





SIOM took the initiative to motivate others and create awareness about the protection and importance of eyes. Students, teaching and non-teaching staff was informed about the eye check-up camp and they turned up in good numbers for the camp. This event was started in the morning at 09:30 AM in presence of Dr. Daniel Penkar sir [Director, SIOM]. It was held in G12 Hall of SIOM campus. All SIOM faculty members and staff along with the students were present for the inauguration.



The Event was started with cutting the inaugural ribbon by the honourable Director Dr. Daniel Penkar sir. The ground was ideally sanitized before the camp providing the ultimate hygiene to the whole visiting gathering. Also, the used medical equipment and other gears were also of high grades ensuring the accurate results of check-ups. The interior of the eye was examined using an ophthalmoscope, a special torch which shines a light through the pupil allowing a detailed study of the internal structures. After the eye examination, the optometrist gave detailed knowledge of the health of the eyes, the standard of the vision and any special requirements that anyone may have. 

Freedom is considered a fundamental tool to respect guarantee for the rights of all. If any living person is not aware about his or her own individual human rights, judiciary system and the constitution of the country, it can be dangerous for the democracy. Where Laws are meant for Justice and equality for everyone and the constitution who gives power to those rights and laws, which makes it applicable to every person or citizen of the country, brings the serenity. Thus, in country like India-world biggest democratic nation with wide demographic differences, it becomes necessary to learn and understand human rights, judiciary system and the constitution of a country, to protect and secure democracy.



A two day workshop on Human Rights, Indian Judiciary system and The Constitution of India was organized for the students of Master of Business Management 1st Year batch 2022-2024 on 15th and 16th of June 2023, at Sinhgad Institute of Management.

Day 1

The day 1st of the workshop began with the introduction of the resource person Mr. Manoj Wagh, Director of Tech Trainers and Testers, Pune, in association with National Service Scheme (NSS), by Miss. Mahima Mangle and Miss Radhika Pawar. At the start of the workshop, printed study booklets on Human Rights, Indian Judiciary system and The Constitution of India was provided to the students by Mr. Manoj Wagh Sir.

He started the workshop in an interactive mode by asking the students about the Human Rights, What do they know about the Human Rights and What is the importance of Human Rights in India. Students were enthusiastically giving answers of the questions asked Mr. Wagh Sir, started speaking human rights like who is called as Human? What are rights? And what is Human Rights? Why every person has those rights and its importance in every individual's life.

The resource person discussed about different rights of every human being in the world, how differently they are provided to them by different countries and specifically in India. He discussed about the different fundamental duties and fundamental duties of a citizen; which they have to perform, what happens if they are not performed in a good manner? He also discussed about the Rights of the Students, Rights of the Employees, Women Rights, Right to Education and Right to Information, Right of the Consumers, and Rights of the Companies along with its importance for the nation.

Further, Mr. Manoj Wagh Sir, discussed about the Judiciary System of India, which acts as a guardian and protects the rights of every human being in the country and how every human being can enjoy his or her own right because of the system. The working of the Indian Judiciary System, how does an aggrieved person can approach to the system for justice, raise voice against injustice in India was also discussed with the students. Along with it different mechanism to get the justice through Courts, specially Supreme Court and High Court and how the judiciary system does taking different steps to protect the rights of the human with ensuring that all people should get their rights and justice, ensuring the no violation of any right of the person. He discussed about Protection of Human Rights Act, 1993 – An act to provide for the constitution of a National Human Rights Commission, State Human Rights Commission and Human Rights Courts for better protection of human rights and for matters connected with them.

The resource person further took the session speaking about how does the Indian Judiciary System plays an important role for ensuring better public governance. There are number of laws, rules and regulations which a person has to follow while performing his duty.

At the end of the Day 1 of the workshop students received the immense and vital knowledge about the Human Rights and how does Indian Judiciary System guards them and guarantee's citizen of the country that they can enjoy their freedom of rights. Mr.Lalit Pandhare, student of MBA-I delivered the vote of thanks for the knowledgable session conducted by Mr. Manoj Wagh Sir.



Day 2

On Day 2, session started with warm welcome of the resource person and the students and brief revision of the previous day's learning on Human Rights and Judiciary system by Miss Mahima Mangle and Miss Radhika Pawar.


Mr. Manoj Wagh Sir took the session further ahead by thanking to both the anchors and spoke in brief about last day's session. He started further speaking about the Indian Judiciary System.

