1. INTRODUCTION:

1.1 Uttarakhand Ayurved University is the first AYUSH University in Uttarakhand. There are Seven Faculties to be established in the University. These faculties are Ayurveda, Homeopathy, Unani, Siddha, Yoga and Naturopathy, Bio medical Sciences, & Pharmaceutical Sciences. The main objective is to promote the application of basic sciences in the field of AYUSH and evidence-based medicine. Uttarakhand Ayurved University has its 03 Campuses namely Rishikul Campus & Gurukul Campus at Haridwar (U.K) and Faculty of Ayurved, Main Campus at Dehradun. The Faculty of Biomedical Sciences at main campus, Dehradun is one of the main faculties being developed on priority basis and going to be one of the centers of excellence in Ayurvedic research.

1.2 In accordance with the letter of NCISM No- 1/2/2026-AACCC Dated 31-08-2026 and the Gazette of India dated 16-02-2022 (**annexure 1**) pertaining to the Indian Medicine Central Council Amendment Regulations, 2022 for common counseling, a centralized counseling board has been constituted and assigned the task of conducting the UAUC UG- 2026-27 Uttarakhand Ayurved University Centralized online counseling for Campuses of the University and affiliated Private Ayurved, Unani, Homeopathy & Naturopathy Colleges of Uttarakhand State recognized by National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM), Central Council of Homeopathy (CCH), Ministry of AYUSH, GOVT. of India, for the academic session of 2026-27. The Counseling will be conducted based on merit of NEET-2026 examination and eligibility criteria & other terms and conditions and as per direction received from Govt. of India & State Govt. and adopted by the counseling board.

1.3 Centralized counseling will be conducted for following quota of seats: -

1.3.1 B.A.M.S., B.H.M.S. & B.U.M.S. Courses in State Government and Private Colleges Affiliated with Uttarakhand Ayurved University, recognized by NCISM, Central Council of Homeopathy, Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India

- The registered eligible candidates who have qualified NEET (UG)-2026 will get admission against available State quota seats and All India quota seats in B.A.M.S. / B.H.M.S. / B.U.M.S. courses **by centralized online counseling on merit-cum-choice basis.**

2. GENERAL INSTRUCTIONS, TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

2.1 The applicants are required to fill in the application form to register him/her and pay the required registration/counseling fee by ONLINE mode only. The counseling registration fee shall not be refunded under any circumstances.

2.2 The candidates must complete the online application form in all respects and upload his/her photograph & signature (same as submitted in NEET-2026 application form) in the appropriate box. The candidates are further advised to re-check the entries/information given by him/her before submitting them, as there is no option for editing the entries after final submission of application form. After final submission of the form, the candidates are required to take the print of the submitted form (hard copy).

Note- No other means of correspondence will be entertained, once submitted.

2.3 The candidates are advised to retain the copy of the form submitted to the University for their best interest in further reference and queries.

2.4 The candidates are advised to keep at least 05 copies of same photographs (same as submitted in NEET - 2026 application form). The candidates will have to produce the same copy of photographs for entire admission process.

2.5 Depending upon the directions received from time to time by various regulatory bodies like NCISM, CCH, Government of India, State Government and Hon'ble Courts, the Schedule/availability of seats/ Rules/ Terms & Conditions may be subjected to change. Such information will be notified on the university website www.uau.ac.in only. Candidates must refer to the website regularly for any update. No separate intimation will be sent to the candidates.

2.6 Only appearing in the UAUC-UG 2026-27 Uttarakhand Ayurved University counseling does not confer any right to secure a B.A.M.S. / B.H.M.S. / B.U.M.S. course seat. The selection and admission to B.A.M.S. / B.H.M.S. / B.U.M.S. course on a State quota and All India quota seats in University Campuses and Private Colleges affiliated to the University is subject to fulfilling all the eligibility criteria, state reservation policy, other terms & conditions etc. mentioned in the Information Brochure and/or amendments made thereafter till the time of counseling.

2.7 In case the information provided by the candidate is found wrong in the application form, his/her application will be summarily rejected. If any candidate secures admission in the college/institute by providing wrong information in his/her application, detected later in due course, his/her admission will be cancelled at the cost and risk of the candidate. **Hence candidates are advised to fill in the online application form very carefully and re-check before the final submission.**

2.8 Candidate's eligibility is purely provisional and is subject to the fulfillment of eligibility criteria as prescribed in this Information Brochure, during subsequent verifications of his/her documents at counseling, admission or afterwards.

2.9 University/counseling board reserves the right to withdraw permission, if any, granted in advertently to any candidate who is not eligible to appear in the UAUC-UG- 2026-27 centralized counseling even though he got himself registered and paid the required fee.

2.10 Instructions, Terms & Conditions in the Information Brochure are liable to change based on decisions consciously taken by the UAUC-UG-2026-27 counseling Board, Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India and Uttarakhand Government from time to time. There are no equity or any rights that are/or deemed to be arising in favor of candidate.

