



The Sentence

A sentence is a group of words which make complete sense. It has a subject and a verb. It begins with a capital letter and ends with a full stop, question mark (?) or an exclamation mark (!).

Kinds of Sentences

1. Declarative Sentences: Declarative sentences state a fact or an argument and end with a full stop.
2. Interrogative Sentences: Sentences that ask questions and end with a question mark are interrogative sentences.
3. Imperative Sentences: Imperative sentences express commands, make requests or give advice and end with a full stop.
4. Exclamatory Sentences: Exclamatory sentences express strong feelings and end with an exclamation mark.

eg 1.

I am not well today. (Declarative)

eg 2

Did it come on time? (Interrogative)

eg 3

Take out your books. (Imperative)

eg 4

What a bright day it is! (Exclamatory)