The judiciary system which takes care and protects the fundamental rights of people also helps in resolving disputes, carrying major political decision and importantly ensuring the Constitution at Supreme and all the decisions according to it. The resource person speaks about the crimes and penalties, consequences of not following the duties in proper manner, punishments on hating, discriminating any person by his gender-religion-cast and others etc. also for not anyone letting enjoy his rights and performing his duties.

Further, Wagh Sir, discussed about the code of conduct, core values related to human rights and how judiciary system is stand there. He also spoke about judiciary systems of different countries like, America, Britain and few from Middle East, what are the core differences between the judiciary laws, rules and regulations along with comparing to India? How does the system works in those respective countries.

Later, Mr. Manoj Wagh Sir started discussing about The Constitution of India. He first asked students; do they know about the India's Constitution and what exactly they know about the same. He said that just knowing the name "Constitution" or having the general idea about the constitution is not enough. People of the country must be fully aware and literate regarding the constitution. He further started explaining about The Constitution of India by starting with what is constitution, its importance, meaning for and impact on every individual's daily life. Why everyone should be aware & possess knowledge of the same, directing on the main objective of the democratic country that is "the protection of the basic rights of the people" and also how it helps for the judiciary system.

The different Articles provided in Constitution of India, Which articles provides what kind of rights to the citizens of the country; the different circumstances in which they can utilize those articles, were discussed by Mr. Wagh Sir. The different articles like Article 14 on Equality and Equal Protection Before Law, Article 21 Right to Life and Personal Liberty, Article 21A Educational



Rights, Article 23 Prohibition of Trafficking and Forced Labor, Article 19(1)(c) Right to Form Union/ Association was some examples of the articles that he discussed with the students. He also discussed on rights of the human or any person with relation to the companies.

The Indian Constituion of India protects the citizens of the country from any partial judgement and gives power to the judiciary to make decisions based on the rules of the laws, whichmakes the judiciary system of India an independent body and sole instituion who controls and pronounce judgement in case of any disputes. Also have provisons for Rights, Laws, Rules and Regulations for every citizen,

At the end of the workshop multiple choice examination was conducted of the students, based on Human Rights, Indian Judiciary System and The Constituion of India to check their learnings of the same. Post workshop Mr. Manoj Wagh Sir presented the Certificate of Participation to the students. He also presented the Certificate to the Institute. At last Mr. Lalit Pandhare shared vote of thanks to Mr. Manoj Wagh Sir for the excellent session and total efforts for the informative and knowledgeabale workshop and sharing his experience too, which gave students an important learning. PREFACE

The Ministry of Rural Development implements many schemes for the benefit of the rural poor in India. Rural development is a State subject. Therefore, the Ministry releases funds to the States for implementing the schemes, for which detailed guidelines have been framed by the Ministry. Ministry recognizes the importance of regular independent monitoring of its programmes. Keeping this in view, a comprehensive system of National Level Monitoring was launched in the year 2003-04 in order to achieve an unbiased and objective monitoring. The role of the National Level Monitors (NLMs) in monitoring the schemes of the Ministry has become very important in the recent years due to several factors;

- (i) These programmes target almost $\frac{1}{3}$ of the country's population;
- (ii) Significant increase in the allocation of funds for various rural development programmes;
- (iii) The increase in demands of accountability and transparency in the execution of these programmes.

In order to improve the empanelment procedure and appraisal of performance of NLMs an Expert Committee under the Chairmanship of Shri S.S. Meenakshisundaram, IAS (Retd.), former Secretary to Government of India was constituted by the Ministry of RD in 2013. Based on the reports of the Committee and discussions in the Ministry, new guidelines -2016 have been prepared under NLM scheme.

1. Introduction

1.1 The Ministry of Rural Development implements many schemes for the benefit of the rural poor in India. Since rural development is a State subject, the Ministry releases funds to the States for implementing the schemes, for which detailed guidelines have been framed by the Ministry.

1.2 The Ministry has a very comprehensive monitoring and Evaluation system for its various programmes through Monthly Progress Reports, Management Information System, Performance Review Committee, Vigilance and Monitoring Committees, etc. However, the Ministry fully recognizes the importance of independent monitoring also. Keeping this in view, a comprehensive system of National Level Monitors (NLM) was introduced in the year 2003-04 to achieve the purpose of unbiased and objective monitoring of its schemes in a systematic and regular manner.

