


**Types of Treatment**



Kripa (name changed) is a single mother of four children, working long hours at a petrol pump to keep her family afloat. A few months ago, her world was turned upside down when her 13-year-old daughter developed a painful swelling in her neck. Referred to CMC Vellore, Kripa was devastated to learn that her child had blood cancer (T-Lymphoblastic Lymphoma). She spent all her savings to begin treatment immediately, overwhelmed by fear and anxiety about the long road ahead.

Through CMC's charitable funds, including the Person-To-Person (PTP), the Paediatric Haematology Oncology team stepped in with timely financial support. Today, Kripa's child is receiving consolidation chemotherapy; the cancer is in remission.
