### 1 EVEN NUMBERS.

- Any number that can be exactly divided by 2, is called an even number. (even numbers are divisible by 2)
- Even numbers always end up with the last digit as: 0, 2, 4, 6 or 8.
- Some examples of even numbers are:  
- 2, 4, 6, 8, 10, 12, 14, 16, 18, 20, - - - - -

### 2 ODD NUMBERS.

- An odd number is a number which is not divisible by 2.
- The remainder in the case of an odd number is always 1.
- Some examples of odd numbers are:  
- 1, 3, 5, 7, 9, 11, 13, 15, 17, 19, - - - - -
