

## Background

Enhanced digital learning in peer-to-peer mode through online courses, conferences and webinar, hence aiming for educational and professional development.






# DEPARTMENT OF MANAGEMENT STUDIES FACULTY




# SUMMER INTERNSHIPS


The summer internship program is an integral part of the MBA program at DoMS IIT Madras. The 2-month summer internship provides industry exposure to all students and enables them to put into practice the knowledge they have gained during the first year of the MBA course. DoMS students have proved their mettle time and again by performing exceptionally well; with many of them securing full-time jobs through Pre-Placement Offers (PPOs). The weightage given to the mandatory internship is one credit. Prior to the commencement of the internship, companies assign groundwork to the student, enabling the candidate to hit the ground running. During the internship, a guide is assigned to the individual who constantly evaluates the work done and the objectives accomplished. Students must submit a report that summarises their internship upon completion. Grades are awarded accordingly.

## Summer Internships 2023

The summer internship placement process at DoMS commenced in October 2020. The corporate world continued to reaffirm its faith in the quality of the MBA Programme at DOMS by participating in the process. The season witnessed more than 23 companies with regular recruiters at DoMS like Accenture, McKinsey and Dell strengthening their existing long-term ties with the department. 
### Domain CTC Average (LPA)




## Summer Internships MBA 2023




### Domain Average Stipend





**Mr. Sudhir Tiku**  
 Vice President, AP and China (Building Technology division), Bosch, Singapore  
**Topic: "AI and the Future of jobs"**

**Highlights**

The speaker began by stating that the modern technological era has revolutionized the industries across domains and the way they work and interact with each other. The unending race for humanity to push their boundaries has resulted in increased life expectancy and even the creation of their alter-ego, the AI. An artificial neural network can be created with the basic unit called perceptron, the replica of the neurons in the human brain. But Perceptrons are advanced and robust in terms of functional, biological, and logical aspects. He also

mentioned that these technologies have enabled the employment of AI in the repetitive, niche jobs in the current scenario whereas the scope for AI to perform more nuanced roles will soon develop exponentially to a plethora of jobs. Such usage of AI will result in more data-oriented approaches, data autonomy, and transparency. With all these stated, the key takeaway was that the current industrial jobs are not going to vanish but transform into more sophisticated ones where the aspirers are required to up-skill themselves accordingly.





**Mr. Nishanth Chandran**

**Topic: "Role of supply chain and delivery management in reaching company excellence"**

**Highlights**

The address by Mr. Nishanth Chandran was an exceptional illustration of how a modest change in a supply chain can result in a magnanimous output. Being the CEO of an Omni-channel startup, he stated in the simplest of terms what supply chain was all about, "The process of moving goods from one point to another". He explained how the distributed and freshly packed model followed by TenderCuts - Farm Fresh Meats and Seafood offered a superior product distinction through a faster, leaner supply chain with the backing of a robust technology stack. He

also mentioned that disruption emerges when the most efficient model is identified for any product in terms of time and cost. More often these disruptions are caused by the most marginal improvements. Mr. Nishanth concluded that in the long run, customization favoring the consumers' choices through machine learning and IoT along with the zest for continuous refinement would help a model stand the test of time. During the Q&A session, he retorted to the queries of the students regarding practical applications and complexities involved in the implementatio




# INTERNATIONAL PARTNERSHIPS\*