2. Types of Monitoring by NLM

2.1 Deputation of NLMs by the Ministry of Rural Development will be for the following three types of monitoring assignments:

❖ **Regular Monitoring of major Schemes of Ministry of Rural Development, Ministry of Drinking Water & Sanitation and Ministry of Panchayati Raj:** The NLMs would be deputed for regular monitoring to monitor and report on various aspects of implementation of the Rural Development Schemes, in two phases. About half of the districts will be covered in each phase so that all the districts of the country can be covered in a year. In each phase an NLM would be assigned to visit three to four districts. In every allotted district, the NLMs are required to visit 10 villages spread over 3 pre-specified blocks, choosing 3/4 villages in each block, on reaching the block considering the major RD Programmes currently going on in those villages. They will interact with the beneficiaries to find out the impact of the schemes at the grassroot level. The objectives of this monitoring are to ascertain;

- Whether the programmes of the Ministry are being implemented in accordance with the guidelines prescribed by the Ministry.
- Whether the selection of beneficiaries under the programme has been transparent, unbiased and fair.
- Whether the prescribed implementation processes are being followed.
- Whether the assets created are of the prescribed quality and useful to the community.
- The views of the villagers on the programmes and their suggestions for improvement.

- ❖ **Special Monitoring of Individual Schemes:** NLMs can be deputed to cover a particular scheme or some specific aspects of a particular scheme only and report on the issues/processes in detail. Limited number of Special Monitoring rounds may be undertaken every year for in-depth coverage or certain specific features of a programme. These visits will be undertaken based on the requirements suggested by the programme divisions and approved by the Secretary. Such special monitoring rounds need also be planned at the beginning of the year itself to the extent possible.
- ❖ **Complaints/Enquiries:** In case of complaints of serious nature from people's representatives, NGOs, etc. regarding mis-utilization of funds, irregularities, etc., NLMs may be deputed to verify facts or for a preliminary enquiry with the approval of Secretary / Addl. Secretary. The finding of the NLMs will be uploaded in the website.

3. Coverage of Rural development Schemes

NLMs shall cover the following programmes of the Ministry of Rural Development, Ministry of Drinking Water & Sanitation & Ministry of Panchayati Raj in the villages visited by them.

- Mahatma Gandhi National Rural Employment Guarantee Act (MGNREGA)
- Indira Awaas Yojana (IAY)
- Pradhan Mantri Grameen Sadak Yojna (PMGSY)
- National Social Assistance Programme (NSAP)
 - (i) Indira Gandhi National Old Age Pension Scheme (IGNOAPS)
 - (ii) Indira Gandhi National Widow Pension Scheme (IGNWPS)
 - (iii) Indira Gandhi National Disability Pension Scheme (IGNDPS)
 - (iv) National Family Benefit Scheme (NFBS)
- National Rural Livelihood Mission (NRLM)
 - (i) Livelihoods
 - (ii) Aajeevika Skills
- Pradhan Mantri Krishi Sinchai Yojyana (Watershed Component)
- Digital India Land Records Modernization Programme (DILRMP)
- National Rural Drinking Water Programme (NRDWP)
- Swachh Bharat Mission (Gramin)- SBM-G
- Assessment of performance of Gram Panchayats in different areas particularly in decentralized planning and own resource mobilization as Ministry of Panchayati Raj is providing capacity building support through Rajiv Gandhi Panchayat Sashaktikaran Abhiyan (RGPSA).

Any other programme of the government, which may be specified from time to time.

4. Empanelment of NLMs

4.1 A system of mix of Institutional and Individual NLM will be adopted. Approximately 210 NLMs (90 Institutional NLMs and 120 Individual NLMs) will be empanelled.

4.2 Institutional NLMs

- 4.2.1 Institutes funded by ICSSR, top institutes of Rural Management and public institutions from the Professional Institutional Network (PIN) will automatically be considered for empanelment after their consent.
- 4.2.2 If institutions identified through the above method are not sufficient for the task, additional institutions will be selected through open advertisement.
- 4.2.3 Such Institution should have minimum 5 years experience and involvement in Monitoring / Evaluation of minimum two RD projects.
- 4.2.4 The empanelment of the Institutional NLM will be normally for 3 years which may be renewed further subject to their performances. There will be an annual review of performance of an Institute and the NLM will be removed/ delisted due to unsatisfactory performance, etc. at any time by the Ministry.