2.11 The candidate must ensure before filling the application form that he/she fulfils the eligibility requirements for quota of seat he/she is applying for i.e., a state quota and All India quota seats in University Campuses and Private Colleges affiliated to the University. The registration fee once paid shall not be refunded in the event of rejection of the application. Only eligible candidates will be considered for counseling/ admission.

2.12 The candidates are advised to give their complete mailing address, ID proof details and correct contact telephone/mobile numbers and email in the application form.

2.13 The records of Counseling shall be preserved only for a period of one year from the date of the counseling.

2.14 All the matters related to counseling, decision of UAUC-UG 2026-27 Counseling Board and Government of Uttarakhand as the case may be, shall be final and binding to all.

2.15 In case of any ambiguity in interpretation of any of the instructions / terms / rules / criteria the determination of eligibility / conduct of counseling / registration of candidate / information contained herein, the interpretation of the UAUC-UG-2026-27 Counseling Board as the case may be, will be final and binding.

2.16 Only those candidates who have accepted all the terms & conditions mentioned in the Information Brochure should apply.

3. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA FOR UAUC-UG-2026-27 UTTARAKHAND AYURVED UNIVERSITY CENTRALISED COUNSELING

The counseling and admission shall be open to registered candidates only who will fulfill the following criteria:

3.1 Eligibility for B.A.M.S. / B.H.M.S. / B.U.M.S. Courses in Government & Affiliated Private AYUSH Colleges for State Quota of Seats.

3.1.1 Is an Indian citizen.

3.1.2 The eligibility criteria of age for UAUC-UG-2026-27 Uttarakhand Ayurved University Centralized Counseling will be as per the latest guidelines / order of NEET-2026 examination conducting body / Hon'ble courts / NCISM / CCH / Government of India and Government of Uttarakhand.

NOTE: Only NEET-2026 qualified candidates can apply for the admission through UAUC-UG 2026-27.

3.1.3 For BAMS (Bachelor of Ayurvedic Medicine & Surgery), BHMS (Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine & Surgery) & BUMS (Bachelor of Unani Medicine & Surgery): -

- The candidate shall have passed 10+2 (or equivalent) with subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Biotechnology. (Letter no. 1/2/2026-AACCC dated 31-08-2026) (**annexure 1**)

3.1.4 The candidate must have fulfilled all the eligibility criteria mentioned in the UAUC-UG-2026-27 Information Brochure and qualified NEET (UG)-2026 examination that is **“In order to be eligible for admission for a particular academic year it shall be necessary for UR/EWS candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50th percentile in NEET for the said academic year. However, in respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Castes, the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile. In respect of the candidates with bench marked disabilities specified under the Rights of persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile for UR/EWS PwBD category candidates and 40th percentile for SC PwBD / ST PwBD / OBC PwBD candidates. The percentile shall be determined based on highest marks secured in the All-India Common Merit list in NEET- 2026”**

3.1.5 Candidates who are Domicile / Permanent residents of Uttarakhand **and** have passed 10th and/ or Intermediate (10+2) or equivalent examination from a recognized educational institution situated in the State of Uttarakhand.

OR

Candidates who are **not Domicile / not Permanent residents** of Uttarakhand **but** have passed both 10th and Intermediate (10+2) or equivalent examination from a recognized educational institution situated in the State of Uttarakhand shall also be eligible, **but they will not be entitled for any type of reservation.**

However, as mentioned in relevant regulations, relaxation in qualifying criteria may be provided category-wise.

OR

Candidates who are Domicile / Permanent residents of Uttarakhand but have passed 10th and/ or Intermediate (10+2) or equivalent examination from a recognized educational institution situated outside the State of Uttarakhand shall also be eligible.

The candidate claiming him/her as domicile/permanent resident of Uttarakhand has to produce the domicile/permanent resident certificate issued by the competent authority of the state of Uttarakhand

3.2 Eligibility for B.A.M.S. / B.H.M.S. / B.U.M.S. Courses in University Campuses (seats to be filled by AACCC) and affiliated private AYUSH Colleges against All India Quota (AIQ) seats in Private Colleges.

3.2.1 Is an Indian citizen.

3.2.2 The eligibility criteria of age for UAUC- UG 2026-27 Uttarakhand Ayurved University centralized counseling will be as per the latest guidelines /order of NEET -2026 examination conducting body/Hon'ble courts/NCISM/CCH/Government of India and Government of Uttarakhand.

3.2.3 The candidate shall have passed 10+2 (or equivalent) with subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Biotechnology. (Letter no. 1/2/2026-AACCC dated 31-08-2026) **(annexure 1)**

3.2.4 The candidate must have fulfilled all the eligibility criteria mentioned in the UAUC-UG-2026-27 Information Brochure and qualified NEET-2026 examination that is **“In order to be eligible for admission for a particular academic year it shall be necessary for UR/EWS candidate to obtain minimum of marks at 50th percentile in NEET for the said academic year. However, in respect of candidates belonging to Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes, Other Backward Castes, the minimum marks shall be at 40th percentile. In respect of the candidates with bench marked disabilities specified under the Rights of persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile for UR/EWS-PwBD (Persons with benchmark Disability) category candidates and 40th percentile for SC-PwBD / ST-PwBD / OBC-PwBD candidates. The percentile shall be determined based on highest marks secured in the All-India Common Merit list in NEET-2026”**

3.2.5 Reservation for allotment of AIQ-UG seats in Private ASU&H institutes – All AIQ-UG seats of Private ASU&H Institutes are open in nature (all category candidates are eligible). However, as mentioned in relevant regulations, **relaxation in qualifying criteria may be provided category-wise.**

Note: For OBC-NCL candidates, Central OBC certificate is mandatory.

