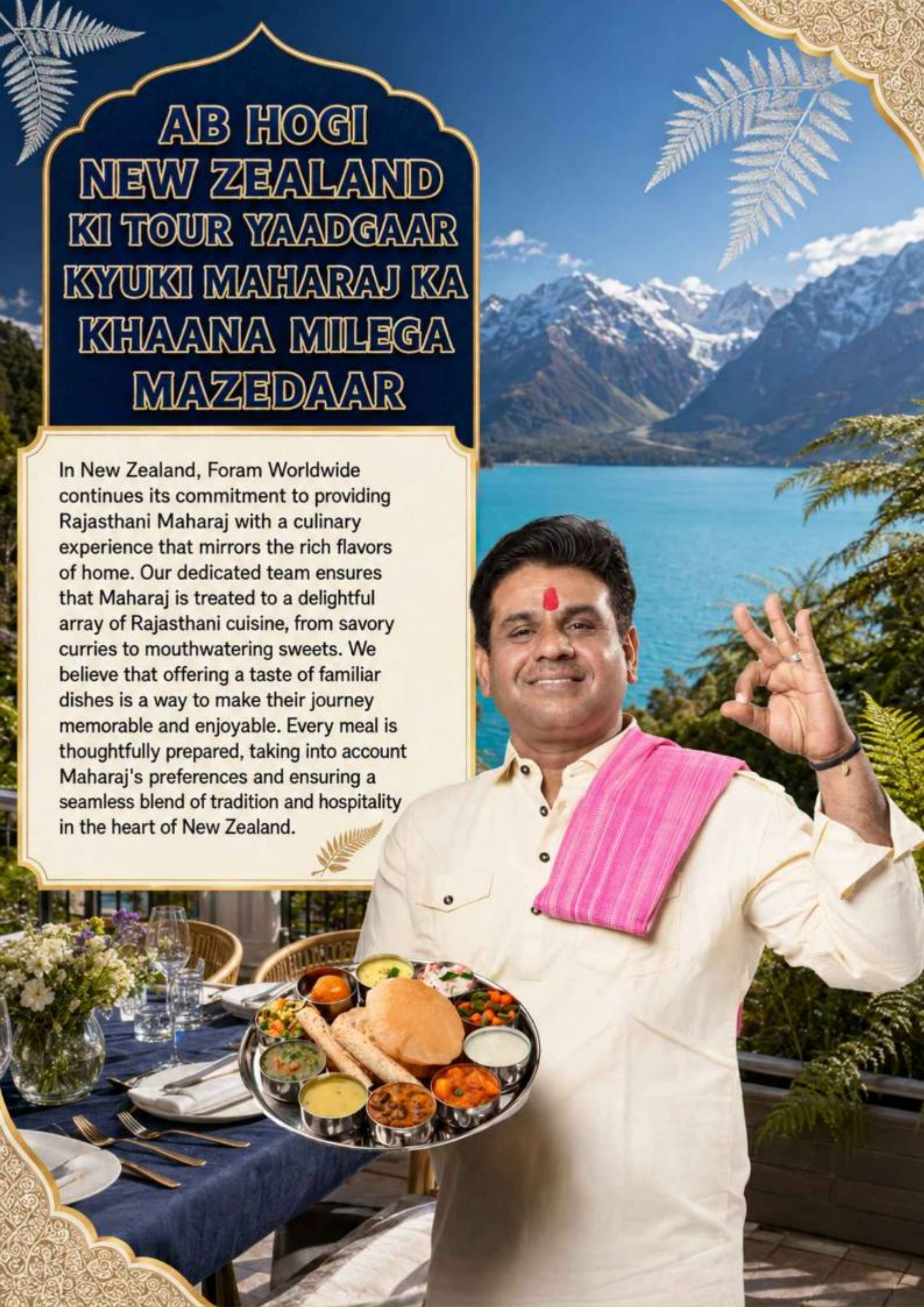

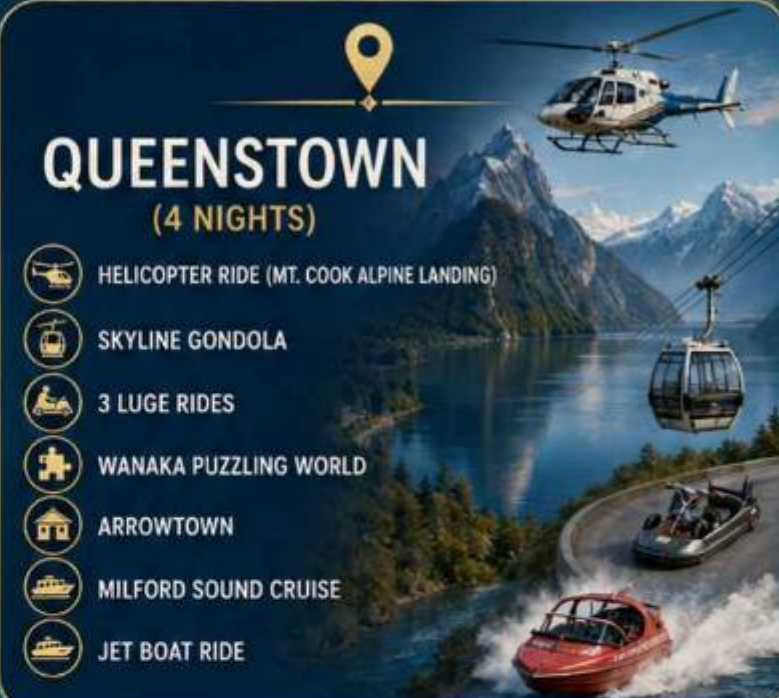

