
It is heartening to learn that the efforts made by the various SECs in conducting elections to the LSGs have been widely lauded by all.





The Ahom Kings ruled Assam thereafter for nearly 600 years. However, part of Assam came to British occupation in 1826 as a result of the treaty of Yandaboo in between the British and the King of Burma. Thereafter, the entire Assam came under the British rule in 1838 AD. During the British era, Assam was made a province of British India in 1912 and thereafter a state of the Indian Union in 1947.