3.3 Counseling will be done based on merit in NEET-2026 as per following percentile.

Category	Percentile in NEET-2026
UR	50 th percentile (213 marks and above)
EWS	50 th percentile (213 marks and above)
UR/EWS –PwBD	45 th percentile (194 marks and above)
OBC	40 th percentile (177 marks and above)
SC	40 th percentile (177 marks and above)
ST	40 th percentile (177 marks and above)
SC/OBC - PwBD	40 th percentile (177 marks and above)
ST - PwBD	40 th percentile (178 marks and above)

3.4 Age Limit: -

3.4.1 No candidate will be admitted to BAMS, BUMS and BHMS Degree courses unless he/she has attained the age of seventeen years on or before the 31st of December of the year of his/her admission in the first year of the course. Further, there is no upper age limit for admission to ASU&H-UG courses.

4. RESERVATION POLICIES

4.1 Reservation policy will be applicable **college wise** on all seats of **state quota** as per the prevailing rules of Government of Uttarakhand, applicable at the time of counseling. **(Government order No. 124/xxx (2)/2020-53(01)/2001 dated 22 May 2020) NO RESERVATION applicable for All India Quota seats for Affiliated Private Colleges.**

4.2 Regarding reservation, Government Orders issued from time to time, by the Government of Uttarakhand will be applicable for reservation and the certificate issued by the competent authority of Uttarakhand Government will only be valid.

4.3 Candidates who are domicile/permanent resident of Uttarakhand will be entitled for the benefit of any type of reservation, only if they produce the specific category certificate issued by the competent authority of the State of Uttarakhand.

4.4 Vertical Reservation:

4.4.1 For State Quota Seats **Vertical Reservation will be applicable in respective category of vertical reservation as per Annexure 01 of GO No. 124/xxx (2)/2020-53(01)/2001 dated 22 May 2020**

4.4.2 OBC-NCL Candidates are advised to check his/her OBC-NCL certificate validity carefully, because the OBC certificate is valid for **three years** duration only. (The OBC-NCL certificate should be valid up to 30.11.2026 or last date of admission whichever is later) Claiming candidate for reservation with invalid OBC-NCL certificate will be summarily rejected for OBC-NCL quota during that particular round of counseling and he/she will be considered UR candidate. However, he/she can freshly re-apply as OBC-NCL candidate with valid document for next rounds of counseling.

Note: Candidates belonging to Creamy layer of OBC are not entitled to reservation, such candidates are treated as belonging to General (GEN) i.e., Unreserved category. (Except prevailing creamy layer criteria as prescribed by the state government)

4.4.3 EWS-Candidate must produce EWS certificate issued by competent authority of the Govt. The EWS certificate should be valid for the financial year 2026-27 (i.e. certificate should be issued on or after 01.04.2026). The Candidate producing invalid EWS certificate will be summarily rejected for EWS quota during that particular round of counseling, and he/she will be considered as UR candidate. However, he/she can freshly re-apply as EWS candidate with valid documents for next rounds of counseling.

4.4.4 Candidate who belongs to Scheduled Castes / Scheduled Tribes / Other Backward Classes / EWS of Uttarakhand must produce caste certificate and Uttarakhand State domicile/permanent resident certificate issued by the competent authority of the State Government. The original certificate must be produced at the time of admission. If a candidate fails to produce the original caste certificate and domicile/permanent resident certificate of Uttarakhand he/she will not be eligible for the benefit of reservation. The candidate shall be responsible for the same. In that case the candidate will be treated as Unreserved (UR) candidate only if he/she fulfills all other eligibility criteria to be considered as UR category candidate. In case of non-availability of reserve candidates in their respective categories, conversion of seats may be done as per **Govt. of Uttarakhand rules and guidelines**.

4.5 Horizontal Reservation (in each vertical category):

4.5.1 **Horizontal Reservation (for Women, Ex-Servicemen/Dependent of Ex-Servicemen, PwBD, Dependent of FF, Orphan) will be applicable in respective category of vertical reservation as per GO No. 124/xxx(2)/2020-53(01)/2001 dated 22/May/2020.** (Candidates falling under these categories will have to produce valid certificates from the competent authorities.)

4.5.2 If a candidate is eligible for more than one subcategory reservation then seat allotment will be done in decreasing percentage of subcategories.

4.5.3 For availing the Women's quota, it is important for a female candidate to select "YES" against Women tab on the portal. If the "YES" option is not selected, the applicant will not be considered under the Women's quota.