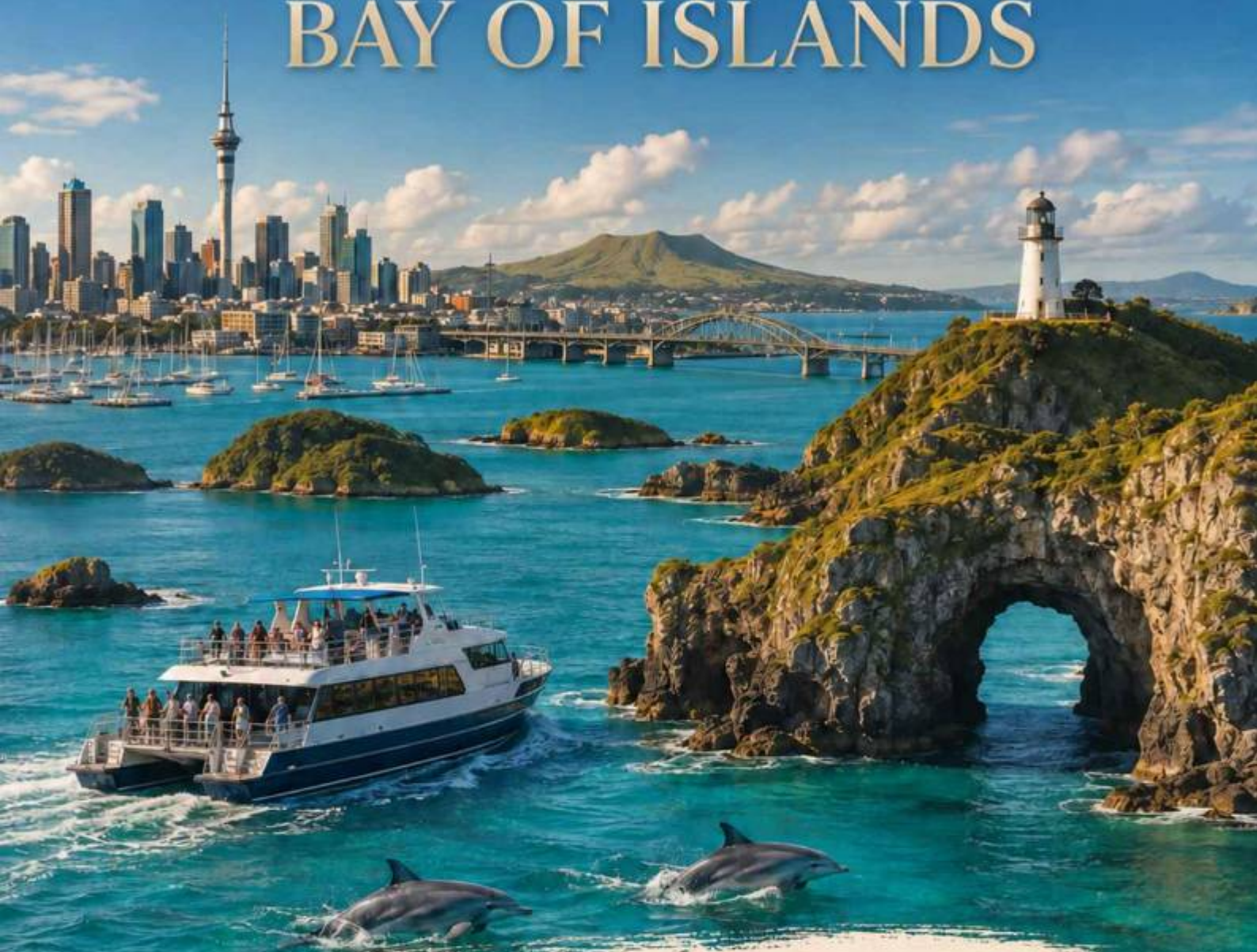
