Day 1 - Arrival and Transfer to Cochin Hotel.

Our representative will pick you at the airport/railway station & transfer to Cochin. Cochin, 'The Queen of Arabian Sea', is a vibrant city situated on the south-west coast of the Indian peninsula. Cochin (now Kochi) is a blend of medieval Portugal, Holland and an English country village. On arrival check in to Hotel. Enjoy a city tour of Cochin visiting the JJewish Synagogue, St. Francis Church, Dutch Palace, Chinese Fishing Net, Marine Drive. Overnight stay at Hotel in Cochin.

Day 2 - Cochin - Munnar

In the morning proceed to Munnar. Munnar, "The Southern Kashmeer of Kerala", located 1800 meters above Sea level. This hill station is marked by vast expanses of tea plantations, colonial bungalows, rivulets, waterfalls and cool weather. A 4 hour scenic/picturesque drive to Munnar through hill station. Overnight at Hotel in Munnar.

Day 3 - Munnar Sightseeing / Leisure

Cruise through the unique web of lakes, lagoons, canals and river. Visit Paddy Field, Kuttanadan Region the only region cultivate rice below sea level. Overnight at hotel/Houseboat in Alleppey.
