ITINERARY

DAY 1: ARRIVAL IN PARO – TRANSFER TO THIMPHU

- Welcome to the Kingdom of Bhutan! Upon arrival at Paro International Airport, meet and greet by our local representative.
- Proceed on a scenic drive to Thimphu, the charming capital city of Bhutan.
- En route, enjoy breathtaking views of the Himalayan mountains, picturesque valleys, and traditional Bhutanese villages.
- Upon arrival, check in to the hotel and relax.
- Later, visit the vibrant Weekend Market (*operates from Thursday to Sunday*), where local vendors sell fresh produce, traditional handicrafts, textiles, spices, and souvenirs.
- Spend the evening exploring the local surroundings at leisure.
- Return to the hotel.

DAY 2: THIMPHU CITY TOUR

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Proceed for a full-day sightseeing tour of Thimphu.
- Visit the Handmade Paper Mill, where traditional Bhutanese paper is produced using age-old techniques and natural materials.
- Continue to the School of Arts & Crafts, renowned for preserving Bhutan's thirteen traditional arts, including painting, wood carving, embroidery, and sculpture.
- Visit the Folk Heritage Museum, offering a fascinating insight into Bhutan's rural lifestyle, culture, and traditional architecture.
- Explore the National Library of Bhutan, home to an extensive collection of ancient Buddhist manuscripts and historical documents.
- Visit the magnificent Buddha Dordenma, one of the world's tallest Buddha statues, overlooking the beautiful Thimphu Valley.

- Continue to Changangkha Lhakhang, one of Thimphu's oldest and most revered Buddhist temples.
- Visit the Takin Preserve, home to Bhutan's unique national animal, the Takin.
- End the day with a visit to Zilukha Nunnery (Drubthob Goemba), a peaceful monastery offering panoramic views of the valley.
- Return to the hotel.

DAY 3: THIMPHU – PARO

- Breakfast at the hotel and check out.
- Drive back to the picturesque town of Paro, surrounded by lush green valleys and majestic mountains.
- Upon arrival, check in to the hotel.
- Visit the famous Paro Eco Bridge, one of Bhutan's longest suspension bridges, beautifully decorated with colorful Buddhist prayer flags.
- Enjoy stunning views of the Paro River and surrounding landscapes.
- Spend the remaining day at leisure exploring the peaceful town of Paro or shopping for local handicrafts and souvenirs.
- Return to the hotel.

DAY 4: PARO SIGHTSEEING

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Proceed for a full-day sightseeing tour of Paro.
- Visit the historic Rinpung Dzong, one of Bhutan's finest examples of traditional architecture and an important religious and administrative center.
- Explore the National Museum of Bhutan (Ta Dzong), showcasing Bhutan's rich history, art, culture, and heritage.
- Visit the sacred Kyichu Lhakhang, one of the oldest and most revered temples in Bhutan.
- Enjoy free time to stroll through the charming streets of Paro and explore local markets offering handicrafts, textiles, prayer flags, and souvenirs.
- Return to the hotel after sightseeing.

DAY 5: DEPARTURE

- Breakfast at the hotel.
- Check out from the hotel.
- Transfer to Paro International Airport for your onward journey.
- Depart with unforgettable memories of Bhutan's breathtaking landscapes, rich Buddhist heritage, peaceful monasteries, and warm hospitality.

- Daily Buffet Breakfast at the hotel (from Day 2 onwards).
- Return Airport Transfers by Air-Conditioned Private Vehicle.
- All Intercity Transfers and Sightseeing Tours by Air-Conditioned Private Vehicle as per the itinerary.
- Visit to the Weekend Market (Thursday–Sunday, subject to operation).
- Thimphu City Tour including Handmade Paper Mill, School of Arts & Crafts, Folk Heritage Museum, National Library, Buddha Dordenma, Changangkha Lhakhang, Takin Preserve, and Zilukha Nunnery.
- Visit to Paro Eco Bridge.
- Paro Sightseeing including Rinpung Dzong, National Museum (Ta Dzong), and Kyichu Lhakhang.