DAY 11 : ROTORUA - AUCKLAND

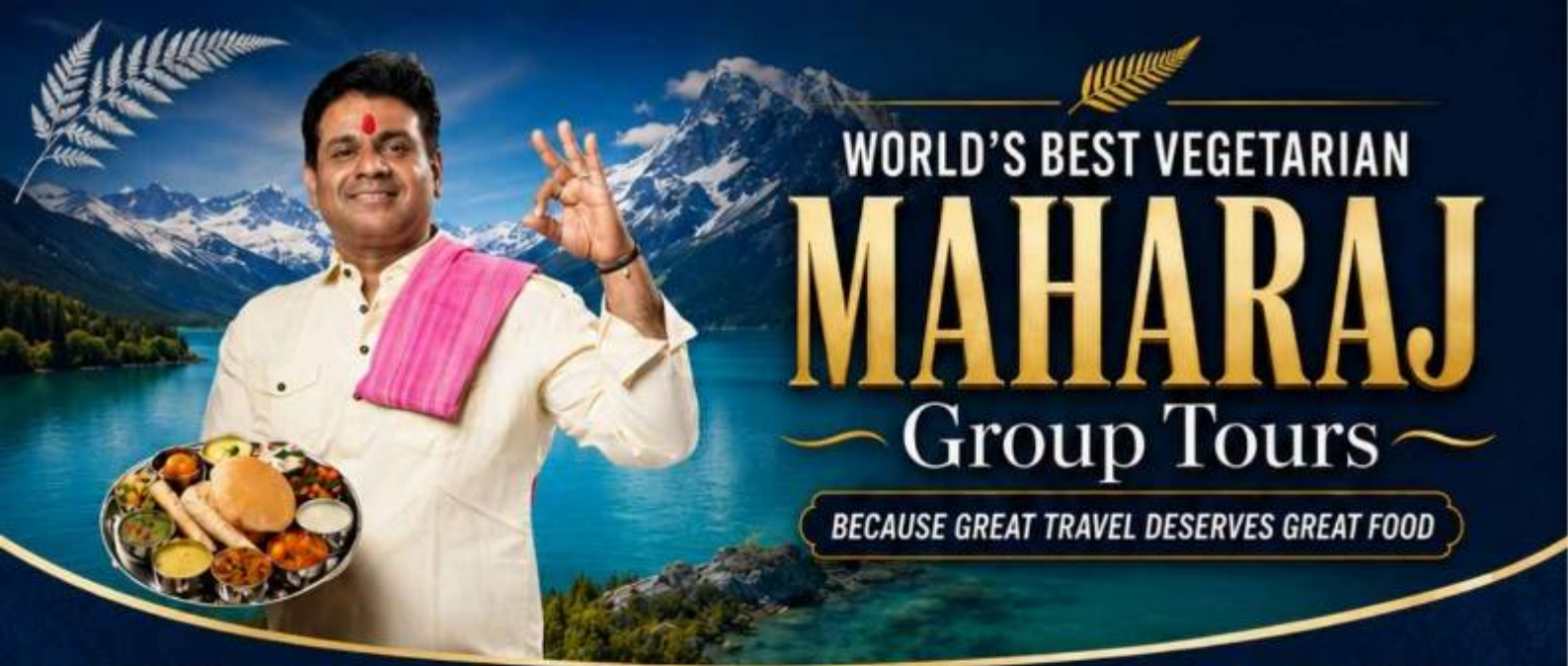