4.3 Individual NLM

- 4.3.1 Individual NLMs will be selected from retired Civil/ Defence Services Officers, Academia of following categories:
 - a. Retired Central/State Government Officers including IT professionals and Management Experts of the level of Deputy Secretary and above to the Government of India
 - b. Retired officers of the rank of Deputy Secretary and above in the offices of AGs and the Comptroller and Auditor General of India
 - c. Ex-service officers from the Armed Forces of the rank of Lt. Colonel and above ;
 - d. Retired officers of Para Military Forces having equivalent rank to Lt. Colonel or above in the Armed Forces;
 - e. Retired Engineers of the rank of Superintendent Engineer and above in Central/State Government
 - f. Retired police officers of the rank Superintendent of Police and above
 - g. Retired professors of any recognized University/Research Institutions/scientific organization and
 - h. Retired PSU/PSB officers of the rank of Deputy General Manager and above.
- 4.3.2 Selection of such NLMs will be made through open advertisement. An individual upto the age of 65 years as on 1st April of the year of empanelment will be considered.

- 4.3.3 Experience in the field of Monitoring/Evaluation work, social sector including rural development will be given weightage for empanelment.
- 4.3.4 Once empanelled, the NLM would remain on the panel subject to annual review. An NLM may, however, be removed/ delisted due to unsatisfactory performance, etc. at any time by the Ministry. Fresh empanelment would be done to make up for the NLMs removed/delisted as and when required.
- 4.4 A Screening committee with AS (RD) as Chairman, one Joint Secretary in the Ministry, Adviser (Stats) and two outside experts as members and Director (Monitoring) as Member Secretary will select the NLMs from among those who have responded to the advertisement.
- 4.5 The fact that the NLM scheme envisages services for a social cause with a sense of voluntarism would be highlighted in the advertisement for empanelment.
- 4.6 Credentials of NLMs, verification of antecedents, etc. recommended by search committee will be checked up with the concerned State government before final empanelment.

5. Orientation and Training

- 5.1 The Ministry will provide proper orientation and training to NLMs to make them well-versed with the Guidelines of Programmes and processes involved. For the newly empanelled NLMs, Induction training will be organized in which the Joint Secretaries of the Programme Divisions should participate.
- 5.2 Scheme specific modules for this purpose would be developed which would also be regularly updated. A special module on Management Information Systems of all departments concerned would also be there.
- 5.3 The induction training will be organized with the assistance of NIRD.
- 5.4 Whenever a new scheme is introduced special training would be arranged for the NLMs before taking up actual monitoring work.
- 5.5 Post-training assessment shall be done to assess the effectiveness and impact of the training. The findings of this assessment would be used to design and improve the training modules for future.
- 5.6 Regular orientation workshops would be organized every year, at national or regional levels so as to keep the NLMs appraised of the latest changes and trends in the programmes. The NLMs would be kept updated through E-Mail/ web-site of the Ministry on relevant instructions, circulars and any other important information.
- 5.7 The State Government officers/Nodal officers would also be invited to participate in the training sessions/workshops and encourage to interact with the NLMs.

6 Responsibility of NLMs

- 6.1 The NLMs are the third party independent monitors for the various programmes of Ministry of Rural Development, Ministry of Drinking Water & Sanitation and Ministry of Panchayati Raj. The personnel engaged by the institutions have to be experts / professionals in the field of Rural Development.
- 6.2 The NLMs are required to visit the districts, ascertain the implementation of the programmes vis-à-vis the guidelines, interact with officials, verify the assets created and interview villagers and submit their reports within a time frame of two months. However specific dates/timelines will be informed to the NLMs at the time of allotment of districts to them.
- 6.3 The NLM will chalk out their final programme (dates / days of visits) in advance and inform the concerned District Authority / DRDA with copies endorsed to the Secretary in charge of Rural Development of the State and to the NLM Division in the Ministry at least one month before the actual date of the visit.
- 6.4 Before proceeding to the field, the NLMs should access the MPR / MIS system of all the schemes as they are actually functioning and gather relevant data.
- 6.5 NLMs shall begin their visit to the District with an Entry Meeting with the District Collector/ CEO ZP and other district level officials implementing the programmes. NLMs will explain the purpose, approach and scope of their visit to the District officials. The District officials may be apprised of the visit plan and requested to keep the required information ready at the District and at the sample villages to be covered by the NLM. At the completion of the visit there will be an Exit Meeting to discuss with the district officials on the provisional findings, areas of good performance and areas for improvement. NLMs shall record the views/feedback of the officials on their findings and also include them in the report.
- 6.6 The NLMs deputed to a State should also interact with the Secretary or Senior Officers in-charge of RD Schemes in the State to the extent possible.
- 6.7 NLMs will earmark one or two hours, preferably on each day when they are available in a district/block, to meet complainants/general public. The district officials will publicize widely, in advance, the field visit programme of the NLMs, their place of stay, contact telephone number and earmarked time schedule to meet the visitors so that the general public interested in interacting with NLMs may do so and provide feed-back about the implementation of the rural development programmes in the district.
- 6.8 The visit may be planned keeping in view the quantum of work and the number of days for the visit will be decided accordingly. Generally a regular monitoring visit to a district should be restricted to 10/12 days. For the Special Monitoring Visits and Enquiries the number of days allowed will be communicated in advance based on the methodology and requirements of the assignment.

