WWS ACTIVITY REPORT 2018-19

Walk With a Scholar (WWS) programme is a new initiative by Higher Education Department, Government of Kerala envisaged to raise the standard of Higher Education Sector to a world-class level. It is proposed to arrange specialized mentoring programmes for students in the undergraduate courses. This scheme introduces the idea of mentoring and builds on the concept of a *mentor as a guide and friend*. Mentoring is a process where a mentor having greater experience and wisdom guides the mentees to develop both personally and professionally. The WWS scheme aims at giving necessary orientation to needy students, to prepare themselves for employment and give them necessary guidance, motivation and mental support to identify appropriate areas of higher study as well as employment.

The activities for the academic year were planned and charted. Ten members of the permanent teaching faculty were selected as mentors for the sixty students based on their willingness to perform the task. Each internal mentor has to mentor any 6 of these students based on their choice. A list of internal mentors and the students allotted to them are enclosed. Smt Maya P.K Assistant Professor in Economics was appointed as the co-ordinator on 16th January 2019 when Mr Doney Kurian, Assistant Professor in Mathematics the co-ordinator was in a position to take up another employment.





Induction Programmes for Internal mentors

The Induction Programme for the internal mentors are conducted on 14.10.2018. Necessary guidelines were given regarding the conduct of the programme and a writing pad, the pen was distributed to the mentors. Tea, snacks & lunch were also provided.



Internal Mentoring

Mentoring sessions were held at least once every month according to the convenience of the mentees and the mentors. The sessions included different programmes like personal introduction, debates and discussions, seminars, counselling, elocution, PowerPoint presentations on various topics, university result analysis and career guidance.







External Mentoring

A panel of external mentors has been prepared in consultation with the mentseman Bicolina SASTHAMCOTTA mentors. Eminent personalities who made remarkable contributions in their fields have been

included in the panel. We have tried our best to include a variety of topics like personality development, higher studies, creativity, self-motivation etc. in the external mentoring session. Only those experts who have conducted mentoring classes elsewhere and have excellent feedback were invited for this programme Classes were arranged according to the convenience of the mentees. ACTIVITY REPORT 2019-20

Walk With a Scholar (WWS) scheme has been designed to arrange specialised mentoring programmes for students in Under Graduate Programmes in Arts, Science and Commerce Streams. The scheme originally introduced the idea of mentoring, building on the concept of mentor as a "Guide and Friend".

One of the most prominent themes in WWS is to develop students into Scholars. WWS aims to nurture a scholarly attitude among selected bright college students in all disciplines provide them with learning opportunities to help sharpen their academic and critical thinking skills, help them confidently pursue their personal and academic goals, and guide them to develop socially responsible citizens. The programme's emphasis is on nurturing bright students to transform into scholars in their respective disciplines in socially useful ways.

With these ideas, the WWS Scheme hope to provide students with opportunities for learning to achieve the following main purcomes.

The activities for the academic year 2019-20 were planned and charted. WWS Coordinators meeting in connection with the Guidelines of 1st year WWS Programme held at
Loyola College Sreekaryam on 21.08.2019. Since the scheme recommends that the scholars
and internal mentors be from the same department, the College council held on 27th August
2019 identified five departments that will participate in the 1st year WWS programme.
College Council selected the following departments: Two departments from Science Batch
Two from Language Batch and One from Social science- Chemistry and polymer chemistry,
Botany, History, Sanskrit, and Hindi. 5 Permanent teaching faculties are selected from these
departments as Internal Mentors.

A total of 6 bright students are selected from each department and allotted concerned mentors. Now we have 15 Internal mentors - Five Internal mentors for 3rd Year Degree Batch Five Internal mentors for 2nd Year and Five Internal mentors for 1st Years having 90 scholars(6 mentees /one Internal Mentor). A list of internal mentors and the students allotted to them are enclosed. Two of our Internal Mentors got an opportunity to attend 2 day Master mentors training workshop on 29th August 2019. smt Maya P.K Assistant Professor in Economics was appointed as the co-ordinator, WWS 2019-20.

Internal Mentoring

Mentoring sessions were held at least once every month according to the convenience of the mentees and the mentors. The sessions included lectures, discussions and activities. Mentors assigned homework to their concerned mentees. All mentees have kept a diary for writing their achievements about each Internal and external session. After the sessions mentors take the feedback.

I Year Internal Mentoring: There is a total of 10 Internal Mentoring sessions for I year. The components of the I year Internal sessions are-know your scholar, Philosophy of discipline, self-directed learning, critical thinking and interdisciplinary, Identifying personal strength and personal action plan, Book review and SWOT analysis. II Year Internal Mentoring There is a total of 7 Internal Mentoring sessions for II Year. Components of the later is resistant are the Basis of research, Discussing a journal article concerned with the Mentees subject, Higher education opportunities,

- Review of personal development plan etc. Though the mentees subjects are different from mentors it shows difficult to manage the components of internal mentoring.
- III Year Internal Mentoring: In the third year there are only 6 Internal Mentoring sessions for III Year. Components of the Internal sessions are preparing CV/Biodata, Interview preparation skills, presentation of the personal development plan and conducting a mock interview with all scholars.

