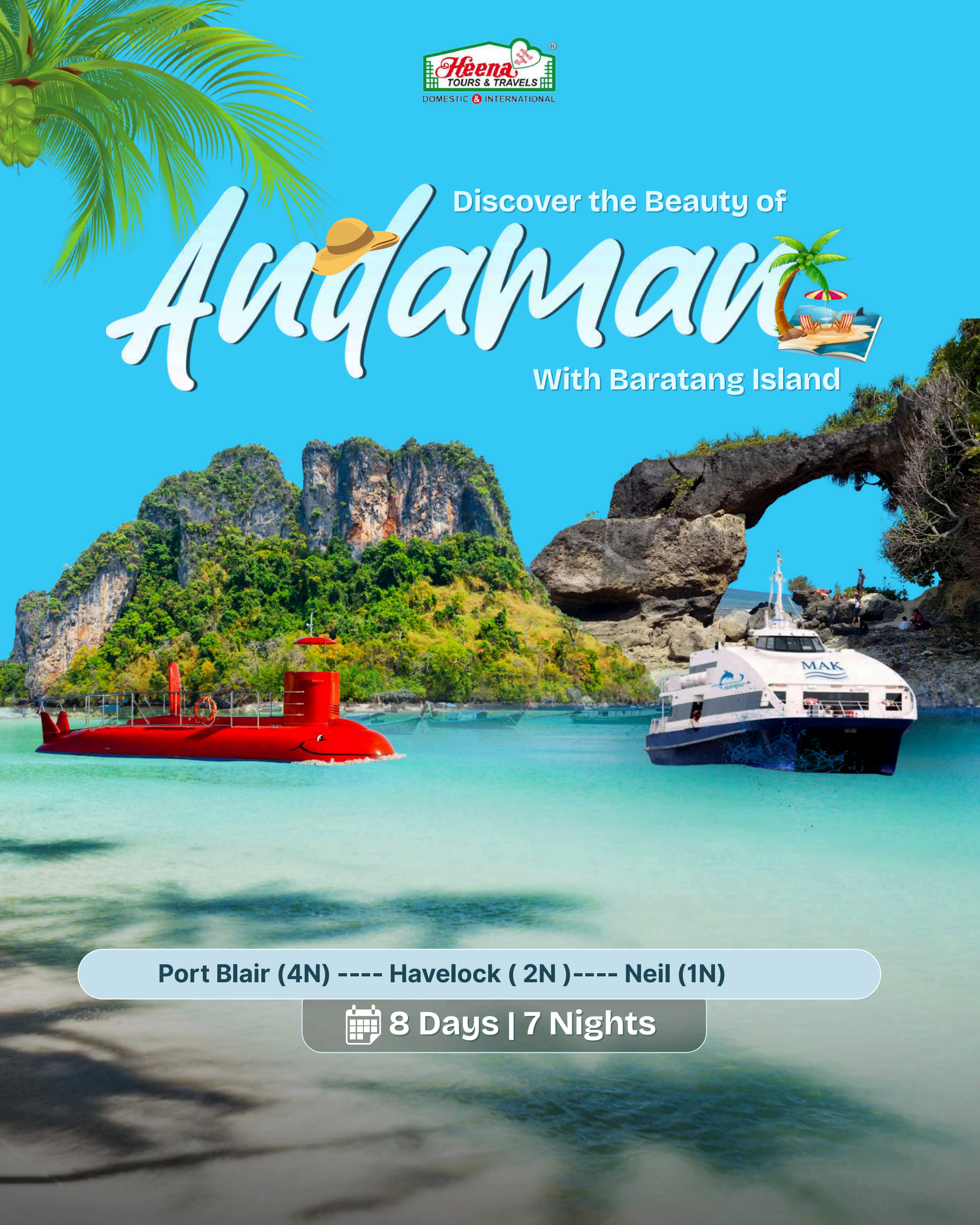

Day 3 : Havelock Island :-

After breakfast, proceed to **Elephant Beach**, customers need to wear half pants as need to catch the boat and transfer to elephant island, located on Havelock Island (now officially called Swaraj Dweep) in the Andaman and Nicobar Islands, is a popular destination known for its beautiful coral reefs, white sand, and various water activities. While the name might suggest the presence of elephants, it's a historical reference to a time when elephants roamed the area. Today, it's a haven for snorkeling, scuba diving, and other water sports like Underwater **Semi Submarine Ride for 45 Mins** (included in the cost) and then proceed to Hotel for Lunch and rest and enjoy high tea and Dinner and night stay at Hotel.