7 Deployment of NLMs

- 7.1 The NLMs will be deployed for regular monitoring twice in a year by the NLM Division. In each phase around half of all the districts will be covered so that all the districts of the country are covered in a year.
- 7.2 The Ministry will prepare a phase wise detailed schedule for deployment of the NLMs for regular monitoring and it would be circulated to them well in advance.
- 7.3 The NLMs may be deputed to visit the districts of neighboring States, but will not be deputed to their home State.
- 7.4 The NLMs will not be allotted districts visited by them during the previous years.
- 7.5 In case of Individual NLM, a team of two NLMs will be deployed to visit a district. For institutional NLM, institutes will be requested to send a team of two persons from their institute for monitoring. Ministry may depute an officer from this Ministry or depute additional NLM, if deemed necessary.

8 Methodology and Reporting

- 8.1 A set of guidelines and instructions would be provided to the NLMs at the time of deputing for an assignment. These would include details about the sample to be covered, methodology to be followed and instructions to fill the formats. Customized Check-list for inspection and the reporting format to be used by the NLMs will be provided to the NLMs.
- 8.2 A D.O letter from the Head of Monitoring Division, clearly mentioning the details of the visits of NLM, should be sent well in advance to the State and District Authorities so that they must provide time to NLMs for pre & post visit briefing.
- 8.3 The visiting NLMs are required to submit a report to the Ministry, in the prescribed format. The report should be concise with an executive summary of not more than 2-3 pages giving key findings and actionable points.
- 8.4 The detailed report should contain key issues related to the different components of the programmes such as:
 - Awareness and reach of the programmes & its implementation
 - Community involvement in planning & implementation
 - Selection processes of beneficiaries and works
 - Financial management – release and flow of funds; utilization of funds
 - Technological issues, skill up-gradation & training
 - Quality of construction, operation & maintenance of assets
 - Transparency in Implementation Process
 - Role & performance of Panchayati Raj Institutions, functionaries
 - Coverage and reach of the programmes in respect of SC/ST, Women and other marginalized sections of the society.

- 8.5 In case of any serious irregularity observed by the NLM, complete information like name of asset/beneficiary, village name, address, time of the event and other necessary details along with the photographs etc. should be provided so as to enable necessary follow up/corrective action.
- 8.6 The NLM should submit Report within 15 days of completion of visit and the submissions may be web-based.
- 8.7 In case of regular monitoring, copy of the report is to be sent to District Collector, Chairman of Vigilance & Monitoring Committee of that district and to the Ministry. In case of special monitoring and enquiry the reports are to be submitted to the Ministry only.

9 **Follow-up Action**

- 9.1 All the actionable points contained in the NLM reports for a State will be collated and a single report with an executive summary of not more than 2-3 pages giving key findings and actionable points will be brought out so that follow up action can be taken up at the State and Government of India level. Ministry will obtain the Action Taken Reports thereafter from the States.
- 9.2 The Programme Divisions will take follow-up action on all NLM reports. In complaint cases, the action taken by the Programme Divisions will be put in the public domain by publishing on the website of the Ministry. While the corrective/penal action in many cases is to be taken by the State Government concerned, the Programme Division concerned will put in place some mechanism to ensure that the States do take action promptly. If any complaint is substantiated by the NLM, the Programme Division concerned is to satisfy itself with the action taken by the State. If no satisfactory action is taken by the State/district for more than one full financial year, further release of funds to such State/district under the particular Scheme can be withheld.
- 9.3 The position of complaints and action taken will be considered by the concerned programme divisions while processing the files for release of funds.
- 9.4 Ministry will organize regular regional workshops with active participation of the Central Ministries and concerned State Governments officials in that region to discuss the findings of the NLM reports after each phase of visit.
- 9.5 Every NLM need to present the observations of the visits in a formatted manner through a power point presentation in the workshop. The presentation should be specific and supported by documents, photograph, etc.

