The supervising teacher shall collect and keep the transfer certificate of the candidate so as to ensure that they do not undergo any other course either Full Time or Part Time before the submission of thesis.

The maximum period for Full Time Ph.D. research is five years and that of Part Time Ph.D research is eight years after which the registration shall automatically lapse.

The following regulations will be applicable to those who register for Ph.D research from July 2009 onwards.

Part-time research scholars working/residing outside the headquarters of the supervising teachers shall spend a period of at least six months at a stretch or in not more than three instalments at the centre of research before they are allowed to submit the thesis.

A course work of six months duration is introduced for all Ph.D programmes. There will be three papers for the course work with one paper on Research Methodology and two other papers related to the area of research. Candidates who have passed the M.Phil degree course, which offers Research Methodology, are exempted from writing the examination of Research Methodology. The research scholars are eligible to appear for the examination after six months from the date of registration. The Syllabus for the paper will be framed by the Supervising teacher and approved by the Doctoral Committee.

The Ph.D. thesis can be submitted only after passing the examination of the course work. A maximum of three attempts will be allowed for passing the examination of the course work. Those who do not pass the examination of the course work within two years from the date of registration will not be allowed to continue the programme. This is applicable to Pull Time and Part Time researchers.

A pre-submission seminar conducted in the Research Centre is one of the requirements for submission of thesis. Students who have passed the coursework examinations and have successfully undergone at least two annual progress assessment by the doctoral committee and are in the final stages of research are eligible to apply for the pre-submission presentation. One publication in an approved journal and one presentation in a National/International Seminar are pre-requisites for submission of thesis.

The pre-submission will be organised in the concerned Research Centre and will be conducted by a Board consisting of the Doctoral Committee and an external expert from outside the Department / Research Centre. Recommendations of the Board has to be included in the thesis.

Full time research scholars are eligible to apply for University Junior Research Fellowship, with effect from the date of registration and within three months of this order. The research scholars shall pay the fee as prescribed from time to time (See www.research.keralauniversity.ac.in for fee details). An affiliation fee of ₹400 shall be remitted along with the research fee. Research scholars except SC/ST students shall remit an amount of ₹1000 as annual fee for meeting the expenses towards the conduct of open defence.

As per University Order No.Ac.E1.A/2013 dtd 23.10.13, the recipients of time bound fellowships shall be given a time limit of two years for passing the course work examination with effect from the date of University Order granting registration.

The Ph.D scholar has to obtain a minimum of 'B' Grade in the UGC 7-point scale in the course work with a minimum of 55% marks in order to be eligible to continue in the programme and submit the thesis.

The scholar shall make a pre-submission presentation of the thesis in the Department, before a Board consisting of Department Doctoral Committee, an external expert and Dean of the Faculty concerned.

Pre-submission presentation shall be open to all faculty members and research scholars/students, and the feedback and comments obtained from the participants may be suitably incorporated into the draft thesis, as advised by the Board.

Ph.D scholars shall publish at least one research paper in referred journal, duly approved by the UGC/University, and make two paper presentations in conferences/seminars, recognized by the Department Council concerned, before the submission of the thesis for adjudication and produce evidence for the same in the form of presentation of certificates and reprints.

The thesis submitted for adjudication shall contain an undertaking from the research scholar and a certificate from the Research Supervisor attesting to the originality of the work, vouching that there is no plaglarism using the software approved by UGC/ University and that the work has not been submitted for the award of any other degree/ diploma of the University or to any other Institution.

University of Kerala has adopted the Green Charter, available in the University website, which shall be adhered to by the research scholars and the Research Departments/Research Centres.

Full time research scholars are eligible to apply for University Junior Research Fellowship, with effect from the date of registration and within three months of this order.

The research scholars shall pay the fee as prescribed from time to time, the details of which are available in the University website www.research.keralauniversity.ac.in.

An affiliation fee of Rs.420 shall be remitted along with the research fee during the first year of registration. Research scholars except SC/ST students shall remit an amount of Rs.1050 as annual fee for meeting the expenses towards the conduct of open defence.

The first instalment of the research fee shall be remitted within one month from the date of the registration order. In case of those candidates who fail to remit the fees within one month the payment can be made within 6 months from the effective date of registration of the candidate, with a fine of Rs.55/-, to be paid along with the research fee. Further period of remittance of research fee during the entire course of research shall be counted w.e.f. the effective date of registration.

A research scholar who causes a break of more than 6 months in the research work or defaults payment of research fee for more than six months get the registration automatically cancelled and in such cases reregistration is to be obtained.