Upon arrival, we visit **Laxmanpur Beach** on Neil Island (now known as Shaheed Dweep) in the Andaman Islands is famous for its natural bridge formation, also known as the Howrah Bridge. This natural wonder is a rock formation created by coral and limestone, and it's a popular attraction for tourists and then check in to Hotel and have lunch, rest and have high tea at **Bharatpur Beach** - One of the best blue water beaches in Andaman, check in to Hotel and enjoy Dinner and Night stay in Neil Island.

Today after breakfast, we checkout from the hotel and proceed to Port Blair, explore the serene coastal beauty of Port Blair. We begin our day with a visit to **Chatham Saw Mill**, Chatham Saw Mill is the saw mill situated in Chatham Island of Andaman and Nicobar Islands in India. It was set up in 1883 with the primary objective to meet the local requirements of saw and timber for the constructional works. It is owned by the state government. It is Asia's largest and oldest saw mill, and then we visit the **Flag Hoisting Point** situated in Port Blair, This flag point is of great historical significance as this is the exact spot where Netaji Subash Chandra Bose hoisted the Indian flag for the first time in Indian soil on the 30th December 1943, and then we have lunch at the hotel and then we enjoy high tea at the hotel, Dinner and Night stay at Hotel.

Later we enjoy a boat ride through the mangrove reserves to the **Wonderful Limestone caves**, to explore stalagmite and stalactite formations which were formed millions of years ago due to the slow deposition of lime on the earth's surface, on the way back enjoy lunch, then reach hotel and dinner and night stay in hotel.

- **Clothing**

- Light, breathable clothing: Cotton and linen clothes are perfect for the hot and humid weather.

- After-sun lotion or aloe vera: To soothe your skin after sun exposure.
- Bug repellent: The Andamans can have mosquitoes, especially in the evenings.
- Personal hygiene items: Toothbrush, toothpaste, deodorant, etc.
- Shampoo, conditioner, and body wash: You may want to bring your own, as some places may only have basic options.
- Hairbrush or comb, Razor or shaving kit, Hand sanitizer: Useful when you don't have access to water.

- **Electronics**

- Phone and charger: With a portable power bank for when you're out on excursions.
- Camera/GoPro: If you're into photography or underwater shots.
- Adapter: Check the plug type for the region (India uses type C, D, and M plugs).
- Waterproof phone case or bag: For water activities like snorkeling, diving, and boat rides.

- **Health and Safety**

- Basic medications: Bring any regular medications, plus a small first-aid kit (band-aids, antiseptic cream, painkillers, etc.).
- Motion sickness tablets: If you're prone to seasickness during boat rides.
- Personal identification: Passport, Aadhar card, or a government ID for travel permits if needed.
- Water bottle: Stay hydrated in the hot climate.

- As in Hill stations rain showers are expected anytime so kindly carry a small umbrella/windcheater & also cover your travelling bag with plastic from inside so that your clothes don't get wet.
- Carry Sun Glasses, Sun's screen, Cap, Sport Shoes.
- No room heating systems (Room Heaters) are provided in the room in maximum hotels.
- Our tour Manager reserves the rights to make changes or omit any place of visit, if it becomes necessary due to bad weather, bad road, strike or band, security reason.

