Trincomalee – Sri Lanka's Eastern Coastal Gem

Trincomalee (known as Trinco) is a beautiful coastal city on Sri Lanka's east coast, famous for its pristine beaches, natural harbour, marine life, and rich cultural heritage.

Fort Frederick is a historic coastal fort located on Swami Rock in Trincomalee, offering spectacular views of the Indian Ocean and Trincomalee Harbour.

Built by the Portuguese in 1624 and later controlled by the Dutch and British. Entrance to the famous Koneswaram Temple is through the fort grounds. Visitors can often see deer roaming freely inside the fort area.

Fort Frederick is a unique place where colonial history, Hindu heritage, and natural beauty come together in the heart of Trincomalee.

Koneswaram Temple (also called Thirukoneswaram Kovil) is one of Sri Lanka's most important Hindu temples, located on the top of Swami Rock in Trincomalee, overlooking the Indian Ocean.

An ancient temple site with roots dating back over two millennia, it is considered one of the historic Pancha Ishwarams (five ancient Shiva temples of Sri Lanka).

Nilaveli and Uppuveli Beaches are two of the most beautiful and popular beaches on Sri Lanka's east coast, located near Trincomalee.

Nilaveli Beach: Famous for its long stretch of soft white sand, clear blue waters, and peaceful atmosphere. It is the gateway to Pigeon Island National Park, a top spot for snorkeling and marine exploration.

Uppuveli Beach: A lively yet relaxing beach area known for swimming, beachfront restaurants, water activities, and beautiful sunrises.

Together, Nilaveli and Uppuveli offer the perfect combination of crystal-clear waters, golden sands, and unforgettable seaside experiences in Trincomalee.

Pigeon Island National Park is one of Sri Lanka's most famous marine parks, located off the coast of Nilaveli Beach near Trincomalee. It is named after the rock pigeons that inhabit the island.

Famous for colorful coral reefs, tropical fish, and clear turquoise waters ideal for snorkeling and diving and features white sandy beaches, rocky landscapes, and crystal-clear seas.

Kanniya Hot Springs is a unique site featuring seven natural hot water wells, each with a slightly different temperature. These springs are closely linked to local legends and have been a place of cultural and historical importance for centuries.

Nallur Kandaswamy Temple one of the most revered Hindu temples in Sri Lanka. Admire its impressive golden architecture, beautifully decorated shrines, and peaceful spiritual atmosphere while learning about its rich history and cultural significance.

Jaffna Public Library, one of Asia's most famous libraries and an important symbol of education, culture, and resilience. Surrounded by beautiful gardens, the library is admired for its elegant architecture and significant place in Sri Lanka's history.

Excursion to Nainativu Island Travel to the jetty and board a local ferry to Nagadeepa (Nainativu Island), a small island renowned for its religious harmony and cultural significance. Nagapooshani Amman Temple one of the 64 sacred Shakti Peethas dedicated to Goddess Parvati. Admire its colourful Dravidian architecture, beautifully sculptured towers, and vibrant spiritual atmosphere.

Nagadeepa Purana Viharaya an important Buddhist pilgrimage site believed to have been visited by Lord Buddha. Experience the peaceful surroundings while learning about the island's religious and historical importance.

Keerimalai Springs a natural freshwater spring located beside the sea. Famous for its clear, mineral-rich freshwater pools believed by locals to have healing and spiritual properties. It is also one of the most significant cultural landmarks in Northern Sri Lanka.

Casuarina Beach one of the most beautiful beaches in Jaffna. With its shallow turquoise waters, soft white sand, and peaceful surroundings, it is an ideal place to relax, take photographs, or simply enjoy the refreshing sea breeze.