4.5.4 For 'Ex-Servicemen/Dependent of Ex-Servicemen' candidates, the certificate issued by the competent authority for this purpose will be valid. (Army/Navy/Air force). (Candidates are advised to upload/produce the certificate in a prescribed format mentioned in **annexure -2**).

Note:

- Dependent of Ex-servicemen of paramilitary forces are not eligible for this reservation
- Dependent Children of Ex-serviceman-

Sons - Up to the attainment of age 25 years or on ceasing to be dependent whichever is earlier or unemployed due to disabled lifetime.

Daughters - Till married or unemployed due to disability lifetime.

4.5.5 **Reservation for persons with benchmark disabilities (PwBD) Candidates** - For candidate/ person with benchmark disability (PwBD) and who are domicile of Uttarakhand, 4% seats of the annual sanctioned state quota (college wise) shall be reserved (horizontal reservation). **Candidates must have to produce the valid certificate from competent authority.**

4.5.6 In case eligible differently abled candidates are not available in its category then the vacant seat shall be filled by UR- PwBD candidate in the order of merit as per the provision given in **Government of Uttarakhand rules and guidelines**.

4.5.7 Reservation for Dependent of FF Candidates – The reservation under this category will be provided as per the prevailing rules of Govt. of Uttarakhand. **Candidates must have to produce the valid certificate from competent authorities.**

4.5.8 Reservation for Orphan Candidates – The reservation for orphan will be applicable only for orphans residing in voluntary/State orphanages operating in the State of Uttarakhand. **Candidates must have to produce the valid certificate from competent authorities.**

4.5.9 Reservation policy for Wards of Kashmiri Migrants (WKM) - Online Applications are invited from the wards of Kashmiri Migrant Candidates, who have qualified in NEET-2026, for admission to 01 reserved seat in each Government AYUSH College of Uttarakhand. The interested candidate should upload the following self-attested certificates/documents **apart** from the documents mentioned in Para 7.4.11 of this Information Brochure:

- a) Certificate of registration as Kashmiri Migrant issued by the Relief Commissioner, Jammu or competent authority of Uttarakhand to establish the status of the applicant as registered migrant.
- b) Proof of **current residence** (such as Ration Card/Photo Identity Card issued by the election Commissioner /driving license/ Aadhar card/ passport etc.)
 - The above two documents must be uploaded for verification at the time of registration.

Note: -

1. **Domicile of Uttarakhand is not mandatory to get the benefit of WKM reserved seats.**
2. **In case eligible WKM candidates are not available then the vacant seats will be filled by general category (UR) candidates in third/mop-up round of counseling.**
3. **The WKM candidates, who otherwise don't fulfill the eligibility criteria for State Quota Seat, will only be eligible for State Quota Seats reserved for Wards of Kashmiri Migrant and All India quota seats.**
4. **The admission shall be made based on merit in the NEET (UG)-2026 qualifying examination.**

4.6 Conversion Policy

4.6.1 If category/subcategory seats of “State Quota” remain vacant due to non-availability of eligible candidates of their respective categories/subcategories, then these vacant seats may be converted in the Round 3rd/Mop-up round of counseling as per the prevailing rules of Govt. of Uttarakhand applicable at the time of counseling.

4.6.2 The seats (if any) not filled-up in the Central Counseling (AYUSH Admission Central Counseling Committee – AACCC) 2026, will be transferred in UAUC U.G. 2026-27 counseling at any stage of the UAUC U.G. 2026-27 counseling, as per norms.

5.COUNSELLING REGISTRATION FEE

5.1 Online counseling one time registration Fee is Rs- 2,000/- for round 1 and round 2 for all categories, but registration fee for fresh registration (for fresh candidate) in Round 2 is Rs. 2000/-. To Participate in IIIrd / Mop-up Round registration of Rs-2000/- is required for all candidates of all categories.

5.2 Counseling registration fee shall neither be refunded nor carried forwarded, if the application for UAUC-UG-2026-27 Centralized counseling is rejected/candidature is found to be ineligible. Hence candidates are advised to read the eligibility criteria carefully before applying. Only eligible candidates will be considered for counseling/admission.

5.3 For all the rounds of Counseling, registration fee as described above will have to be paid online through Net Banking, Credit or Debit card only. No cheque or draft will be accepted.

NOTE - Only the institution permitted (for the year 2026-27) by NCISM / AYUSH Ministry, Govt. of India has been allowed to participate in the Counseling for a particular round. The seat distribution of the colleges will be subjected to the permission granted.

6.2 Total Number of Seats may increase or decrease as per the Recognition/ permission by Govt. of UK/ NCISM/ CCH/AYUSH Ministry, Govt. of India at the time of Seat allotment of a particular round.

6.3 Vacancy of seats will be displayed on the website – www.uau.ac.in before the commencement of each round.

7. COUNSELLING PROCEDURE

7.1 All NEET (UG)-2026 qualified eligible candidates interested to participate in counseling against UG State/All India quota seats are required to register themselves for counseling (see 5.1). **Candidates who fail to register in 1st round of counseling can participate in 2nd and 3rd/Mop-Up round of counseling after registration and payment of required fee.**

7.2 Only registered candidates will be allowed for that particular round of counseling.

7.3 The candidate is compulsorily required to furnish **NEET 2026 examination Roll Number, NEET application number, valid mobile number and other required information**, in order to register for counseling.

