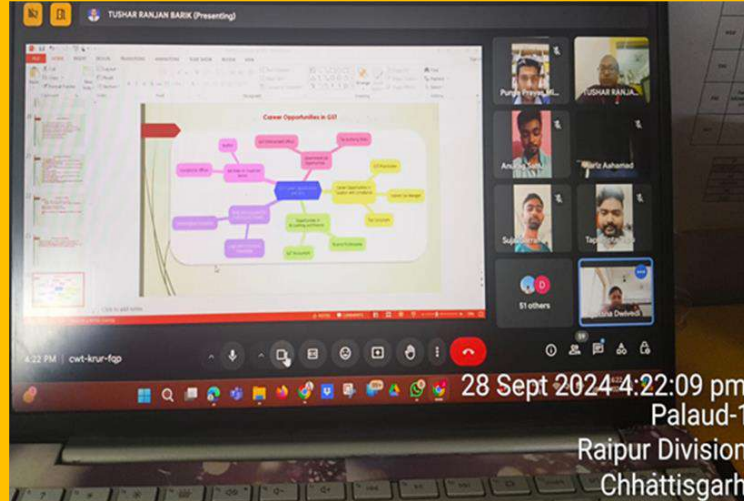