10 Role of State Government

- 10.1 The State Government Officials should ensure that the District Collector / Chief Executive Officer concerned devote time to interact with the NLMs at the beginning as well as at the end of the visit.
- 10.2 Since there are different implementation agencies in the States for the RD programmes the Action Taken Report on the NLM report should be coordinated by a senior officer in the state not below the rank of Joint Secretary.
- 10.3 The Reports of the NLM will be forwarded to the State Government so that they can look into the issues highlighted in the report and identify the actions to be taken. They should also take corrective actions, wherever required.
- 10.4 The reports of the NLM will also be discussed in a follow-up workshop where they can interact with the Ministry officials on the identified issues and action taken.
- 10.5 The findings and ATRs would be discussed with the State Governments in the PRC meetings.

11 Role of District Collectors/CEO ZPs

- 11.1 The District Collectors/CEO ZPs should ensure cooperation with the NLMs and arrange for facilitating a smooth and timely completion of their visits to the district.
- 11.2 As explained in Para 6.5, an Entry Meeting with the District Collector/ CEO ZP and other district level officials will be made by the NLM. Similarly, At the completion of the visit there will be an Exit Meeting to discuss with the district officials on the provisional findings.
- 11.3 All the information required by the NLMs for the purpose of their monitoring should be collated, duly cross checked and provided to them so as to ensure timeliness, correctness and reliability of the reports.
- 11.4 All logistical support as deemed necessary and within the guidelines prescribed by the ministry shall be provided to the extent possible. If the NLM is not provided/not availed transport/ lodging facility, a certificate to this effect shall be given to the NLM so that they can claim the reimbursement of the same from the Ministry.

12 Performance Appraisal of NLMs

- 12.1 The performance of each NLM, including Institutional NLMs, will be assessed annually and graded by the screening committee of selection of NLM on prescribed parameters (Annexure-I).
- 12.2 An undertaking will have to be obtained from the members of the Assessment Committee that they do not have any association with any empanelled NLM.

- 12.3 The committee will grade the NLMs on the following criteria:
- (i) 75 percent weightage will be given to the reports submitted by the NLMs
 - (ii) Remaining 25 percent will be for the presentation made by NLMs during workshops. During their presentation, the NLMs may be graded on the following parameters:
 - Quality of analysis
 - Quality of suggestions
 - Content
 - Clarity of issues and specificity
 - (iii) The committee may bring in more criteria or use other criteria for assessment.
- 12.4 The NLMs who get less than 70% in the provisional grading will be removed from the panel and the border line cases where the NLMs score 70-75 % will be issued warning for taking necessary remedial action.
- 12.5 Grading of NLMs on each assignment will be maintained in a database to enable an overall ranking of NLMs which can be used for deputing them for future special assignments and disengaging the ones who are not up to the mark.

13 Code of Conduct to be followed by NLM

- 13.1 Unsubstantiated and subjective observations must be avoided.
- 13.2 Hospitality from the state government & / or any other organizations / officials / other individuals must be avoided.
- 13.3 No public statement should be made.
- 13.4 The Enquiry reports should not be shared with State / District / PRI administration or public.
- 13.5 No inconvenience to the public should be caused.
- 13.6 They should not cause any embarrassment to the State / district / village officials or to general public during the visit.
- 13.7 The integrity of the NLMs should be beyond any doubt.
- 13.8 The NLM who will violate the code of conduct will be removed from the panel.

14 Terms and Conditions of Service of NLMs

- 14.1 The terms and conditions of service of NLMs on TA / DA, Honorarium etc. are as per O.M. No. Q-17018/07/2014-NLM dated 17.06.2015 revised from time to time (Annexure – II).

Office Memorandum

Subject: Consolidated Terms and Conditions for reimbursement of TA/DA, Monitoring charges etc. to National Level Monitors (NLMs).

The Ministry of Rural Development has evolved a comprehensive system of independent third party monitoring of implementation of its rural development programmes/schemes in the country by deputing National Level Monitors (NLMs) for ensuring accountability and transparency in the execution of its various programmes/schemes. Therefore, this Ministry has empanelled Institutional National Level Monitors who are required to conduct regular monitoring, attending meetings / workshops, special monitoring and enquiries into complaints of various rural development programmes as independent third party monitors so that unbiased and objective monitoring can be achieved.

