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
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

GNM course train students to become nurses in community or medical institutions. GNM nurses practice in a niche segment like maternity care, post-trauma, rehabilitation, mental care, data collection, etc. Since there is no central Entrance Exam for GNM Admission, the admission process involves state specific entrance exams.
