The students of our college succeeded in transforming the 5-acre barren land on the banks of the Sasthamcotta Lake into a field of ripe pineapples within a short span of time and reaped the fruits of their labour too. The harvest was a good one consisting of about 2000 pineapples.

This project, which included the cultivation of vegetables and fodder along with pineapple, was the joint venture of 'Subhiksha Keralam' Project of The Government of Kerala, 'Devaharitham Project' of Travancore Devaswom Board and 'Harithalayam Project' of NSS. Support was rendered by PTA too.

The students of NSS and NCC toiled in the barren land to make this venture a huge success. Even in the time of the Covid 19 pandemic, 20 students each sweated out in the land following Covid Protocol.

Within a year, the students reaped the harvest of their labour. The method of farming was fully automatic. Dr. Geethakrishnan Nair of Botany Department gave timely suggestions and guidance. Smt. Binisha, Agriculture Officer, was with the students during all the stages of farming right from the selection of seeds to harvesting.







# RECOVERY TOWARDS DYNAMIC AND RESILIENT INTERVENTIONS TO COMBAT COVID 19 PANDEMIC

The college, as a community the students, teachers, the various clubs and forums was actively engaged in activities aimed at combating the covid 19 pandemic and the ensuing social problems. The drive against the pandemic can be categorised into two awareness programmes and surveys conducted by the college for students and local community and secondly a plethora of activities for actual intervention and alleviation of covid related personal and The range of proactive approaches can be seen in the student who social miseries. volunteered to disinfect covid infected households to the student who conducted the funeral of a person who died of covid, and teachers discharging their official duty in covid first line treatment centres. This becomes even more significant since these interventions were done at a time when the stigma, social ostracizing and fear generated by covid was at its zenith. The programmes include distribution of masks to the Taluk Hospital, aiding online teaching learning process through supplying television and gadgets for online learning to the financially backward students, NCC cadets performing harbour duty and organizing creative endeavours of students to keep them emotionally, socially and academically equipped to fight the covid menace

NSS volunteers took active part in supporting the society in various ways to live with, and overcome the trials and tribulations unleashed on families by the pandemic. At a time when people who died of covid were denied even an honourable cremation or burial, one of our NSS volunteers, Ananthakrishnan, a student of II BA Malayalam, helped to conduct the funeral of a patient who died of covid, a person named John Mathai from Udayamangalam. He risked his life and inspite of the stigma and practices related to covid prevalent at that time, he personally did everything that was needed to bury the dead body on 14 May 2021





Our college inculcates the social value and responsibilities of the faculty members, staff and students by imparting extension activities in the neighbourhood. All faculty members, non-teaching staff and students of the Chemistry department are engaged in the extension activities.

Kerala, was the first state in the country to report coronavirus infection in January 2020. Department of Chemistry has conducted some awareness classes among students, their parents and local people through kudumbasree. In March 2020 our department staffs have prepared around 100 litres of hand sanitizer under the name "Mukthi" strictly following WHO regulations. First batch was supplied to all departments and staffs in our college. Second batch is prepared for the students who are coming to college for examination and various purposes.

As many cases of Covid 19 reported in Kerala in the midst of March, there was a shortage of hand sanitizer all around our country. There is an urgent need of hand sanitizers in hospitals and in emergency services. We have prepared a third batch and were given to the medical officer, Taluk hospital, Sasthamkotta free of cost. 5 litres are given to the treasury department which is also an essential service during this season. Another batch is supplied to the nationalised Banks including Indian Bank, SBI, South Indian Bank, Co-operative Bank Etc. About 50 litres of hand sanitizer prepared is given to Travancore Devaswom board, to use in their offices and temples all over Kerala. We have also given awareness among staff and students about the importance of social distancing and wearing masks.

The report of Rapid Impact Assessment of flood on Biodiversity is a collaborative effort of Biodiversity Management Committee (BMC) and Kerala State Biodiversity (KSBB) with the technical inputs from a wide range of research institutes and stake holders. The objective of the process was to undertake a rapid assessment of the damages to ecosystem and Biodiversity after the floods and to lay the foundation for a recovery and ecosystem-based reconstruction process at local level. The biodiversity club coordinator has participated as Field Expert in the "Rapid Assessment Survey on Impact of Flood on Biodiversity-Community Perspective" conducted by the Kerala State Biodiversity Board, Government of Kerala from October 2018- November 2018.A Joint team of subject experts (Dhanya S.R, Biodiversity convener) and 5 Biodiversity club members (Rahul.S, Adarsh.M, Jegath.S, Arun.P and Sonu.S) with representation from KSBB was constituted to conduct a rapid impact assessment of floods in Munroe Islands. Theteam visited the affected areas and data was collected in a prescribed format using Open DataKit software. Our team visited the affected areas in Munroe Islands to understand the extent and the nature of damage and record the findings.

