Living and non-Living things

- 1) Birds, trees and human beings are examples of living things.
- 2) Rocks, tables and cars are examples of non-living things.
- 3) ~~Human~~ Many animals, including human beings, breathe through their nose.
- 4) Fish breathe through gills.
- 5) Caterpillars breathe through spiracles.
- 6) Plants take in air through tiny openings called stomata, present on the underside of their leaves.
- 7) Animals move on their own, from one place to another in search of food, water and shelter.
- 8) Fish swim using fins, birds fly using wings and Human beings walk with legs.

- 9) Most plants do not move from one place to another as they are fixed in the soil.
- 10) All living things live up to a certain age called lifespan.
- 11) lifespan of a dog is 10-12 years and of a butterfly is around 20-30 days.
- 12) Living things need food to remain alive and grow.
- 13) Plants make their own food. They need air, water and sunlight to make food.
- 14) Body parts of insects that help them feel changes around them are called antennae.
