The course fee of Rs. 5000/- per participant will be deposited by the institutes at UPTU. In addition, the TA/DA of the participants would also be paid by their respective institutes. The participants for the first workshop have already been identified. For the subsequent workshops, as

## 1. INTRODUCTION

### Essential Complementarity of Skills & Values

It is our joint aspiration and endeavor to move towards excellence in technical/professional education. However, it is important to understand that excellence cannot be achieved by providing adequate professional skills only. It is also essential to appropriately shape the values and vision of the students. It is, in fact, crucial to inculcate a holistic vision to enable them to effectively utilize their professional skills for human welfare.

In the present age, Science and Technology have advanced to a very high degree and have become very powerful tools for progress and development. Hence, it has become all the more necessary to integrate the education in Science and Technology with matching inputs in Human Values and Professional Ethics.

### Value Education- the Missing Link in Present Curricula

It may be appreciated that technology is only a means to achieve what is considered 'valuable' but it is crucial to know 'what is really valuable?' for sustained Human Welfare.

In the present scenario, professional education has become primarily skill-biased and the value aspect is taken for granted. As a result, the high degree of skill competence being imparted, gets harnessed largely by profit-centric objectives leading to exploitation of human beings and the rest of nature. This trend is responsible for multiple global crises. Therefore, the need to introduce appropriate inputs in Value Education becomes indispensable. The need for introducing value education has been repeatedly highlighted by various education commissions and expert committees. However this gap still remains to be bridged.

### Learning from Experiments in this Direction in Other Institutions

Some successful experiments in this direction have taken shape in various Institutions in recent past, e.g. IIT Delhi, NIT Raipur, IIIT Hyderabad, Somaiya Group of Institutions, Mumbai and IIT Kanpur etc. As a result, a rational and universally applicable orientation methodology for value education has become available. This is based on initiating a process of self-exploration and self-investigation in the students at the level of their natural acceptance. It takes the

form of a dialogue between the teacher and students to begin with and within the student himself finally. The students have shown very good receptivity and a tangible improvement in their personal lives, behavior, confidence and their attitude towards academics and profession. There is another interesting outcome in the form of improved environment in the institutions and faculty-student relationship.

### The Present Initiative of UPTU

Realizing this urgency and driven by its sincere aspiration towards excellence, UPTU has taken a very welcome initiative in introducing 'Human Values and Professional Ethics' as an audit course across all its affiliated Institutions from the coming academic year 2009-10 to be offered in each semester. This will be supplemented by practical inputs like community service activities, awareness and inspirational programmes and socially relevant projects for which requisite slots have been provided in each semester.

Of course, it is going to be a challenging task to effectively provide value orientation at such a large scale. It demands deployment of competent resource persons, resource material and orientation of teachers along with adequate commitment and support from the Management and Heads of Institutions. Let us get ready to take up this unique challenge together!

## 2. STEPS ALREADY TAKEN BY UPTU FOR IMPLEMENTING THIS INITIATIVE

- At the behest of Hon'ble Vice-Chancellor, two consultation meetings were held, one in November last year and the other in January this year with Heads of UPTU Institutions. These were also addressed by Secretary, Technical Education, Coordinator, Kabir Peace Mission and experts from IIT Delhi, HBTI, BHU etc. Subsequent to these consultations, a decision was taken in the meeting of conveners of BOS, UPTU on January 12, '09 to introduce the above mentioned Value Education inputs in the curriculum. An expert committee under the chairmanship of Prof. R R Gaur has been set up to plan and monitor this program.
- Expert resource persons were identified to draft the syllabus for the new course and to plan and carry out Teacher Orientation Programs. The requisite resource material is

under preparation under the guidance of the resource persons.

- The proposed syllabus was duly approved in a subsequent meeting of BOS conveners held on April 2, '09.
- A value education cell at the University level has been set up at the university under the chairmanship of Hon' able Vice Chancellor with Prof. G P Bagaria of HBTI, Kanpur as the Coordinator.
- Two one-day interactions have been planned on May 13 & 17 at Lucknow and Ghaziabad respectively for the chairpersons and heads of various institutions to apprise them of the content, methodology and likely expectations from the proposed VE inputs, so as to get enthusiastic support from them.
- A number of 7-day residential Teacher Orientation Programs are being planned to orient at least one teacher from each institute. The first such workshop is scheduled to be held from 21<sup>st</sup> to 27<sup>th</sup> May, '09 at IIT Kanpur. Each such workshop will have a maximum of 50 participants.
- Each Institution is expected to set up a VE Cell under the chairmanship of Director/Principal and identify at least 2-3 committed and teachers to carry out this activity in their Institute. These teachers will be successively oriented through the above seven-day workshops. They will also facilitate motivation of other teachers and carry out supplementary activities as mentioned above.

## 3. ABOUT THE FOUNDATION COURSE ON 'HUMAN VALUES AND PROFESSIONAL ETHICS'

The approved syllabus of the course is provided on the UPTU website along with the exercises for practice sessions. The L-T-P structure of the course is 2-2-0. It may be pointed out that the methodology adopted for Value Education is based on facilitating self-exploration and not on giving sermons or prescribing do's and don'ts. The course will be conducted in a highly interactive manner. The emphasis will be on developing a Holistic Perception towards life by drawing attention towards the reality of oneself as well as the rest of existence. Although the course can be taken at any stage of the program, it is desirable to complete this course during the first year itself.