The biodiversity club conducted a one-day Nature Camp at Shendurney Wild life Sanctuary. Students and faculty went on a field trip to Shendurney Wild Life Sanctuary on 22.12.2018. The sanctuary has thick forest cover and is also noted for many exotic plants, some of which are medically important. Four different types of vegetation have been found in Shenduruny. They include: West Coast tropical evergreen forest, West Coast tropical semi-evergreen forest, Southern moist mixed deciduous forest and the Southern hilltop tropical evergreen forest. Of these four, the tropical evergreen forest comprises one fourth of the total Shenduruny forest area. The Shenduruny forest, which was declared a wildlife sanctuary in 1984, gets its name from an endemic species of tree called Chenkuruny or Shenkuruny (Gluta travancoria). In the central region of this moist, mixed deciduous forest, spread over a hilly terrain of over 100 sq km is the 26 sq km artificial lake formed by the Parappar dam built across the Shenduruny and Kulathupuzha rivers.

## WATER QUALITY ANALYSIS OF SASTHAMCOTTA LAKE AND WELL WATER SAMPLES FROM THE PANCHAYATH

With the involvement students of Department of Botany and of members of Bhoomitra Sena club, physicochemical and microbiological analysis of water quality of Sasthamkotta lake and well samples of Sasthamkotta Panchayat were conducted. Study was conducted under the supervision of Ms.Lekshmy Sreekumar, Assistant Professor of Department of Botany. Head of the Department of Botany, Dr. P. Geeta Krishnan Nair and Ms.Dhanya S.R, Assistant Professor of Department of Botany, valuablesuggestions. Eight students from the department of botany participated in the study, conducted on 18-12 -2020. Water pollution caused by fecal contamination is a serious problem due to the potential for contracting diseases from pathogens. The presence of pathogens is determined with indirect evidence by testing for an "indicator & quot; organism such as coliform bacteria. Coliforms are relatively easy to identify, are usually present in larger numbers than more dangerous pathogens. As a result, testing for coliform bacteria can be a reasonable indication of whether other pathogenic bacteria are present or not. Drinking water and well water samples from different localities of the Sasthankotta panchayath and different parts of lake was analysed for coliform testing Altogether 20samples were analysed for preliminary screening. Those samples tested positive were further subjected to physicochemical and microbiological analysis in CEPCI (Cashew Export Promotion Council Of India) for testing total coliforms and the two subgroups thermotolerant faecal coliforms and E.Coli. The results indicated that the water tested was highly contaminated with the fecal material of man or other animals. The Presence of fecal contamination is an indicator that a potential health risk exists for individuals exposed to this

water. Fecal coliform bacteria may occur in ambient water as a result of the overflow of domestic sewage or nonpoint sources of human and animal waste. Thus, the public around the locality were advised to take proper measures to solve this issue. Program 2. Awareness campaign was conducted among common people to promote sustainable development goals.

As a part of extension activities of Department of Botany drinking water and well water samples from different localities of Sasthamkotta Panchayath and different parts of the lake was analyzed for coliform bacteria. The study was conducted under the guidance of Ms.Lekshmy Sreekumar Head of the Department of Botany, Dr.P. Geeta Krishnan Nair and Ms.Dhanya S.R, Assistant Professor of Department of Botany, also offered valuable suggestions. . Eight students from the department of botany participated in the study, conducted on 11-12 -2019. Students of the Department of botany participated in the collection of samples. Altogether twenty samples were analyzed for preliminary screening. Those samples tested positive were further subjected to microbiological analysis in CEPCI (Cashew Export Promotion Council of India) for testing total coliforms and the two subgroups thermotolerant fecal coliforms and E.coli. The result indicated that the water tested was contaminated highly with fecal materials. Water pollution caused by fecal contamination is a serious problem due to the potential for contracting diseases from pathogens. The presence of pathogens is determined with indirect evidence by testing for an "indicator" organism such as coliform bacteria. Coliforms are easy to identify, are usually present in larger numbers than more dangerous pathogens and respond to the environment, waste water treatment and water treatment similarly to many pathogens. As a result, testing for coliform bacteria can be a reasonable indication of whether other pathogenic bacteria are present. Awareness programmes were conducted and the public people around the locality were advised to take proper measures to solve the coliform problem.

Department of botany analysed the water quality of Sasthamcotta lake under the supervision of Ms.Lekshmy Sreekumar . Eight students from the department of botany participated in thwe study, conducted on 11-02-2018. Samples from different localities of Sasthamkotta Panchayath and different parts of the lake were analyzed for coliform bacteria. Altogether twenty samples were analyzed for preliminary screening. The result indicated that the water tested was contaminated highly with faecal materials. Water pollution caused by fecal contamination is a serious problem due to the potential for contracting diseases from pathogens. The presence of pathogens is determined with indirect evidence by testing for an "indicator" organism such as coliform bacteria. Coliforms are easy to identify, are usually present in larger numbers. As a result, testing for coliform bacteria can be a reasonable indication of whether other pathogenic bacteria are present. Thus, the public people around the locality were advised to take proper measures to solve the coliform problem. It can sometimes be solved with relatively simple actions like chlorination, boiling, and adding disinfectants. Thus, awareness programs were conducted to revive the quality of Sasthamcotta Lake.
