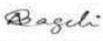

3. COLLEGE PROFILE

DOMKAL GIRLS' COLLEGE, a pioneering institution committed for dissemination of higher education in the district of Murshidabad of West Bengal. The glorious educational history and academic tradition developed by the college has so far attracted students inhabiting a basically agrarian economically disadvantaged region of West Bengal to join the institution for higher education. Since the inception of DOMKAL GIRLS' COLLEGE, the institution has been tirelessly functioning to realize the vision of its legendary founder President, Mr. Anisur Rahaman, Former Minister-in-Charge of Animal Resource Development Department, Government of West Bengal of empowering the women, who are socially and economically marginalized classes of a backward district chiefly populated by the minority, offering them scopes for quality education and helping them to achieve excellence in higher education. From the Beginning the college is affiliated under the University of Kalyani and subsequently enlisted under UGC 2(f) on 13th July, 2021 Through innovations and adoption of best practices, the institution has been striving hard to meet the demands of quality higher education which in turn would lead to the empowerment of its student community, extension activities and sustainable socio-economic growth of the adjoining underdeveloped territory. So many measures have been undertaken to improve quality in every aspect. The College is now prepared for going 1st Cycle of Assessment and Accreditation to evaluate the quality of Institutions serve its stakeholders better. With this aim in focus, the Academic Audit Report, reflecting the quality sustenance and enhancement measures adopted by the institution in last five years as well as the performance of and procedures maintained by the college in areas related to all the seven Criteria, has been prepared in detail.

Since its inception in 2011, the activities of the college have always been fueled by the need to empower the weaker rural community of the adjoining areas through education. The college has been offering General Degree programmes in B.A. The college is girls with large student strengths in most courses.

DOMKAL GIRLS' COLLEGE, being a multi-faculty institution, offers a variety of subjects, such as History, Bengali, English, Education, Political Science, Sociology, Philosophy, Geography, Physical Education and Computer Application which are taught by competent faculty members in a peaceful academic environment, along with providing ample number of educational resources. The vision of DOMKAL GIRLS' COLLEGE is to transform the institution into a centre of excellence in the arena of higher education and contribute to the inclusive development of the country by generating quality women resources in a basically rural and underdeveloped region of West Bengal. The college also seeks to stimulate scientific temper and promote awareness about heritage and culture among the students.

Recently this institution plan to adopt different add-on course and certificate course regarding tailoring, Yoga, Computer Application, Poultry Farming etc. which will help the students to empower them economically.



4. OBJECTIVES OF ACADEMIC AUDIT

4.1 NEED FOR ACADEMIC AUDIT

The IQAC of DOMKAL GIRLS' COLLEGE in its endeavor to ensure quality in academic matters opted for Academic Audit by internal and external peers.

To assess the institutional performance in academic matters the Governing Body of Domkal Girls' College in its meeting held on 01/11/2022 and 27/02/2023, instructed the Principal to arrange academic Audit of the college for different academic session and constructed an academic audit committee after inclusion of internal and external peers in the meeting of GB dated 01/11/2022 in agenda No. 8 (eight). The Principal from his desk has taken initiation to identify the strength and weakness of different department and has taken the suggestion of academic committee to rectify the weakness of different departments, Institution and other academic hindrance of the academic atmosphere.

It was desired that the audit would help the institution take corrective measures and go for betterment of its performance, wherever needed.

4.2 AIMS OF THE ACADEMIC

The aim of the academic audit was to determine whether the delegated responsibilities for quality and standards of academic provision are being appropriately discharged in the institution. The college aimed at benefitting from the insights and experiences in teaching, research and administration of the senior academicians belonging to the Peer team formed for external academic audit. The objective assessment made and recommendations provided by these members were expected to help the institution maintain and improve quality in teaching-learning, research and support services provided to the students by the institution. It is important for an institution to identify its strengths, weaknesses, opportunities and challenges for further progress. The academic audit instructed by Governing Body and organized by the IQAC aimed at such identification and self-assessment by external peers to ascertain quality in academic matters.

4.3 GUIDING PRINCIPLES OF THE ACADEMIC AUDIT

The guiding principle of the Academic Audit has been fair, transparent and objective evaluation of various aspects of institutional functioning and performance in academic matters following standards set by NAAC for self-correction, academic betterment and quality management in effective and efficient manner.

