DAY 01: ARRIVAL - SEOUL

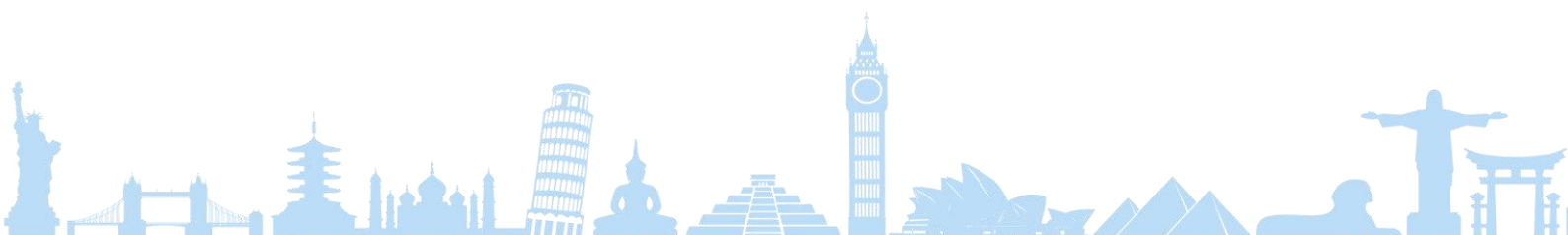
Upon arrival at Incheon International Airport, you will be welcomed by your driver and guide and transferred privately to your hotel in Seoul for check-in. After settling in, proceed to the vibrant district of Myeong-dong, renowned for its bustling shopping streets, street food, and lively atmosphere. Later, enjoy the world-famous Nanta Show, an entertaining non-verbal performance featuring comedy, rhythm, and acrobatics. In the evening, relish dinner at Myeongdong Taj or a similar restaurant before returning to your hotel for an overnight stay in Seoul.

DAY 02: JEJU ISLAND BY FLIGHT

After breakfast at the hotel, check out and transfer to Gimpo International Airport to board your flight to Jeju Island. Upon arrival, enjoy lunch at a local restaurant before meeting your Jeju local guide and transferring to your hotel. After check-in, spend the rest of the day at leisure. In the evening, savor dinner at a local restaurant before returning to the hotel. Overnight stay at the hotel in Jeju Island.

DAY 03: JEJU ISLAND

After breakfast at the hotel, begin your day with a visit to Dongmun Market, one of Jeju's most popular traditional markets, known for its vibrant atmosphere and variety of local products. Continue to Manjanggul Lava Tube, a remarkable natural wonder and one of the world's longest lava tubes, stretching nearly 8.9 kilometers and showcasing the island's unique volcanic landscape. Enjoy lunch at an Indian-friendly vegetarian restaurant or a similar venue before proceeding to the Jeju Haenyeo Museum, which highlights the fascinating history and lifestyle of Jeju's renowned female divers through photographs, exhibits, and cultural displays. The museum also features an observatory offering panoramic views of the Hado-ri area, along with beautifully landscaped gardens and sculptures. Later, visit the iconic Seongsan Ilchulbong, a UNESCO-listed volcanic tuff cone formed by an ancient eruption from the shallow seabed. Its dramatic crater and ring of distinctive rock formations create one of Jeju's most spectacular natural landmarks. In the evening, enjoy dinner at Mt. Everest Restaurant or a similar restaurant before transferring back to your hotel. Overnight stay at the hotel in Jeju Island.

Day 04: JEJU ISLAND

After breakfast at the hotel, proceed to visit Sanbanggalsa Temple, a unique cave temple located on the slopes of Sanbangsan Mountain. Known as the “Sanbang Cave Temple,” it offers a serene atmosphere and beautiful views of the surrounding landscape. Continuing to Yongmeori Coast, often referred to as Dragon Head Beach, where dramatic rock formations and rugged cliffs create a stunning coastal panorama. Enjoy lunch at Yatri Restaurant or a similar restaurant before heading to Cheonjiyeon Waterfall, one of Jeju’s most famous waterfalls, whose name translates to “the pond where heaven and earth meet.” The waterfall cascades gracefully from a height of 22 meters into a picturesque pool surrounded by lush vegetation. Later, visit the spectacular Jusangjeolli Cliff, renowned for its striking hexagonal basalt columns formed by volcanic activity millions of years ago. Continue to Jungmun Saekdal Beach, a beautiful stretch of coastline offering magnificent sea views and a lively atmosphere, popular for swimming, surfing, and other beach activities. In the evening, enjoy dinner at Warda Restaurant or a similar restaurant before returning to your hotel. Overnight stay at the hotel in Jeju Island.

Day 05: JEJU ISLAND TO SEOUL BY FLIGHT

After breakfast at the hotel, check out and transfer to Jeju International Airport to board your flight to Seoul. Upon arrival, enjoy a private transfer and visit Gamcheon Culture Village, known for its colorful hillside houses and artistic charm. Continue to the Seoul Sky observatory at Lotte World Tower, where you can enjoy breathtaking 360-degree views of Seoul from one of the tallest buildings in the world. Lunch will be served at Taj Palace Itaewon or a similar restaurant. Later, visit Bongeunsa, a historic Buddhist temple renowned for its serene atmosphere and impressive Maitreya Buddha statue, followed by a visit to the iconic Starfield Library, a striking cultural space featuring towering bookshelves and contemporary architecture. Drive through the vibrant Gangnam district before enjoying dinner at Chakra Restaurant or a similar restaurant. Thereafter, check in to your hotel and enjoy an overnight stay in Seoul.

DAY 06: DEPARTURE

After breakfast at the hotel, check out and transfer to Incheon International Airport to board your return flight home, carrying your wonderful memories of your South Korea journey.
