

36-year old Sangita lives in Ranipet with her husband and parents. Her mother sells flowers for a living. Sangita completed a course in teacher training but few years ago, she was diagnosed with an advanced stage of chronic kidney disease. Since then, she comes to CMC for check-ups. She is on regular dialysis in a nearby hospital. Unfortunately, her kidneys continuing to deteriorate. She could not work and became completely dependent on her mother and husband. Fluid collection in her chest cavity made it painful for her to breathe. She bore the pain as long as she could knowing that getting admitted in hospital would put an additional strain on their meagre finances. In a few days the pain was unbearable. Her mother and husband rushed her to CMC. She was admitted under the Department Pulmonary Medicine of hospitalised for more than a week until she got better.



"Sangita and her three sisters were born here in CMC," her mother says. "Even in those days, the bills were subsidised for ordinary patients like us. We are grateful that Sangita's treatment costs are supported by CMC." Sangita hopes she will recover enough to have a kidney transplant. However, her future is uncertain. She is now discharged and at home with her family.
