31. **suite** : (a set of connected rooms) The minister booked a suite for his family in this hotel.
suit : My father wore a new suit for his meeting.
soot : (a black deposit from smoke on a flat surface) A thick layer of soot had got deposited inside the chimney.
32. **vein** : (a blood vessel) Veins carry blood from different parts of the body to the heart.
vain : (proud) The princess was vain of her beauty.

33. **vocation** : (profession) Teaching is a noble vocation.
vacation : I have made great plans for my winter vacation.

34. **yolk** : (the yellow of an egg) The yolk of an egg is rich in fat.
yoke : (a wooden frame or bar) The bull was put into the yoke.