2. The NLMs are required to visit the allocated district(s) and furnish a comprehensive and crisp report to the Ministry within the stipulated time as per the directives issued by the Ministry from time to time. As per the terms and conditions, the NLMs are required to be reimbursed TA/DA and other charges for providing monitoring services to the Ministry on submission of their bills in the prescribed format (**Annexure**). The changes approved by the IPD, so far, has been incorporated in the existing terms and conditions governing the rates of remuneration and other monitoring charges admissible to the NLMs, as under:-

A. Journey by air (Air India Only):-

(i) The NLMs are entitled to travel by air by AIR India, Economic Class, cheapest fare by shortest route, distance involved should not be less than 500 Kms, subject to production of air tickets alongwith boarding passes. However, Government of India's instructions under Supplementary Rule 190 of TA Rules regarding T.A. to Non-official Members will apply.

(ii) If air facility (Air India only) is available and the NLM chooses to travel by train / road by public transport or taxi/car, he will be reimbursed the actual fare paid or 2nd AC Class fare of mail/express train, whichever is less. Tatkal Sewa journey by train should normally be avoided. However, if it is availed of, reasons/justifications for availing of the same should be given in the TA bill. Only one time to and fro travelling allowance and other charges will be admissible for one visit. **NLMs may travel by Air (any private airline) but the reimbursement would be restricted to 2nd Class AC fare of mail/express train.** Government of India's instructions is to be followed for air travel.

(iii) If any NLM travels by his own car, the rates of road mileage allowance will be fixed on the basis of prevailing rates in the metropolitan city of a particular State and if no rates have been fixed, then the rates of neighbouring State may be adopted as per the order issued by Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, from time to time. **Prior approval of the competent authority in the Ministry is also required to be obtained by the NLM before travelling is done by his/her own car.**

B. Local Transport Charges

(i) The NLMs will be reimbursed actual expenses incurred by them in travelling from residence to Railway Station/Airport and back and railway station/airport to destination and back subject of production of original bills in support of claim which is restricted to prescribed government rate.

(ii) If NLM hires a vehicle for field visit from one village/block to another village/block, actual cost will be reimbursed subject to production of original bill(s) countersigned by the District Authorities (with rubber stamp) of the district being visited by the NLM and a Certificate from the District/State Authority/Agency to the effect that no official transport/vehicle was provided to the NLM during visit to the district. This will also require maintaining tour diary for field visit from one village/block to another village/block, which would be verified from the District/State Authorities.

(iii) If any NLM travels by his own car for field visit from one village/block to another village/block, the rates of road mileage allowance will be fixed on the basis of prevailing rates in the metropolitan city of a particular State and if no rates have been fixed, then the rates of neighboring State may be adopted as per the order issued by Ministry of Finance, Department of Expenditure, from time to time. Prior approval of the competent authority in the Ministry is also required to be obtained by the NLM before travelling is done by his/her own car. To claim local transport charges, specific journey distance is required to be indicated in the appropriate column in the TA Form for timely settlement of claim.

C. Remuneration/Honorarium

NLMs would be given remuneration @ Rs 3,000/- per day (excluding journey period) for actual days of visits only, subject to fulfilment of condition of six hours spent in a day in the allotted village/GP/Block, which the NLM should self-certify. No remuneration would be payable if the absence from the district headquarter is less than six hours in a day.

D. Duration of Visit

(i) The duration of visit to a district for regular monitoring shall ordinarily be of 10 to 12 days, excluding journey period.

(ii) The duration of visit to a district for investigation/reviewing of the specific complaints/programmes shall ordinarily be 4 to 6 days, excluding journey period.

E. Report Writing Charges

NLMs would be entitled to claim report writing charges of Rs. 5000/- for preparation of report of one district subject to fulfilment of the following:

- (i) Separate report is required to be submitted for each district.
- (ii) The report should be neatly typed in a computer and duly bound.
- (iii) Soft copy of the complete report should be given.
- (iv) **Three copies of the report are required to be prepared in cases of regular monitoring and one copy each should be sent to District Collector, Chairman of Vigilance & Monitoring Committee and to the Ministry.**
- (v) In case of enquiry, the enquiry report is not required to be sent to District Collector or Chairman of V&MC.

F. Accommodation/enforced halt charges

In case, arrangement for stay is made by District/State Administration in government guest house/ rest house, the actual lodging charges would be payable. However, where no lodging arrangements are made by District/State Administration, NLM would be paid actual lodging charges restricted to Rs 2,500/- (including all taxes) per day/ per head, subject to production of original bills and a certificate issued by the District/State Administration concerned that no accommodation was provided to the NLM by the District/State Administration. In case of enforced halt, where night halt is involved and is unavoidable, the NLM would be paid lodging charges of Rs. 2,500/- (one halt only) subject to production of a receipt of stay at hotel/retiring room etc. For Officers retired at the level of Additional Secretary to the Govt. of India and above, the ceiling will be 5,000/- per day of halt, for both enforced halt and normal halt.

