TOUR ITINERARY

DAY 01: IMPHAL AIRPORT

Warm Greetings to your North East Tour. Arrive Imphal airport till 12.00 Hrs - Meet our representative and proceed to Hotel. After Lunch, day free at your leisure. Evening visit the Khwairamband Bazaar (a local market run by mothers) and Shree Govindjee temple Dinner & Overnight stay in Imphal.

Manipur, the Land of Jewels, lies in lowland crisscrossed by the water-channels of the Loktak Lake in the North East corner of India. The diverse culture of the state is depicted in martial arts, dance & music and handloom & handicraft. The magnificent natural beauty of the state is a unique charm of the place.

Khwairamband Bazaar: It is the world's only market whose shops are owned, run and controlled by women. A unique all-women's market, where more than 3000 'Imas' (mothers) run the stalls! It is split into two sections on either side of a road. Vegetables, fruits, fish and household groceries are sold in one section and exquisite handlooms, jewellery and household items in the other. This reflects the independent spirit and enterprise of the Manipuri women. The bazaar remains open from 9 in the morning till 7 in the evening. This tradition that is more than 100 years old.

Govindjee Temple: Shree Govindajee Temple is the largest Vaishnava temple in Manipur. The temple is simple in design with two gold plated domes, a paved court and a large, raised mantapa, or congregation hall. The central chamber of the garbhagriha (sanctum sanctorum) has Govindaji (Krishna) and his consort Radha as the main deities. The other two chambers on the either side of the central altar is dedicated to Krishna and Balarama on one side and Jagannath, Subhadra and Balabhadra on the other side. The temple was originally built in 1846 during the reign of Maharaja Nara Singh and rebuilt by Maharaja Chandrakriti in 1876.

DAY 02: IMPHAL- LOKTAK LAKE-IMPHAL (Distance: 45Kms/1Hrs-Approx)

Morning after breakfast, drive to Moirang (45 km / 1 hr), the ancient capital of the Manipuri Kings. It is also the centre of Meithei culture. Cross by the local villages as you go to see the Sadu Chiru waterfall (Cascading from a height of nearly 300 metres) and the Japanese war memorial, which reflects the history of the Second World War.

Visit the Loktak Lake and Sendra Island (a hillock Island with mesmerizing views of the Loktak lake). Loktak Lake is the largest fresh water lake in the North East. Watch the unique floating islands 'Phumdi' that are actually floating weeds on which people live and Keibul Lamjao National Park .Return to Imphal. Overnight in Imphal.

Loktak Lake: Loktak is Lok "stream" and tak "the end". It is famous for the phumdis (heterogeneous mass of vegetation, soil and organic matter at various stages of decomposition) floating over it. The largest of all the phumdis covers an area of 40 km² (15 sq mi) and is situated on the southeastern shore of the lake. Located on this phumdi, Keibul Lamjao National Park is the only floating national park in the world. The park is the last natural refuge of the endangered Sangai (state animal).

Loktak Day is observed every year on the 15th of October at the periphery of the Loktak lake. The lake is also a source of livelihood for the rural fishermen who live in the surrounding areas and on phumdis, also known as "phumshongs".

Japanese War Memorial :

INA Memorial : This is a replica of the original Indian National Army (INA) Memorial whose foundation stone was laid by Netaji Subhash Chandra Bose in Singapore on July 8, 1945. The original was subsequently demolished by the British when they retook Singapore. The replica is part of the larger INA Memorial Complex in Moirang. The Complex includes the site where the INA flag was hoisted for the first time on the Indian mainland in April 1944.

DAY 03: IMPHAL - MOREH - IMPHAL (Distance:110Kms/4Hrs Approx One Way)

After breakfast, visit Kangla Fort . Later proceed for a day trip to Moreh (guest must carry Passport / Voter

ID). Moreh - The border town on the Indo-Bumna road & is the international trade centre of the state. Only 5 km away from Tamu, its Myanmar counterpart, it is an important commercial hub. Sightseeing covers a visit to The Friendship Gate, Tamu and Namphanglong market which is a big Myanmar shopping complex selling all kinds of Thai and Chinese consumer goods. Later return to Imphal. Overnight in Imphal.

Kangla Fort : The **Palace of Kangla** is an old palace at Imphal. It was the traditional seat of the past Meetei rulers of Manipur. Kangla was the ancient capital of Manipur and a number of Meetei monarchs have ruled the destination from this fort. The existence of this fort dates back to 33 AD, when the mythical God-King of Manipur, Nongda Lairen Pakhangba first ascended the throne. It was the seat of Manipur's power till 1891.

