

28-year-old Ganga (named changed) from Vellore has been struggling with difficult health challenges. Eight years ago, she developed paraplegia due to a spinal tumor. Rehabilitation in CMC helped her to get back on her feet. She cares for her 3-year-old daughter and is now expecting her second baby. She visits CMC regularly for her prenatal checkups. Her husband is a daily wage labourer and the sole bread winner of the family.

A few days before Christmas, Ganga had high fever and vomited 7-8 times. Worried, her husband rushed her to the casualty in CMC. She was immediately admitted in the High Dependency Unit under the Department of General Medicine. After she stabilized, she was moved to the general ward. Unfortunately, her haemoglobin and blood pressure



dropped due to an infection in the kidney. Over the next couple of weeks, she was in and out of critical care. Her ICU admissions and treatment costs were subsidized by PTP and CMC's charity. She is now recovering in the general ward and looking forward to go home.
