Lectured about microvascular and macrovascular causes of renal disease, Renal syndromes like acute kidney injury, chronic kidney injury and glomerular syndromes.



He lectured about significane of proteinuria and quantitative measurement of proteinuria and discussed about microscopic and macroscopic hematuria with slide images .


He discussed about medical management of hyperkalemia, metabolic acidosis, pulmonary edema and other complications of chronic kidney disease.

The Educational fest ended with the National Anthem.







LIGHTENING LAMP BY HOD DR.K.SIVAKUMAR MD





The important facts and information stressed upon: Eyes may be donated only after death

1. Eyes must be removed within 4-6 hours after death, and the nearest eye bank should be informed immediately.

2. Eyes may be removed only by a trained doctor.

- 3. The eye bank Team will remove the eyes at the home of the deceased or at a hospital.
- 4. Eye removal takes only 10 to 15 minutes, is simple and does not lead to any disfigurement.
- 5. Please remember that only the transparent section of the eyes called cornea is taken out and not the full eye ball.
- 6. A small quantity of blood will be drawn to rule out communicable
- 7. The eyes can be pledged to any Eye Bank preferably the nearest one.
- 8. The identities of both the donor and the recipient remain confidential.
- 9. One pair of eyes gives vision to TWO corneal blind people
- 10. Who can donate and who cannot also was explained.

World Kidney Day 2018 - CKD Screening camp conducted

- 1) Every year world kidney day is commemorated on the second Thursday of March with an aim to create awareness about kidney health among public
- 2) This year World Kidney Day fell on 08/03/2018
- 3) The theme of this year's World Kidney Day is "Women's Health: Include, Value and Empower"
- 4) The Department of Nephrology conducted Chronic Kidney Disease (CKD) Screening Camp for all women employees of Trichy SRM Medical College and Hospital on 12/03/2018 in commemoration of World Kidney Day 2018.
- 5) The screening camp was conducted at Lecture Hall No. 200 at Trichy SRM Medical College Hospital campus
- 6) The camp was inaugurated by the Medical Superintendent of Trichy Medical College Hospital
- 7) The screening was offered free of cost to the female employees.
- 8) The screening included history taking, identification of risk factors for CKD like Diabetes, Hypertension etc, clinical examination including BP measurement, lab investigations namely urine analysis, Serum Creatinine and eGFR, Blood sugar measurement. The screening protocol and lab requisition are enclosed.
- 9) A total of 415 female employees attended the screening camp. Voluntary screening was offered to female employees from all departments (Doctors, teaching and non teaching faculties, clerical staff, staff nurse, FNA, housekeeping etc.,) and all ages were included.
- 10) 16 female employees were newly detected to have asymptomatic proteinuria with normal eGFR and two employees were newly detected to have chronic kidney disease with low eGFR.

4.0. PROGRAMME


Dr. A. Uma, Professor and Head of Microbiology welcomed the gathering after a brief introduction on the topic.



4.1. DELIBERATIONS


Title 1: Transplantation antigens & finding eligible donor- recipient match


Title 2: Immunology of transplant rejection


Title 3: Immunosuppressive drugs and future transplant therapies