DAY 04: IMPHAL – KOHIMA (Distance :135 Kms/6 Hrs Approx.)

After breakfast, check out from hotel with your luggage drive to Kohima the capital of Nagaland. Enroute visit the Heritage Complex in Kisama and the Catholic Cathedral. Evening free at leisure. Overnight in Kohima.

Heritage Complex : The Naga Heritage Complex was inaugurated by the Government of Nagaland on 1st December 2003, where the HORNBILL FESTIVAL is celebrated annually. It is a permanent site at KISAMA situated 12 kms away from Kohima. The Naga Heritage Complex serves as “Window to Nagaland” (WTN), aims to showcase the state in a single platform.

The objective of the Heritage Village is to protect and preserve all ethnic cultural heritages by establishing a common management approach and comprehensive data base for perpetuation and maintenance for promotion of tourism. It also aims to uphold and sustain the distinct identity of dialects, customs and traditions of all the ethnic tribes of Nagaland.

The Heritage Complex consists of a cluster of sixteen houses of each tribe created in the indigenous typical architectural designs and concepts with significance. The tribal house is also called “Morung or Youth Dormitory”. Colorful life and culture are a vital part of 16 officially recognized Naga tribes. They are different and unique in their customs and traditions. These customs and traditions are further translated into festivals. Songs and dances form a soul of these festivals through which their oral history has been passed down generations. Nature has been kind to the Nagas and their land by virtue of natural and scenic beauty and making it a tourist hotspot.

The Hornbill Festival is organized by the State Tourism and Art and Culture Departments every year from December 1 to December 10.

Catholic Cathedral : The **Catholic Cathedral** at Aradura Hill in Kohima, is one of the biggest cathedrals in North-east India. Its splendid architecture makes it one of the important landmarks of Kohima. The unique design created by blending the traditional with the orthodox developed into an architectural marvel. A must-visit place in Kohima

DAY 05: KOHIMA- KHONOMA-KOHIMA (Distance: 60 Kms/1 Hrs Approx. one way)

After breakfast drive to the green village, Khonoma (India's first green Village!) (20 km/ 1 hr). Take a village walk and visit the Morungs (the age group house), the ceremonial gates and meet the local

craftsmen. Collectively Khonoma was known for its fighting prowess in the past and for the fallow management of its alder trees which balance the nature and its surrounding areas. Later back to Kohima. Overnight at Kohima.

DAY 06: KOHIMA TO DIMAPUR AIRPORT

(Distance:230 Kms/6 Hrs Approx.)

Morning after breakfast transfer to Dimapur airport for onward journey. (Flights to be booked after 14:00)
Tour ends with sweet memories conducted by Heena Tours & Travels.

Imp Note:- This tour starts with lunch on Day - 01 & concludes with breakfast on Day - 06.

Documents Required for Inner Line Permit for Nagaland / Manipur

For every traveler:

- 02 passport size photograph of each member traveling (name, age & gender written behind the photograph)
- Photo Copy of Photo ID proof. **Both front and back side required**
- ID Proof : Driving License, Voter Card, Valid Passport or Aadhar Card.
- Pan Card is not accepted as ID proof by the authorities / hotels.
- A list mentioning the Name Age & Gender of all traveler
- In case of Child (below 18 Years) or couple traveling where there is no ID proof of wife, a written declaration must be given by the parents / husband.
- Kindly submit the documents at the time of booking.

Important Information for MANIPUR & NAGALAND

Guests with adventurous mind should travel to Manipur & Nagaland. All hotels in this region are basic to very very basic.

- Room heaters may not work due to voltage fluctuations.
- In this region there are no relevance between the distance and time travelling as it depends upon the conditions of roads and congestion of traffic.
- Mobile services may not be active in all destinations. Pre-paid roaming and International roaming connection does not work in this region. We suggest carrying BSNL (GSM) connections.
- Credit Cards / Travellers cheque are not freely accepted.
- If guests have health problems like blood pressure, asthma, & heart related issue etc. kindly advise them to consult their doctors
- Kindly carry appropriate medicines as they will not be available easily
- National Parks remain open only from 1 November - 30 April 2020. In May Safari will be closed.
- We are not responsible for cancellation of safari.
- Many place have 3 Star equivalent as highest property
- No star rated category is available in interior region of Nagaland & Manipur. Best available (subject to availability) will be provided
- All hotels do not have lift facility & the guest may have to climb stairs
- The region's prime tourist interest in its Nature and eco-friendly atmosphere. The facilities available here cannot be matched with other developed destinations.
- Many accommodations will have basic facilities compared with other regions. Please note that this region can be enjoyed in its natural beauty and simple flavor.

