Medical Graduate Attributes

- 4. Lifelong learner, and
- 5. Professional.

In order to achieve this, the National goals proposed by the regulatory authority are adapted by the institution. National goal as "health for all", health as a fundamental right of all citizens, obligations of medical profession to fulfil of this goal are insisted to the students by educating them about various National policies and programs on health, concepts of holistic and ethical medical practice.

Our institutional goals help achieve the national goal each by producing the desired IMGs who are highly competent in clinical skills, holistic and ethical clinical practice and basic healthcare system management. Accordingly, a Competency Based Training Programme is incorporated for

the medical students where we have specific programme and learning outcomes. Accordingly, specific learning objectives have been framed for each of the sessions. Assessment for the specific objectives are conducted according to the sessions either as formative or summative like OSPE, OSKE, Self-reflections, Assignments and Internal Assessments.