7. SUMMARY OF OBSERVATIONS

7.1 Curricular Aspects

DOMKAL GIRLS' COLLEGE at present offers option to the students to opt for both Honours and General subjects in Credit Based Choice System for the academic session 21-22 under the affiliation of Kalyani University. The selection of Hons and General Subjects is followed by the rules of Kalyani University. The college has also introduced U. G. Courses under NEP from the session 2023-24. The courses under NEP are approved by the affiliating university.

For effective implementation of the curriculum, various action plans are meticulously developed and deployed. At the beginning of every academic year, Principal conducts a meeting of teachers' council including teachers of all departments to discuss the curriculum and changes in the syllabus, if any, and a strategy is formulated for its effective implementation. In tune with the changes of syllabi made by University, College procures required number of books and research Journals for our College Library. Students can search their books and availability in library by using computer searching system by means of KOHA software. Each department has also a departmental book bank from where students can issue books on small scale. Our college is now well equipped with sufficient computers and internet facilities. Most of the departments have their own computers with internet connectivity. Teachers are encouraged to make power point presentation in classes.

The head of the department in departmental meeting assigns each faculty member a particular portion of the curriculum for teaching. Teachers frame a teaching plan according to the given framework of time, and proceed for the implementation of curriculum accordingly. At the event of a faculty member's failure to complete the assignment within the stipulated time, the teacher arranges extra classes for his/her subject. Consistent monitoring of student learning outcomes is accompanied by special emphasis on the weak students. At the end of each semester, the students have to appear for final examination. Each department implemented Mock test or internal assessment, to improve the writing skill of their students.

Each department also organizes Seminar or Special lecture inviting some eminent persons in their field for benefit and enrichment of the students. The college also organizes many seminars and lectures time to time. Our institution of higher education also observes Netaji Birth Day, Republic Day, Rabindra Jayanti, etc. every year. To develop their personalities and to engage in outreach activities, students opt for NSS. NSS units organize blood donation camp every year and conduct seminars on World Environment Day, AIDS day, World Women's Day etc. Students are encouraged to participate in games and sports events and to develop their creativity through the making of wall magazine. All these activities help them to improve their personality and to develop a social bonding with the institution.

The college also aims at empowering the women students i.e. underprivileged section of the society by imparting quality education. The College is affiliated to Kalyani University and offers

B.A. in 9 subjects.

- Systematic curriculum delivery is attempted through utilization of syllabus and preparation and implementation of the Academic calendar. Documents have been verified.
- Departmental profile has been prepared by all the departments.
- Students' attendance registers and registers of Departmental activities are maintained.
- The student-teacher ratio should be increased in a few departments like sociology, geography and Physical Education.
- A few add-on courses are being run by various departments of the college.
- A MOU is implemented in the field of faculty exchange and student exchange programme with neighbouring college