G. Journey DA

National Level Monitor will be paid journey DA @ Rs. 500/- per day provided the travel journey is more than six hours and no field work is claimed on that day.

H. Managerial Cost

Institutional NLMs will be paid an additional amount of Rs. 10,000/- per report/district towards managerial cost.



SIOM took the initiative to motivate others and create awareness about the protection and importance of eyes. Students, teaching and non-teaching staff was informed about the eye check-up camp and they turned up in good numbers for the camp.

“Eye is the jewel of the body.” It is the lamp of the body. If your eyes are healthy, your whole body will be full of light,” this was the message spread across during the camp.

The ground was ideally sanitized before the camp providing the ultimate hygiene to the whole visiting gathering. Also, the used medical equipment and other gears were also of high grades ensuring the accurate results of check-ups. The interior of the eye was examined using an ophthalmoscope, a special torch which shines a light through the pupil allowing a detailed study of the internal structures. After the eye examination, the optometrist gave detailed knowledge of the health of the eyes, the standard of the vision and any special requirements that anyone may have. Participants asked questions of their interest.

The dramatic slowdown in the global economy, coupled with severe restrictions on movement, has resulted in mass job losses over the last year. Governments have responded to the unprecedented disruption in economic activity by instituting ad hoc social protection policies that vary considerably in terms of their reach and scale. Many wealthy nations have introduced multi-

billion-dollar economic stimulus packages to support business and workers, but most lower-income nations lack the financial firepower to follow suit.


Worsening hunger levels and the impact of the COVID-19 pandemic require a strong coordinated global response. In this challenging context what role should the G20 play under the leadership of the Italian Presidency? This question will be addressed at the first session which will also offer opportunity to get an overview of the Food Coalition, a global alliance established by FAO in November 2020 on the proposal of the Indian Government in response to the pandemic. The session will stimulate the debate around two main topics that are pivotal in setting up an effective and sustainable policy response to such a dramatic food crisis. The first one is the need to support robust and inclusive social protection systems in low and middle income countries as a key requirement to ensure food security for chronically food-insecure. The second one is to recognize the key role of women and young small scale farmers, to address their specific needs, to counter discriminations they suffer and to promote, instead, the transformative role they can play in reducing poverty and hunger.

9. Monetary Compensation to Veterans for sessions they attend as speakers or expert to share their experience post-retirement.
10. All Sports/ physical fitness activities are to be conducted in collaboration with the Veterans India Youth Wing to meet the objective of the FIT India movement launched by the Honourable Prime Minister.
11. The college / Institute/ University shall provide premises in their campus free of cost and available manpower to Veterans India for patriotic activities as and when required besides above mention activities.
12. Facilitation of appropriate internship opportunities to the students in all applicable aspects of the organization including management and technology sectors in their Wings.

Definitive Agreement



Any cost associated with the execution of the objectives of this MOU, if any, shall be mutually discussed and agreed to between the parties in a definitive agreement, before carrying out the activity.

Tenure and Termination

This MOU is valid for five (5) years initially and will be deemed renewed for three years unless terminated otherwise.

This MOU shall commence as set forth above and remain in effect through the end of the term unless:

- a. Otherwise superseded by another agreement between the parties.
- b. The parties mutually agree to terminate this MOU.
- c. Either party gives the other 90 days' written notice of their intent to terminate this MOU.
- d. A breaching party has failed to cure a material breach of this MOU within 30 days following written notice of that breach given by the non-breaching party.

Each party is an independent contractor and no provision of this MOU grants either party any express or implied right or authority to assume or create any obligations or responsibility on behalf of or in the name of the other party or bind the other party in any manner or thing whatsoever.

Neither party shall assign or transfer the privileges and obligations under this MOU without the prior written consent of the other party.

The law of the Republic of India shall govern this MOU. Any dispute between the parties arising in connection with the performance of this MOU shall be resolved amicably between the parties through a process of negotiation



before the use of any judicial remedy before the appropriate forum. Both parties irrevocably submit to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Courts at New Delhi, for any action or proceeding.

Any changes to the MOU are to be mutually agreed to by Veterans India and the (Name of College/Institute/University) and executed in writing.

This MOU may be executed in one or more counterparts, each of which will be deemed to be an original of this MOU and all of which, when taken together, will be deemed to constitute the same agreement. A signed copy of this MOU delivered by facsimile, e-mail or other means of electronic transmission shall be deemed to have the same legal effect as delivery of the original signed agreement.


