## Under National Road Lighting Program, 49 lakh LED Street lights have been installed



- Under National Road Lighting Program (SLNP), so far 49 lakh LED Street lights have been installed in 28 States / UTs.
- The program was started by the Prime Minister on January 5, 2015, with the purpose of replacing 1.34 million conventional street lights with energy-efficient LED lights by March 2019.
- The SLNP is being implemented by Energy Efficiency Service Limited (EESL), a joint venture company of Public Sector Undertakings (PSU) under the Ministry of Power.

## Two Acts passed from Parliament for Social Justice



- Two Act passed by Parliament is extremely important for achieving the objectives of social justice.
- The first act is the Civil Rights Protection Act (PCR), 1955.
- Through this, there is a provision to punish anyone who practices untouchability in any form.
- The second act is Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes (Inhibition of Atrocities, POA) Act 1989.

## ISRO may launch Chandrayaan-2 next month



- Indian Space Research Organization (ISRO) can launch Chandrayaan-2 in April this year.
- This time, a rover will also be sent on this mission, which will land on the surface of the moon and gather its information.
- ISRO chairman According to Siwan, if the mission of this mission can not be completed in April, it will be launched in October.


### **TTV Dinakaran will announce his party on March 15**

- Oli (66) got support from all other political parties, except the main Opposition Nepali Congress and some smaller parties.

- The company is planning to localize its two-thirds of its product portfolio in the next few years, under which it plans to introduce its native beverage and fruit juice.

## Foreign investors pulled out Rs 6,000 crore from Indian market



- Due to better opportunities in other emerging countries, withdrawal of foreign investors from the Indian capital market continues.
- Foreign Portfolio Investors (FPI) has cleared nearly Rs 6,000 crore in just 6 business days of the current month.
- According to the depository data, between March 1 and 9, March, FPI has raised Rs 2,410 crore from the stock market and the date
- 3,473 crore withdrawal from the market. Thus, these investors have withdrawn a total of Rs 5,883 crore.

## SpiceJet deals with CFM International for 810 billion rupees



- SpiceJet, the cheap aviation company, said on Saturday that it has tied up with CFM International to buy 155 engines of Boeing-737 MAX aircraft, with an approximate value of 810 billion rupees.
- Spares engines will also be purchased with this.
- CFM develops engines of international aircraft. It is a 50:50-share company of American General Electric and France's Safran Aircraft Engine.

- The RBI will also see whether the banks had prior permission from the credit limit and whether or not they had adequate cash margin available before issuing the guarantee letter.