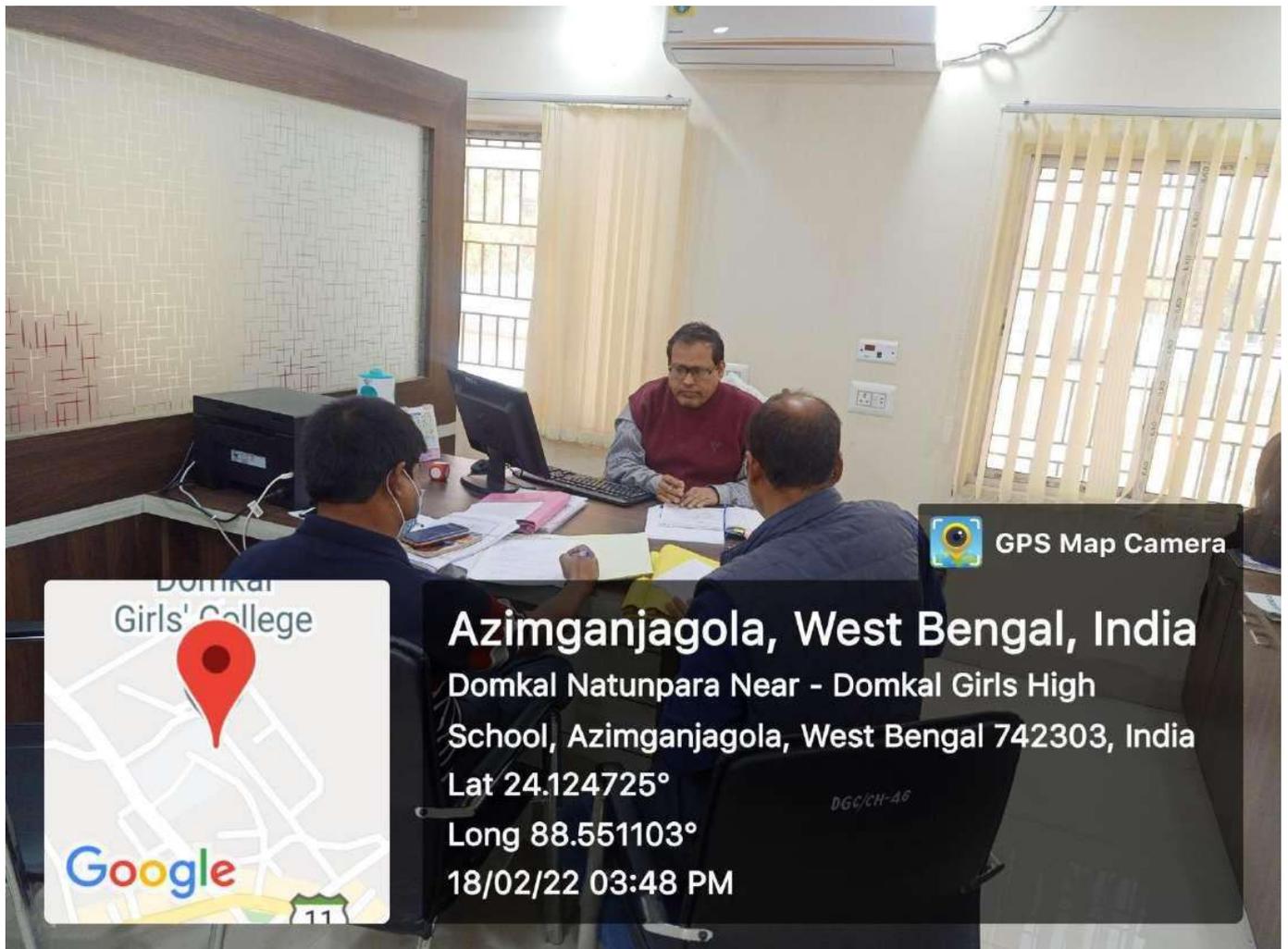
7.2 Teaching, Learning and Evaluation

The college ensures publicity and transparency in the admission process. A public notice is displayed on the College website as well as on the college notice board soon after the publication of the result of the H. S. Examinations of West Bengal Council, displaying the admission rules, eligibility criteria, intake capacity, reservation policy according to government rules, dates of submission of application forms and other relevant information about the admission process. Apart from admission related information is available from local newspapers and TV channels also. The admission process is totally online and it is done through counselling. Admission is done strictly on the basis of merit. There is no management quota. The admission committee of the college, which consists under the chairman of the Principal, plays an important role in framing out the admission criteria based on the guidelines of Kalyani University and recommendations of the departments of the college. The student intake capacity for each course and the norms for preparing the merit lists are displayed on the college notice board as well as college website. Application forms for admission can be downloaded from college website, and the same can only be submitted through online under college website. The merit list of all Applicants is also published in the College website along with their ranks. After the first phase admission, if there is any vacancy, the next phase of admission is done from the waiting list. The candidates eligible for the next phase of admission are also duly notified. The afore mentioned system of admission ensures total transparency. The institution ensures hundred percent transparency in admission process since the college strictly adheres to the rules and regulations formulated by the government and the University for Aided Affiliated Colleges. The institution also follows the guidelines regarding reservations to the backward classes unfailingly.

- Mentoring system has been introduced.
- Remedial classes are held.
- Result analysis is done.
- Records of Internal assessments are maintained.
- ICT is used in teaching-learning process.

7.3 Research and Consultancy

The institution is an undergraduate College, and hence has a little scope for developing scientific temper and research culture among the students of the college. However, the institution arranges lecture talks and national and international seminars and student's seminar to develop scientific temper among the students.



