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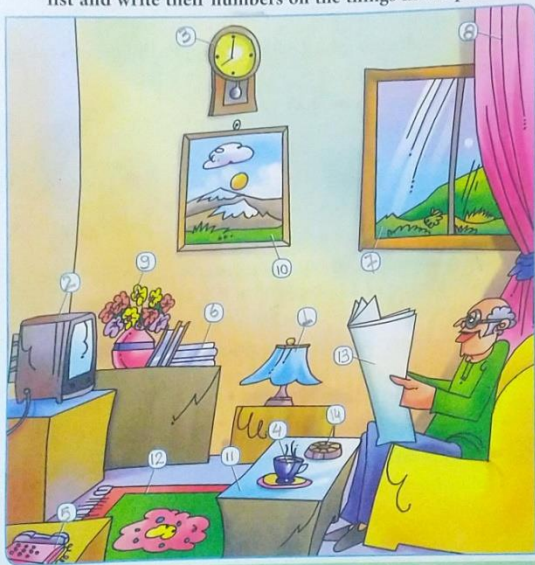

2 PROPER NOUNS

P Proper nouns are special names of people, things, places and animals.

Here are some examples.

1. **Jasbir** is a boy.
2. **Rita** is a girl.
3. **Delhi** is the name of a city.
4. **Snowy** is my pet.
5. **Yamuna** is the name of a river.



The words in bold are **special names**. For example, **Jasbir** is a special name of a boy and **Rita** is a special name of a girl. These special names are called **Proper Nouns**.

We begin a proper noun with a capital letter. We do not begin a common noun with a capital letter.
