About the Speaker: Mr. Ehara joined JICA in 2000. He was holding JICA's Kenya Office from 2004-2007 JICA Kenya Office and the South Asia Department of JICA from 2011-2013. He has been representing JICA's India Office from the year 2015. Currently, he is the In-charged of Social Sector, Human Resources Development, and Regional Connectivity of JICA's India Office.

Abstract of the Talk: JICA (Japan International Cooperation Agency), a Japanese governmental development agency, has been assisting growth of developing countries across the world, as well as promoting the country's overall international cooperation. This public lecture will focus on the current bilateral relationship between India and Japan, and its future prospect. India has become the largest bilateral development aid partner for Japan ever since the country started providing ODA to India in 1958. The two countries' link as development partners has been unique, especially regarding its strong emphasis on "Partnership for Quality Infrastructure."

About JICA India Office: JICA is actively providing assistance to construct infrastructure as well as poverty alleviation. On August 1, 2011, a Comprehensive Economic Partnership Agreement between Japan and India went into effect, and 2012 is a memorable year of the 60th anniversary of Japan-India diplomatic relations. JICA is providing assistance to realise Japan-India cooperation such as the Delhi-Mumbai Industrial Corridor (DMIC) and the Chennai-Bengaluru Industrial Corridor (CBIC) in South India, as well as assistance to strengthen Japan-India academic-industry networks, and human resources development for industries such as manufacturing. JICA is extending its assistance to contribute to stronger relations between Japan and India.
