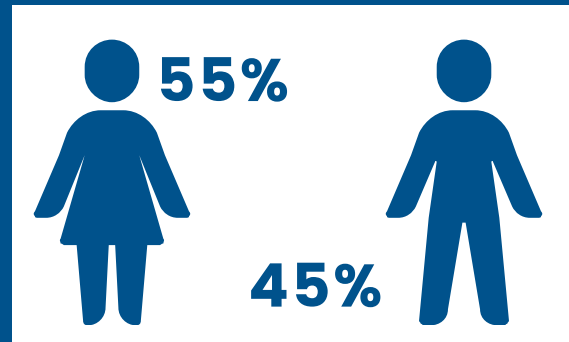
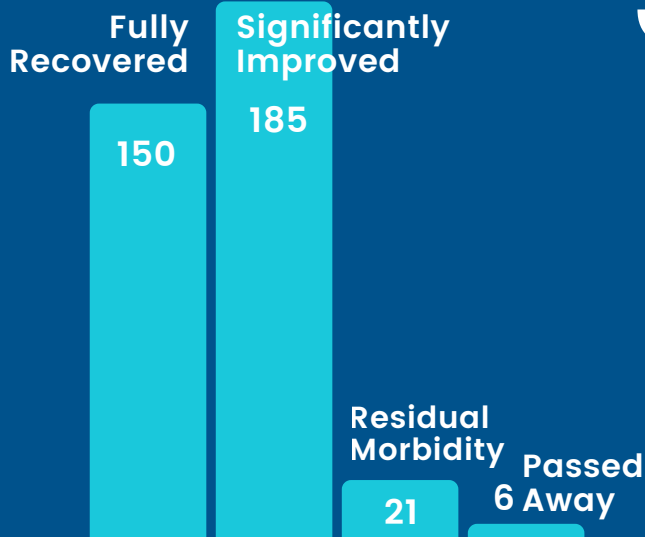


Treatment outcome

18-year-old Maran (name changed) lives with his parents and elder brother in a rented home. He has experienced developmental delays since childhood and continues to need help with many daily activities. His family faces significant challenges. His mother, a school teacher, is undergoing treatment for chronic rheumatoid arthritis. His father serves as her primary caregiver and supports Maran's needs as well.

In 2020, Maran suffered a severe foot injury in a road traffic accident and required surgery, placing additional strain on the family's finances. More recently, he developed a benign growth in his left thumb that affected its function and further limited his independence.

**Maran admitted in our general ward**

Admitted into CMC's general ward, Maran required Hand Surgery costing nearly ₹80,000—well beyond the family's means. Through the generosity of our donors, he received the treatment he needed. His family is deeply grateful and hopeful that the surgery will improve his hand function and help him lead a more independent life.