CLIMATIC CONDITIONS

- The best time to visit Andaman and Nicobar Island is from **September** to **May** as the climatic conditions are favourable for visitors, Andaman and Nicobar islands have a tropical climate. The islands are situated at the hot zone. The island has large forest area. About 86% of the island is covered by forest. This affect the climate. The island experience a Mean Relative Humidity of 79% . Maximum temperature is 30.2degree Celsius and mean minimum temperature is 23.8 degree Celsius.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Our Food:

- During the tour we will provide delicious, pure vegetarian / Jain / Swaminarayan Food specially prepared for you according to Maharaj style (We provide Breakfast, Lunch, Evening Tea/Coffee with light cookies and dinner with dry munchings during travel) prepared/cooked by our own expert Rajasthani Cooks.

IMP Note:

- To operate this tour with our full Kitchen Facilities/Maharaj Food, we require minimum 08 to 10 Passengers travelling at a time on that particular date, if we get less number of Passengers as mentioned above, then you will have to opt for any one of the below options, since we will not be able to operate with Kitchen Food/ with Maharaj for less than 08 to 10 Passengers travelling:
 - 01 – You may switch to any other sector as per your choice of date
 - 02 – You may opt for Customised Package (FIT) with hotel food (Breakfast & Dinner) with some additional amount if applicable.
 - 03 – You can take full refund of amount paid by you towards this booking (Advance/Full Payment whatever amount you paid).
- *We are not responsible for any flight/train cancellation charges applicable to you

Transportation:

- Seat numbers in the bus and cruise are provided on first come first serve basis, as per the booking date and the seat numbers remain fixed throughout the tour, Still the passengers may interchange their seats with their co-passengers on mutual consent. Once reaching destination, all the road travel will be by AC Vehicles (AC will not be operational during travelling on Hills/Ghats) as per group size. Due to unavoidable circumstances, if there is any road block, or traffic jam, you will have to co-operate with the tour manager. In case of accident, please follow the instructions of the tour manager to reach the next destination, in such cases we are not responsible for the damage to your luggage or any injury to the passenger.

TERMS & CONDITIONS

Hotels:

- Though we have made blocking of rooms in all the above hotels in advance as per our tour dates, but due to some unavoidable circumstances, if we forced to change the hotels, we have full rights to change without prior notice to the guest. If we have to provide alternative/similar accommodation, for which no refund shall be allowed. The rooms shall be allotted as per the check-in time of the hotels and they shall have to be vacated as per the hotels check-out time. In some hotels the rooms may be twin bedded. Non AC Rooms will be provided in Hill Stations.

Luggage:

- During the entire tour our staff will be at your service to carry your luggage, but at the same time we are not responsible for the theft or damage to your luggage. No claims to be entertained.

Tour Manager:

- We advise you to co-operate with our tour manager in all respect to make your tour really enjoyable. Allotment of rooms, selection of the daily food menu, is the duty of the tour manager and passengers should not interfere in these matters. Passengers indulging in unwanted hindrance, in the smooth operation of the tour, or quarrelling with the manager or other passengers, shall be asked to leave the tour at that spot immediately and shall not be given any refund for the same

Unavoidable Circumstances:

- If due to reasons beyond our control like riots, floods, political unrest, band's, accidents, traffic jam or any other natural or manmade calamities, the program of the tour has to be changed or extended, the additional expenditure for the same will have to be borne by the passengers. If any passengers has to leave the tour mid-way, due to any reasons like death of relative / illness / any other reasons, there shall be no refund for the remaining portion of the tour. And the expenses for returning back to your destination also shall be borne by the passengers. Booking and Cancellations:

YOU CAN CONFIRM YOUR BOOKING BY PAYING A DEPOSIT OF 25% OF THE TOTAL TOUR COST, WHICHEVER IS HIGHER. THE BALANCE PAYMENT SHALL BE PAID 21 DAYS BEFORE TOUR DEPARTURE DATE. IF ANYBODY FAILS TO PAY THE BALANCE AMOUNT BEFORE 21 DAYS, THEN YOUR ROOMS WILL BE AUTO RELEASED AND NO REFUND WILL BE PROVIDED. IF WE ARE FORCED TO CANCEL THE TOUR DUE TO THE UNAVOIDABLE CIRCUMSTANCES LIKE NATURAL CALAMITIES - FLOODS, RIOTS, BANDS, STRIKES OR ANY POLITICAL REASONS ETC.