7.4 The general instructions for eligible candidates:

7.4.1 Registration facility is available for each round of counseling as notified in counseling schedule. To become eligible to participate in any particular round of counseling, candidates have to register / upgrade themselves and fill their choices for that particular round of counseling. **(Note: Spot registration will not be entertained in any case)**

7.4.2 If a candidate has not registered/upgraded himself for a particular round of counseling, he/she will not be considered for seat allotment for that particular round of counseling.

7.4.3 If candidate has been allotted a seat in 1st Round and if candidate does not report/join the allotted college, he will be eligible to participate in second round, but he/she will not be able to claim his/her allotted seat of the previous round.

7.4.4 If a candidate has been admitted on a seat in 2nd round of counseling and in case the candidate wants to resign/surrender the seat he/she has to compulsorily apply through respective college Principal to the Registrar, UAU, Dehradun and has to report to the counselling board in-person before the registration of 3rd Round/ Mop-up round. Further He/she will not claim for the seat resigned/surrendered.

7.4.5 Candidates who have been allotted seat in round I of counseling can opt for seat up-gradation in round II of counseling only.

7.4.6 If a candidate has upgraded in round-II the seat allotted in round-I gets automatically cancelled and allotted to next eligible candidate in merit. Candidates are advised to select choices carefully.

7.4.7 Candidates must fill new/fresh choices in each round of counseling to become eligible for seat allotment in that particular round.

7.4.8 Candidate can give as many choices as he/she wishes during online choice filling. However, choices should be in order of candidate's preference & eligibility.

7.4.9 **Candidates are advised to select the choices very carefully. If candidate is not interested in any specific Quota/College/Course, it is advised not to opt for that specific Quota/College/Course seat in choice filling process as allotment once done will not be altered. University / Counseling Board will not be responsible for any mistake done at the part of the candidate.**

7.4.10 Candidate has to fill up the fresh choices/quota for each subsequent rounds of counseling separately irrespective of previous choices/quota.

7.4.11 Candidates are required to produce following self-attested documents at the time of admission in respective colleges along with the original documents for verification.

- ✓ Colored passport size photographs (five)
- ✓ High School (10th) Marksheet and Certificate for Age proof.
- ✓ Intermediate (10+2) Certificate.
- ✓ Intermediate (10+2) Marksheet.
- ✓ NEET 2026 Admit Card
- ✓ NEET 2026 Result/Rank letter
- ✓ Certificate of Reserve category, if applicable (SC, ST, OBC-NCL, EWS)
- ✓ Certificate of Sub-Category, if applicable. (for Domicile/Permanent resident of Uttarakhand only)
- ✓ Ex-Servicemen/Dependent of Ex-servicemen /Dependent of FF/ PwBD / Orphan category certificate issued by competent authority of Uttarakhand state only, if applicable.
- ✓ Certificates required for Ward of Kashmiri Migrants, if applicable.
- ✓ Domicile Certificate (For Uttarakhand domicile candidate only)
- ✓ Valid ID proof (preferably Aadhar Card/Passport/Driving License etc.)
- ✓ Character Certificate (by last institute attended).
- ✓ Migration Certificate (original)
- ✓ Leaving certificate or Transfer certificate (original)
- ✓ Affidavit of Gap (if applicable)
- ✓ Allotment letter of UAUC U.G. 2026-27
- ✓ Other documents as per the requirement of the college concerned (e.g. Notarized affidavit and Online Anti-Ragging Undertaking at Anti-Ragging portal of UGC, Medical Fitness Certificate etc.)
- ✓ Other supporting document as desired by candidate.

7.5 UAUC UG-2026-27 Uttarakhand Ayurved University Centralized counseling will be carried out in the following rounds.

7.5.1 First Round: -

- Candidates must register online (including payment of required registration) themselves and fill choices as per their preference & eligibility to become eligible for first round of counseling.
- **Candidates must keep a print copy of the online choice filled form for future reference.**
- The College allotment letter will be available online along with necessary instructions on the University website only. The printout of this allotment letter will have to be produced by the candidate at the time of admission to the college allotted. No extension of last date of admission will be permitted.
- **Candidates who are allotted the seats will have to secure admission in the AYUSH colleges concerned on or before the last date of admission of that particular round otherwise admission stands cancelled automatically.**
- Candidates allotted/admitted to the institution/college in the first round of counseling can exercise option to participate in second round of counseling for up-gradation. Round 1 candidate can upgrade from their allotted seat, if he/she is not satisfied. He/she can still participate in Round 2.
- **Candidate can generate his/her allotment letter only after deposition of security fee (Rs. 25000 for U.G) which would be refundable after last round of counseling, once the candidate has taken admission.**
- **The security fee (Rs.25000) will be forfeited if a candidate does not join the allotted seat of Round-1 or surrender/withdraw the seat allotted in Round-1. Further, the security fee will also be forfeited if the allotted seat of Round-1 is cancelled due to any unforeseen reason from the candidate's end. For example, the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration based on which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting or fails to produce the required documents at the time of admission. However, if the admitted candidate opts for upgradation in Round 2, the same Security fee will carry forwarded.**

- **Candidates who have taken admission against the allotted seats will be permitted for course/college/quota up-gradation up to second round of counseling only.**
- The registered candidate who does not get allotment to any College may participate in the next round of counseling.

