Namib Desert (02N) -Swakopmund(02N) -Damaraland(02N) –Kaokoland(01N)- Epupa(01N)

DAY 01: ARRIVAL NAIROBI – NAMIB DESERT

After breakfast, you will be picked up from your hotel in Windhoek and begin your journey south to Sossusvlei. Travel via the scenic Spreetshoogte Pass, one of Namibia's most breathtaking mountain passes, offering spectacular panoramic views of the surrounding landscapes. En route, stop for lunch at Solitaire, a charming oasis nestled in the heart of the Namib Desert. Upon arrival at the lodge, check in and spend the remainder of the afternoon at leisure. Enjoy dinner and an overnight stay at the lodge.

DAY 02: SOSSUSVLEI

After an early breakfast, depart before sunrise for a scenic drive through Sesriem Gate to Sossusvlei, home to the world's highest sand dunes and part of the UNESCO-listed Namib Sand Sea. Enjoy the opportunity to climb the famous Dune 45, then continue by 4×4 to visit the stunning Deadvlei, known for its ancient dead acacia trees and dramatic desert scenery.

After lunch, visit Sesriem Canyon and Elim Dune before returning to the lodge. In the evening, enjoy dinner and an overnight stay at the lodge.

DAY 03: NAMIB – SWAKOPMUND & ATLANTIC COAST

After breakfast, depart for Swakopmund through the scenic Namib-Naukluft Park, enjoying views of canyons, rock formations, and the vast Namib Desert landscape.

Along the way, spot wildlife such as oryx, springbok, mountain zebras, giraffes, and ostriches. Stop at the Tropic of Capricorn for photos before continuing to Walvis Bay. Visit the Walvis Bay Lagoon to see flamingos and other bird species before arriving in Swakopmund.

DAY 04: SWAKOPMUND

Today full day at leisure on your own to explore place on own or you can opt for optional activities. Overnight at Swakopmund.

DAY 05: SWAKOPMUND – DAMARALAND

After breakfast, travel north along the coastal salt road to Cape Cross, home to a large colony of Cape Fur Seals. After visiting the seal colony, continue east into the desert region of Damaraland towards the impressive Brandberg Massif, one of Namibia's most spectacular landscapes.

Along the way, pass through Damara villages and enjoy opportunities to spot wildlife such as ostriches, jackals, hyenas, and springboks.

DAY 06: DAMARALAND

Today, explore the fascinating Twyfelfontein Rock Engravings, a UNESCO World Heritage Site and one of Africa's largest collections of ancient petroglyphs. Discover some of the most impressive carvings, created centuries ago by the San people on the region's rusty-orange rocks.

The site offers a unique insight into the cultural, spiritual, and daily life practices of ancient hunter-gatherer communities in southern Africa.

DAY 07: DAMARLAND – KAOKOLAND

After breakfast, depart for Opuwo in the Kaokoland region. On arrival, visit a traditional Himba village to experience the unique culture and lifestyle of the semi-nomadic Himba people. Enjoy time to interact with the local community before returning for an overnight stay.

DAY 08: KAOKOLAND – EPUPA FALLS

After breakfast, visit a traditional Himba village to learn about the unique culture, customs, and way of life of the semi-nomadic Himba people.

Later, continue north to the beautiful Epupa Falls on the Kunene River, which forms the natural border between Namibia and Angola. Upon arrival, explore the falls and, in the late afternoon, climb Kapika Hill to enjoy panoramic views of Epupa Falls at sunset.

Overnight stay at the lodge.

DAY 09: EPUPA – ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK

After breakfast, depart for Etosha National Park, one of Namibia's most famous and visited wildlife reserves. Enter the park through Anderson Gate and enjoy the stunning scenery of white salt plains and open landscapes. In the afternoon, enjoy a game drive through the park, where you may spot a variety of wildlife, including elephants, rhinos, lions, leopards, cheetahs, hyenas, giraffes, zebras, and antelopes.

DAY 10: ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK

Today, a full day unlimited game drive in Etosha National Park, from sunrise till sunset.

DAY 11: ETOSHA NATIONAL PARK

Today full day unlimited game drive in Etosha National Park, from sunrise till sunset.

DAY 12: DEPARTURE

After breakfast, bid farewell to Etosha National Park and travel south to Windhoek, the capital city of Namibia. Enjoy time for last-minute shopping at the local open-air craft market, where you can find gifts, souvenirs, and traditional curios. Take the final opportunity to capture beautiful photos of Namibia's stunning landscapes before concluding your journey.
