SUGGESTED ITINERARY

DAY 01: ARRIVE AHMEDABAD TRANSFER TO JAMNAGAR (330 KMS / 7 HRS DRIVE)

- Arrive Ahmedabad airport in the morning.
- After collecting your baggage, meet your driver in the arrival hall
- Drive to Jamnagar
- Arrive Jamnagar and check in hotel
- After fresh n up, depart for the panoramic sightseeing of Jamnagar including Bala Hanuman Temple - Bala Hanuman Temple is a pilgrim place venerated by the devotees of Lord Ram. It is a world - famous temple, known for the continuous chanting of Jai Ram, Shri Ram. The chanting is going on since 1964 and has found a place for it in the Guinness Book of World Records. People chant the name of the Lord in shifts, 24 hours a day.
- Arrive back to hotel for dinner & overnight stay

DAY 02: JAMNAGAR – DWARKA (140 KMS / 3 HRS)

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Check out and drive to Dwarka
- Arrive Dwarka and check into hotel.
- After fresh – n - up, depart to visit **Bet Dwarka, Nageshwar Jyotirling & Rukmani Temple.**
- Dinner and overnight stay at hotel.

DAY 03: DWARKA – PORBANDAR – SOMNATH (310 KMS / 8 - 10 HRS DRIVE)

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Check out and proceed to Porbandar.
- Arrive Porbandar and visit Kirti temple, known as house & birthplace of Mahatma Gandhi. Also visit Gandhi Museum, Study room of Mahatma Gandhi in the Kirti temple.
- Later visit Sudama Temple & then continue drive to Somnath
- Arrive Somnath and check in hotel
- In the evening, transfer to Somnath Temple to witness the evening aarti & darshan at the Temple - A lord Shiva temple known as Jyotirling built by Moon God.
- Enjoy lighting and sounding Show also.
- Arrive back to the hotel for dinner and overnight stay



DAY 04: SOMNATH – DIU (90 KMS / 2.5 HR DRIVE)

- Breakfast at hotel
- Check out and drive to Diu,
- Arrive Diu and visit St. Paul's church, Diu Fort & markets. St. Paul's church - St. Paul's church is dedicated to our Lady of Immaculate Conception. The construction of the church was started in 1601 and was completed in the year 1610. The main facade of the church is perhaps the most elaborate of all Portuguese churches in India. The wood - paneling of the church is rated one of the best in church craftsmanship.
Diu Fort: It is an expansive and imposing structure, situated on the coast of the island. The fort commands a magnificent view of sea. It was constructed between 1535 and 1541 AD. The fort is skirted by the Sea on the three sides. On the fort stands a giant Light House. Several canons still stare menacingly from top. The main front wall has five huge windows with stone galleries. The Fort has been creatively lit, which creates a breath - taking views at night.
- Spend your evening in the local market
- Check in hotel for dinner and overnight stay

DAY 05: DIU – SASANGIR (100 KMS / 2.5 HRS DRIVE)

- Breakfast at hotel
- Check out and drive to Sasangir, Gir National Park, this park has been the only habitat of the Asiatic lion. During the British Raj, lions were hunted mercilessly by the British officers assisted by the obliging Maharajas and Nawabs. Every Maharaja was proud of the number of lions or tigers he killed during his lifetime. The Government of India banned the hunting of lion in the mid - 1960 and now this park is open only for the photo safaris. The Gir National Park later became a major tourist attraction in India. About 300 lions are found in this park.
- Arrive Sasangir and check into the hotel
- Day free to do jeep safari or any other activities on your own
- Dinner and overnight stay at Sasangir.

DAY 06: SASANGIR – JUNAGADH – AHMEDABAD (375 KMS / 8.5 HRS DRIVE)

- Breakfast at hotel
- Check out and proceed to Junagadh,
- Arrive Junagadh and visit **UPERKOT FORT** is an ancient fort built by Chandra Gupta. The fort has been rebuilt & extended many times.
- Later visit Ashokan Edicts, Mahabat Maqbara. The Ashoka's Rock edict is on way of Girnar hill temple. The rock engraved with the Buddhist edicts of Ashoka. The edicts impart moral instruction on dharma, harmony, tolerance and peace.
- Afterwards drive to Ahmedabad.
- Arrive Ahmedabad in the evening and check into the hotel
- Dinner and overnight stay at Ahmedabad.



DAY 07: DEPART AHMEDABAD

- Breakfast at the hotel
- Check out and visit Akshardham Temple (Monday Closed) Akshardham is situated in the capital city of Gandhinagar, which lies near Ahmedabad. The magnificent temple is dedicated to Lord Swaminarayan. It was constructed in the direction of Pramukh Swami Maharaj, the spiritual leader of BAPS Sanstha. The complex of this temple is the largest in Gujarat. It has a sprawling 23 - acre area and is chiseled out in pink sandstone.
- Shopping in the afternoon
- In the evening, transfer to airport to board the flight back home.
