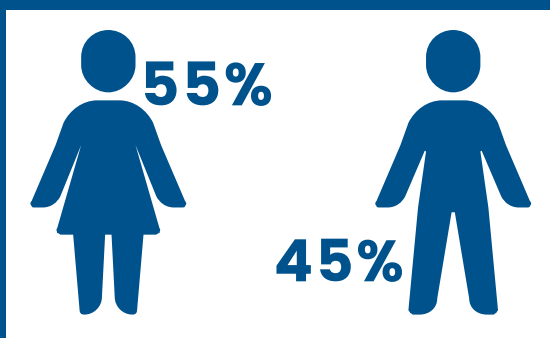
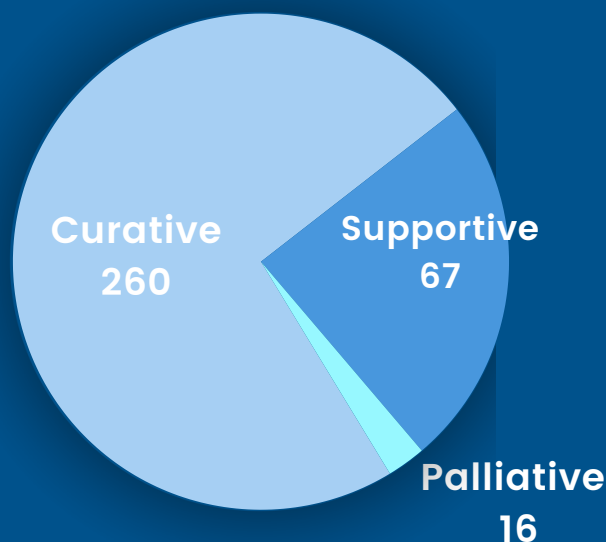

Types of Treatment



Bhuvanesh (name changed), 43, spent two decades driving a lorry, supporting his wife and three daughters. In November 2025, illness forced him off the road. As his health declined despite treatment, his wife began household work, cleaning and cooking, to sustain the family.

By March 2026, severe breathlessness led to his referral to CMC Vellore under the Department of Pulmonary Medicine. Admitted to the High Dependency Unit, he was treated for tuberculosis, acute respiratory distress syndrome and other complications. He received oxygen, anti-tuberculosis therapy, insulin, and antibiotics etc.

With mounting bills and no income, the family struggled financially and emotionally. With support from generous donors through CMC's charitable funds, including Person-to-Person (PTP), Bhuvanesh's family found relief. Gradually, his condition improved. He was discharged stable and advised follow-up care.

Today, his daughters are back in school, and his family moves forward with cautious hope.
