


## 264 Patients supported

Yuvraj (*name changed*) lives in Vellore District with his aged mother, younger brother and sister. He was born at CMC's RUHSA (Rural Unit for Health and Social Affairs) and has been suffering from asthma from a young age. *“Despite taking treatment, his health has deteriorated over the last 15 years,”* says his sister. Their brother, a painter, is the sole earning member of this small family.

Yuvraj was diagnosed with Type II respiratory failure and became dependent on oxygen cylinders for several months. Each cylinder costs ₹900 and needs replacement once or twice a week. His condition later deteriorated, and he was brought to CMC's Emergency Department with severe breathlessness and critically low oxygen saturation of 35%. He also has complications like diabetes, hypertension, and pulmonary hypertension. With continuous treatment by the Department of Pulmonary Medicine, he has recovered but now requires lifelong Bi-PAP support. Thanks to CMC's charitable funds like PTP, he has been able to continue his life-sustaining treatment. The family is deeply grateful for this timely support.
