Tori-Balumuth rail line and balumath-CCL siding dedicated to the nation



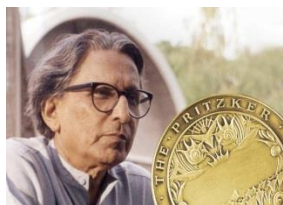

Judge Gita Mittal awarded 'Women Power Award'



- Acting Chief Justice of Delhi High Court Geeta Mittal was awarded the Women Power Award on March 08, 2018.
- For the first time, this award is being awarded to India's highest civilian award for women in the field of law and justice.
- This award was given to her on the occasion of International Women's Day in Rashtrapati Bhavan.
- He took over as Chief Justice in April 2017. During his tenure, there was considerable change in the working conditions of the High Court.

Supreme Court Approval for Euthanasia



- On March 9, 2018, the Supreme Court approved the will granted by a mortal person for the willful (Living Will) written for euthanasia, while hearing a petition.
- According to the Supreme Court decision, now a patient can die with respect.
- The Supreme Court has issued a guideline for euthanasia, which will remain effective until it becomes law. The statutory bench of five judges led by Chief Justice Deepak Mishra gave this historic judgment.

India's number of endangered Asian lions increased to 600



- An increase in the number of Asian lions found in Gir National Park has increased.
- According to the recent calculation, the population of Asiatic lions has increased to more than 600.
- In the 1960s, the number of Asian lions was just around 160.
- In view of such a small number, continuous protection programs were started and success in achieving the growth of the population of Asiatic Lions.

Airtel Payments Bank fined Rs 5 Cr



- The Reserve Bank of India has imposed a fine of Rs. 5 crore on Airtel Payments Bank for operational guidelines and violation of Know Your Customer (KYC) Rules .
- The Reserve Bank has imposed this penalty on the company after examining the bank's documents. He found that the accounts of the people of the people without any clear consent were opened.

- In a statement, the central bank said, "The Reserve Bank of India has imposed a fine of Rs 5 crore on March 7, 2018 on Airtel Payments Bank Limited. The penalty has been imposed on him due to violation of the KYC rules and payments bank operating guidelines issued by the central bank.