External Mentoring

A panel of external mentors has been prepared in consultation with the mentees and internal mentors. Eminent personalities who made remarkable contributions in their fields have been included in the panel. We have tried our best to include all components of external mentoring sessions as per Guidelines. Only those experts who have conducted mentoring classes elsewhere and Experts from KSM DB College who have excellent feedback were invited for this programme. The class were arranged according to the convenience of the mentees. The mentoring programmes were conducted on Saturdays/ Sundays/Holidays to ensure that the mentees will not miss out on their regular classes. The feedback from the students reveals that they are highly benefitted from these external mentoring sessions. The External Mentoring sessions started in October 2019.

There is a total of 18 External Mentoring sessions conducted for I years. The components of each session are Review of Academic Book: To review Book, Coordinator Purchased Books "Wings of Fire" for each mentee as per External Mentor's suggestion and he dictated each mentees performance. Other components are- Essential aspects of Research, SWOT analysis, Goal setting; Meet two experts through Interactions, Arts and self-development and understanding Constitution and democratic values. There are 7 External Mentoring sessions conducted for II years. The components of each session are Review journal article- here also Book "Wings of fire provided for review Book, Learn a soft skill and presentation skills, Gender sensitization and Environment Sensitisation. To know students gender sensitisation our second years mentees prepared a questionnaire and conducted a survey and prepared a learn re-ching the Topic. For Know Environment

problems in cooperation with Botany Department, second-year mentees conducted an awareness campaign regarding the protection of Sasthamcotta Lake.

ASAP (ADDITIONAL SKILL ACQUISITION PROGRAMME)



Additional Skill Acquisition Programme (ASAP), a joint initiative of General and Higher Education Departments, was launched with an objective to impart quality skill education to the higher secondary / undergraduate students alongside their regular curriculum. ASAP trainees shall undergo a mandatory soft skill training programme of 180 hours. The module includes 100 hrs of Communication module and basic IT module of 80 hours. Foundation module helps students improve their presentation skills, rise their confidence level, groom them to be a better individual by inculcating moral values etc. Skill course training of 120 – 250 hrs is carried out at various Skill Development Centres across the State. Regular mode of training delivers soft skill and industrial skill training to the students. A maximum of 35 students can be enrolled from the institution every year. Training is timed as prior to or after the regular class schedules to suit the convenience of the institution, students and the professional trainer appointed by the ASAP.

National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL)

National Programme on Technology Enhanced Learning (NPTEL) is a project of MHRD initiated by seven Indian Institutes of Technology (Bombay, Delhi, Kanpur, Kharagpur, Madras, Guwahati and Roorkee) along with the Indian Institute of Science, Bangalore in 2003, to provide quality education to anyone interested in learning from the IITs. The main goal was to create web and video courses in all major branches of engineering and physical sciences at the undergraduate and postgraduate levels and management courses at the postgraduate level. NPTEL provides Online Certification Courses through an online portal with 4 to 8 or 12-week online courses, typically on topics relevant to students in all years of higher education along with basic core courses in sciences and humanities with exposure to relevant tools and technologies. NPTEL provides FDP courses also. The significance of Local Chapter in an institution is to develop a local link between students/faculty in the institution and SWAYAM-NPTEL. Once an institution becomes a SWAYAM Local Chapter, they will be able to better facilitate the MOOC adoption of the students as the portal provides sufficient features for allowing monitoring of learner progress to the faculty and SWAYAM coordinator (or Single Point of Contact) within the institution. Recently our college has been established as Local SWAYAM-NPTEL chapter co-ordinated by IIT Madras with ID (LC ID) 4027 and Dr.Shemeena Basheer N, Assistant Professor, Department of Physics has been selected as the single point of contact (SPOC). 





The resource persons conducted periodical tests and assignments and given back to the students after correction. They assessed the progress of the students accordingly. Three sessions of one hour duration each were handled on topics. The teachers were allowed only for one session after which there sessions were completely dedicated for the selected students of SSP. The general feed back about the sessions showed that the students were impressed. They expressed their heart felt feeling that sessions like this should be extended to their parents. Then only it will be completely beneficial. The students were motivated well and they were freely and actively interacting with the resource person. A two hour mentoring session was handled by D. R. College, Sasthamacotta. He concentrated well after the communication and Career Perspectives to the students. It was on 04th Maps, 2017.



LANGUAGE LAB