7.5.2 Second Round: -

- The following group of candidates are eligible for 2nd Round of allotment: -
 - Group-I : Registered candidates who did not get any seat allotment in the 1st round.**
 - Group-II : Candidates who have reported/joined at allotted institute during 1st round of allotment and wants to participate for second roundup-gradation.**
 - Group-III : Candidates who have been allotted a seat but have not joined.**
 - Group-IV : Candidates who are registering for the first time.**
- New/Fresh Candidates have to online register (including payment of required registration) themselves and fill choices as per their preference & eligibility to become eligible for second round of counseling. However **already registered Candidates & candidates opting for up gradation have to opt for upgradation without payment of registration fee.**
- **Candidates who have admitted against round I or II allotted seat and want to Resign/Surrender the Seat he/she has applied through college principal to Registrar, UAU, Dehradun before Mop-Up Round of the Counseling. Candidate will not claim for the seat once resigned/surrendered.**
- **Candidates who are allotted seats will have to secure admission in the AYUSH College concerned on or before the last date of admission of that particular round otherwise admission stands cancelled automatically.**
- **Candidate can generate his/her allotment letter only after deposition of security fee (Rs. 25000 for U.G) which would be refundable after last round of counseling, once the candidate has taken admission.**
- **The security fee will be forfeited if a candidate does not join the allotted seat of Round-2 or surrender/withdraw the seat allotted in Round-2. Further, the security fee will also be forfeited if the allotted seat of Round-2 is cancelled due to any unforeseen reason from the candidate's end. For example, the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration on the basis of which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting or fails to produce the required documents at the time of admission.**

7.5.3 IIIrd / Mop Up Round: -

- The following categories of candidates are eligible for IIIrd / Mop-up Round: -
 - Candidates who are registering for the first time.
 - Candidates who have registered but not allotted seat in Round I & Round II.
 - All candidates except those who have taken admission in Round I or Round II.
 - Candidates who have resigned/surrendered his/her allotted seats after admission in a college/campus and applied for the same through college principal to Registrar, UAU.
- Candidates must online register themselves to become eligible to IIIrd / Mop -UP Round Counseling.
- Eligible candidates will have to present him/her in front of counseling board at the designated counseling venue as per schedule date and time, for seat allotment along with required original document. No TA or any other allowances will be given to him/her.
- **Candidate can generate his/her allotment letter only after deposition of security fee (Rs. 25000 for U.G) which would be refundable after last round of counseling, once the candidate has taken admission. (Note: It is strictly advised to pay security money through candidates own account or their parent's account. Security fee will be refunded (after issue of enrollment number) to the same account from which it was debited)**
- **Round-1/Round-2 admitted candidates can withdraw/surrender their admitted seat with forfeiture of security fee before the commencement of registration of IIIrd / Mop-up round. After the said period, candidates will not be allowed to withdraw/surrender their admitted seat of Round-2. If they do so, they will be ineligible for any further AYUSH counseling.**
- **The security fee will be forfeited if a candidate does not join the allotted seat of IIIrd / Mop-up**

round or surrender/withdraw the seat allotted in Mop-up round. Further, the security fee will also be forfeited if the allotted seat of IIIrd / Mop-up round is cancelled due to any unforeseen reason from the candidate's end. For example, the candidate gives wrong information at the time of registration based on which a seat may be allotted and later cancelled by the Admission Authorities at the time of reporting or fails to produce the required documents at the time of admission.

NOTE: University can conduct stray vacancy round if any seats remain vacant even after the IIIrd / mop-up round. (The admissions are subjected to the final decision of Counseling Board).

Round specific additional instructions will be displayed separately on university website Candidates are advised to visit the University website regularly for updates regarding counseling. No personal intimation will be sent.

NOTE: While filling in the online counselling form, candidates are advised to fill in the details and upload relevant documents correctly and carefully, as once the form is submitted, it will be considered as final and no change will be entertained thereafter for that particular round.

8. ADMISSION PROCEDURE

8.1 Candidates should report personally to the allotted college office for deposition of fee to complete admission process.

8.2 The candidate should report personally to the allotted college along with the mentioned in point 7.4.11 for completion of further admission process within the specified period

8.3 After completing the above-mentioned formalities/procedure, the admission process will only be completed once the candidate gets the admission letter issued by the concerned college within the specified time period mentioned in the allotment letter. Hence, the candidates are required to make necessary arrangements from his/her side well in time to complete the whole admission process within the specified time period of that particular round.

NOTE: Seat allotment and admission will be purely provisional. Provisionally allotted seats (in all Government and private colleges) will be cancelled at any time in-between or even after admission if student's documents supporting their allotted seat found not original/ forged. Strict legal action will be taken against them. Enrollment will only be done after verification of certificates/ documents submitted.