As part of the curriculum, departments like Geography, History and Bengali arrange excursion every year and conduct project works; similarly, students of the departments like Environment science also undertake project works. Students of these departments prepare their projects works under the guidance of the departmental teachers. This helps in developing scientific temper as well as in increasing interest in research among the students. Students of the College are also encouraged to participate in different cultural competitions.

- Seminars are regularly organized by Departments at state, national and international levels.
- Students' seminars are also organized.
- Most of the departments have computers and internet connectivity.
- Some departments like Geography. are equipped with computer, printers, scanners etc.
- Central and departmental libraries have sufficient books.
- Procurement of research-oriented journals and e-journals.
- Access to E-journals and E-books through INFLIBNET.
- Well-equipped Laboratories for Geography department.
- Funding for organization of Research-oriented seminar by Department.
- College sponsored field works or research projects by students are a creditable initiative.
- Faculty research and publication should be increased.
- Opportunities for consultancy have not been pursued.

7.4 Extension Activities

The units of National Service Scheme, Bigyan Chetana Club, ECO- Club and the Women's Cell of our college play active role of interaction with the community. These Units undertake social welfare activities such as community health and hygiene awareness camps.

- In our college there are one NSS units. These units organize special winter camp to generate health awareness in adopted villages.
- Blood donation camps, medical camps, Health Awareness programmes are conducted by NSS units.
- Gatherings to protect environment and campaigns like “Not to use Polythene” are organized by our NSS volunteers.
- Free medical camps and blood donation camps are also organized.
- NSS volunteers meet the patients and offer fruit packets to the patients in Domkal Rural Hospital.
- Tree Plantation programmes are undertaken in the college campus.
- A large number of students are involved in extension activities and community services through NSS.
- Number of industrial visits are limited.



8. SUMMARY OF RECOMMENDATIONS

8.1 Curricular aspects

- More use of ICT/Smart class in teaching-learning is suggested.
- More special lectures should be arranged.
- New full-time faculties should be recruited in departments like Geography & Bengali.
- Number of student enrolment may be increased, particularly in the department of sociology and Geography.
- Add-on courses, especially for the students of all departments should be designed by faculty members in consultation with corporate experts.
- An innovative idea already implemented in the college to use the reading room by the Students. it is needed more library facilities with in the library.
- Some departments may introduce certificate courses considering the necessity of students of the region.
- Feedback mechanism should be strengthened by introducing online feedback system.

8.2 Teaching, Learning & Evaluation:

- Mentoring system has been introduced, but needs to be upgraded and modified as per NAAC module. Students may be asked to narrate their mentorship experience.
- Emphasis should be given on organizing special lectures by eminent academicians, coming from outside the state.
- Online examination system may be introduced for internal assessments of different departments.

8.3 Research and Consultancy:

- The experts recommended that teachers should be encouraged to take up more research projects.
- Post-seminar publications should be made regularly.
- There is scope for increasing number of publications by individual teachers.
- Independent students' projects and seminars may be increased and students may be asked to provide feedback on these.
- The Computer Science department should have a separate software laboratory for the department.
- To access research data the software should be installed in the college library.
- Infrastructure of Physical education department should also be improved.
- Opportunities for consultancy should be explored.

8.4 Extension

Extension also is the aspect of education which emphasizes community services. These are often integrated with curricula as extended opportunities, intended to help, serve, reflect and learn. The curriculum-extension interface has an educational value, especially in rural India.

- To arouse social consciousness of the students by providing them opportunities to work with and among the people.
- To develop an awareness and knowledge of social realities to have concern for the well-being of the community and engage in creative and constructive social action.
- To provide with rich and meaningful educational experiences to them in order to make their education complete and meaningful.
- To develop skill needed in the exercise of democratic leadership and programme development to help them get self-employed.
- To give them the opportunities for their personality development.
- Understand the community in which they work.
- Understand themselves in relation to their community.
- Identify the needs and problems of the social and involve them in problem solving process.
- Develop among themselves a sense of civic responsibility.
- Utilize their knowledge in finding practical solution to individual and community problems.
- Develop competence required for group-living and sharing of responsibilities.
- Gain skill in mobilizing community participation.
- Acquire leadership qualities and democratic attitude.
- Develop capacity to meet emergencies and natural disasters.
- Practice national integration and social harmony.