Our Food: During the tour we will provide delicious, pure vegetarian / Jain / Swaminarayan Food specially prepared for you according to “**Heena Style**” (We provide Breakfast, Lunch, Evening Tea/Coffee with light cookies and dinner with dry munching during travel) prepared/cooked by our own expert Rajasthani Cooks.

IMP Note: To operate this tour with our full Kitchen Facilities/Maharaj Food, we require minimum 08 to 10 Passengers travelling at a time on that particular date, if we get less number of Passengers as mentioned above, then you will have to opt for any one of the below options, since we will not be able to operate with Kitchen Food/ with Maharaj for less than 08 to 10 Passengers travelling:

01 – You may switch to any other sector as per your choice of date

02 – You may opt for Customized Package (FIT) with hotel food (Breakfast & Dinner) with some additional amount if applicable.

03 – You can take full refund of amount paid by you towards this booking (Advance/Full Payment whatever amount you paid).

Transportation: Seat numbers in the bus are provided on first come first serve basis, as per the booking date and the seat numbers remain fixed throughout the tour, still the passengers may interchange their seats with their co-passengers on mutual consent. Once reaching destination, all the road travel will be by Non AC Vehicles as per group size. Due to unavoidable circumstances, if there is any road block, or traffic jam, you will have to co-operate with the tour manager. In case of accident, please follow the instructions of the tour manager to reach the next destination, in such cases we are not responsible for the damage to your luggage or any injury to the passenger.

Hotels: Though we have made blocking of rooms in all the above hotels in advance as per our tour dates, but due to some unavoidable circumstances, if we are forced to change the hotels, we have full rights to change without prior notice to the guest. If we have to provide alternative/similar accommodation, for which no refund shall be allowed. The rooms shall be allotted as per the check-in time of the hotels and they shall have to be vacated as per the hotels check-out time. In some hotels the rooms may be twin bedded. **Non AC Rooms will be provided in Hill Stations.**

Luggage: During the entire tour our staff will be at your service to carry your luggage, but at the same time we are not responsible for the theft or damage to your luggage. No claims to be entertained.

Tour Manager: We advise you to co-operate with our tour manager in all respects to make your tour really enjoyable. Allotment of rooms, selection of the daily food menu, is the duty of the tour manager and passengers should not interfere in these matters. Passengers indulging in unwanted hindrance, in the smooth operation of the tour, or quarrelling with the manager or other passengers, shall be asked to leave the tour at that spot immediately and shall not be given any refund for the same.

Unavoidable Circumstances: If due to reasons beyond our control like riots, floods, political unrest, band's, accidents, traffic jam or any other natural or manmade calamities, the program of the tour has to be changed or extended, the additional expenditure for the same will have to be borne by the passengers. If any passenger has to leave the tour mid-way, due to any reasons like death of relative / illness / any other reasons, there shall

be no refund for the remaining portion of the tour and the expenses for returning back to your destination also shall be borne by the passengers.

If any tour is cancelled from our end, then the cost and responsibility of organizing the new tour will be of passenger's only. Any dispute will be subject to Mumbai Jurisdiction.

Suggestions / Complaints during the Tour: If the passengers have any suggestions/complaints regarding our services like hotel, bus, food etc. are advised to inform to your sector in-charge and then our office immediately by whatsapp to your sales executive and co-operate with the tour manager, so that the same can be readdressed as early as possible. No complaints or refund for the same be entertained after completion of the tour.

Booking & Cancellations:

You can confirm your booking by paying a deposit of Rs.10000/- per person (Non Refundable).

The balance payment shall be paid 21 days before tour departure date. If anybody fails to pay the balance amount before 21 days, then your rooms will be auto released and no refund will be provided. If we are forced to cancel the tour due to the unavoidable circumstances like natural calamities - floods, riots, bands, strikes or any political reasons etc. then we shall give you an option of date change or credit note after deducting 10% of the total tour cost as our service charge for making the necessary arrangements for your tour.

Cancellation policy:

Before 21 days of tour departure Rs.10,000/- per person

Between 10 to 21 days 50% of the tour cost.

Between 05 to 10 days 75% of the tour cost.

Within 05 days 100% of the tour cost (**NO REFUND**).