9. FEE & FEE REFUND POLICY

9.1 The fees structure of State Quota and All India Quota will be same.

9.2 Fees details about University Campuses will be notified separately on the University website.

9.3 FOR UNIVERSITY CAMPUS COLLEGES (MAIN CAMPUS, RISHIKUL CAMPUS AND GURUKUL CAMPUS)

9.3.1 If a candidate wants to quit the college allotted to him in the First round he/ she has to inform the Registrar, Uttarakhand Ayurved University through the Principal of the concerned college before **the date of registration of second round** that he/she is vacating the seat allotted to him/her in the counseling & then only he/she will be entitled to get refund of the fees deposited by him/her after deduction of Rs. 5000/- only (as administrative charges). In addition, charges for the services availed (e.g. Hostel, mess etc) by the candidate will also be deducted from the fees deposited, on actual consumption/rational basis, by the college administration

9.3.2 If a candidate wants to quit the college allotted to him/her in the Second round he/she has to inform the Registrar, Uttarakhand Ayurved University through the Principal of the concerned college **before the date of registration of Third/Mop-Up Round** that he/she is vacating the seat allotted to him/her in the counseling & then only he/she will be entitled to get refund of the fees deposited by him/her after deduction of Rs. 5000/- only (as administrative charges). In addition, charges for the services availed (e.g. Hostel, mess etc.) by the candidate will also be deducted from the fees deposited, on actual consumption/rational basis, by the college administration

9.3.3 **If Candidate leaves the College allotted to him after the last round of counseling, fees will be refunded back to him with following Terms & Condition: - (For govt. Campuses Only)**

- If the Candidate informs through Campus Director/Principal to the Registrar, UAU, Dehradun within 01 to 07 days after taking admission Rs. 25000/- will be deducted except security money.
- If the Candidate inform through Campus Director/Principal to the Registrar, UAU, Dehradun within 08 to 15 days after taking admission 50% of total fees deposited will be deducted except security money.
- If the Candidate informs through Campus Director/Principal to the Registrar, UAU, Dehradun within 16 to 30 days after taking admission 75% of total fees deposited will be deducted except security money.
- If the Candidate inform through Campus Director/Principal to the Registrar, UAU, Dehradun after 30 days after taking admission the total fees deposited by the candidate will be forfeited except security money.
- After one Month the fees deposited by the candidate (except security Money) will be forfeited if the candidate surrenders the seat before the completion of the first prof. of that batch.

For Private Colleges

- Fees details will be uploaded separately on university website.

10. JURISDICTION

10.1 Any dispute concerning “UAUC-UG-2026-27 Uttarakhand Ayurved University Centralized Counseling” would be subject to exclusive jurisdiction of the competent Hon’ble Courts within the territorial jurisdiction of Uttarakhand only.

11. DISCLAIMER

11.1 In case of incorrect information detected at any stage of the selection process, the candidate will automatically disqualify from the selection process and he/she will not be allowed to appear for UAUC UG counseling in future in the Uttarakhand Ayurved University, Dehradun. If such instances go undetected during the current selection process but are detected in subsequent years or later on; such disqualification will take place with retrospective effect and the Principal/Dean/Director of the concerned college/institute shall have the authority to cancel the admission of the candidate and to proceed for legal action against him/her and all the information/documents furnished by the candidate will be scrutinized/verified by competent authorities further.

11.2 The statement made in information brochure and all information contained herein is believed to be correct at the time of publication/uploading in the website. However, the Uttarakhand Ayurved University reserves the right to make any change without notice, changes and additions to the regulations, conditions governing the admission procedure, conduct of students, requirements for degree, fees and any other information, or statements contained in this information bulletin at any time. Homoeopathy (ASU&H) Streams for the Academic Session 2026-27**

A. DIRECTIVES FOR COUNSELING AUTHORITIES (STATE /UT)

I. Common directives for State/UT Counseling and Admissions:

Eligibility Criteria to Participate in the Counseling:

1. Colleges/Institute who have received permission from the Medical Assessment and Rating Board/National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (NCISM) for Ayurveda, Siddha and Unani streams or the Medical Assessment and Rating Board/National Commission for Homoeopathy (NCH) for admission to ASU&H- UG courses for the academic session 2026-27 shall only be eligible to participate in the counseling process.

Seat Matrix (AIQ & State / UT Quota):

2. The seat matrix for admission in the State/UT Government/Government-aided institutions and Private Institutions shall be fifteen per cent (15%) for All-India Quota and eighty-five per cent (85%) for State/Union Territory Quota as specified in the NCISM and NCH Regulations in force at the time of admission. (Please refer to Sl.No:14 of this guideline).

Provided that-

- i. the AIQ for the purpose of admission in all the Deemed Universities (both Government and Private - established under Central Act), shall be hundred per cent;
 - ii. the University and institute, which are already having more than fifteen per cent All-India Quota seats, shall continue to maintain that quota;
 - iii. Five per cent. of the annual sanctioned intake capacity in Government and Government-aided institutions shall be filled up by candidate with specified disability in accordance with the provisions of the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016) and based on the merit list of NEET(UG)-2026.
3. For State/UT quota (85%), the seat matrix for Government, Management, NRI quota etc., shall be as per respective State/UT policy; however, all admissions (except foreign nationals) shall be through counseling conducted by State/UT counseling authority.
 4. The Management seats under the State/UT Quota in Private Institutions shall be treated as domicile-free.

