



48-year-old Venu (name changed) lives in Kaniyambadi, Vellore district with his wife, two school-going children and his mother. He has very light skin and hair due to a genetic disease, albinism. Venu used to work as a painter but after a road traffic accident he fractured both legs and has been unable to work. He needs the support of a walker to move around.

Recently Venu had difficulty passing urine. He came to CMC's CHAD hospital where the medical team referred him to the Department of Urology in CMC's Ranipet Campus. This was Venu's first visit to CMC's Ranipet campus. He underwent urethroplasty, a complex surgical repair to reconnect the damaged urethra.



Venu recovered well post-surgery and was moved to the general ward in CHAD hospital for monitoring and recovery. His surgery and cost of stay was subsidized by PTP, Department funds and CMC's Charity. Venu and his family are grateful for this financial support in their time of need.
