### Call For Abstracts and Full Papers

Original unpublished abstracts and full paper from Researchers are invited for the Oral/Poster presentation. The received abstracts will be screened for the suitability with the theme and shortlisted one will be communicated within due time. Please note that only few papers will be accepted for Oral Presentation; however, for Poster Presentation, there are enough slots. The selected full paper will be published in the book/proceedings having ISBN number and **indexed in SCOPUS**. There will be best awards for each oral and poster presentations. The abstract must contain a concise title, Authors' name, Affiliation, email address and contact number of presenting authors. The abstract must be provided in MS doc. file in Times New Roman font (12pt) with line spacing of 1.5 and structured in background, aim, method, result and conclusion with maximum of 300 words and full paper of **3000 words**. The selected full papers shall be published in **SCOPUS** indexed books. The choice of presentation (Oral/Poster) must be clearly mentioned in the upper corner of the abstract. ### Preparation of Oral/ Poster Presentation

Oral presentation must be prepared in PowerPoint. The PPT must contain 10-15 slides focusing to aim, method, results and conclusion. Poster should be printed in flex of 3(width) x 4 (height) foot in size, to be scientific, simple, brief and self-explanatory. An appropriate font size should be selected for easy read.
