

- **Minimum Marks Requirement:**
 - General (Open)/EWS/Orphan: 45%
 - VJ/DT/NT(A)/NT(B)/NT(C)/NT(D)/OBC/SBC: 42%
 - SC/ST (Maharashtra only): 40%
- **Distance/Correspondence Mode:**
 - +2 through distance/correspondence is eligible, except for those who completed 10+2 through open university without basic qualification.
- **CET Requirement:**
 - Non-zero score in MAH-LLB-5 CET 2023.
- **Other Qualifications:**
 - 11th (old pattern) or Pre-Degree Course from recognized Boards are acceptable if followed by regular schooling (1st to 10th).