Reservation:

5. Category-wise reservation of seats shall be as per Central or State or UT Reservation Policy, as the case may be.
6. Reservation for allotment of 15% AIQ-UG seats in Private ASU&H Institutes:-All AIQ-UG seats of Private ASU & H Institutes are open in nature (all category candidates are eligible).

However, as mentioned in relevant regulations, the relaxation in qualifying criteria may be provided category-wise.

Counseling schedule:

7.State/UT counseling authorities shall follow the counseling schedule for the A.Y. 2026-27 as specified by NCISM/NCH for seamless admission process as given below:

As per National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (National Examinations for Indian System of Medicine) Regulations, 2023 and National Commission for Homoeopathy Examination Regulations 2023.

***A penalty of ₹1,00,000 (Rupees One Lakh) per day shall be levied by the NCISM/NCH on colleges/institutes for failure to submit the admission data within 30th November, 2026 (On or Before 6 PM).**

- ❖ It has been observed in past academic year that the schedule of State/UT Ayush Counseling is delayed as a result of which candidate find difficulties in making choice of college for admission/ becoming ineligible for Ayush Counseling/forfeiture of Security money thus inviting multiple grievances and litigations. In order to avoid it State/UT-Counseling authority/University need to begin their State/UT Ayush Counseling as per schedule specified.
- ❖ State/UT Ayush Counseling authority shall provide the data of vacant seat on the last day of reporting of every round to Central Govt. (AACCC, NCISM) to take analytical/calculative decision regarding counseling.

Counseling and Admissions:

8. All sanctioned/permitted seats by the Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Indian System of Medicine (MARBISM)/NCISM/Medical Assessment and Rating Board for Homoeopathy (MARBH)/NCH, irrespective of categories/reservations, are to be filled only through online counseling, i.e., Central/State/UT counseling as the case may be (except foreign nationals).
9. Ayush Admissions Central Counseling Committee (AACCC), NCISM will conduct "AIQ-UG Online Counseling" for admission to AIQ (15%) seats under State Govt. /Govt. Aided Colleges/Institutes, Central/Deemed Universities (Established under Central Act) and National Institutes of ASU&H streams.
10. The State/UT Counseling authorities shall conduct counseling for admission in 15% of AIQ-UG seats under Private ASU&H colleges/institutes/State Universities (other than Deemed Universities established under the Central Act). Further, State/UT Counseling shall be conducted in adherence to guidelines/schedule provided by NCISM/NCH to avoid the overlapping of the Schedule of AACCC counseling and State/UT counseling.
11. For State/UT Quota (85%), the seat matrix for Government, Management, NRI Quota etc., shall be as per respective State and UT policy; however, all admissions in all quotas (except foreign nationals) shall be through online counseling conducted by State/UT counseling authority.
12. Seat allotment in any category shall be as per inter-se-merit.
13. No candidate who has failed to obtain the minimum eligibility marks in NEET (UG)-2026 shall be eligible for admission to Undergraduate courses for the academic year 2026-27.
14. Qualification Criterion:(As per the ASU &H-UG Regulations in force at the time of admission)
 - (a) *National Commission for Indian System of Medicine(Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Ayurveda Education) Regulations-2022*
 - (b) *National Commission for Indian System of Medicine (Minimum Standards of Undergraduate Unani Education) Regulations-2022*
 - (c) *National Commission for Indian System of Medicine(Minimum Standards of*

Undergraduate Siddha Education) Regulations-2022

- (d) National Commission for Homeopathy (Homeopathy Graduate Degree Course- Bachelor Homeopathic Medicine and Surgery (B.H.M.S) Regulations-2022*
- (e) The National Commission for Homoeopathy (Homoeopathy Graduate Degree Course – Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery (B.H.M.S.) Amendment Regulations 2025*
- (f) NCISM's BOA letter dated 19.08.2026*
- (g) NCISM's BUSS (Unani-U.G.Reg) letter dated*
- (h) NCISM's BUSS (SID-UG-MSE) letter dated*

For admission to ASU & H-UG Courses:

15. The eligibility to admission in ASU&H-UG courses should be as per the ASU&H-UG regulations and should be followed strictly. The details of qualifications for different categories are as follows:

- For ASU&H- UG Courses - the candidate shall have passed 10 +2 (or equivalent) with subjects of Physics, Chemistry, Biology or Biotechnology

16. No candidate shall be admitted to BAMS, BSMS, BUMS & BHMS Degree Courses unless he/she has attained the age of seventeen years on or before the 31st December of the year of his/her admission in the first year of the course. Further, there is no upper age limit for admission to ASU&H-UG courses.

17. In order to be eligible for admission to an undergraduate course for an academic year, it shall be necessary for a candidate to obtain minimum of marks at the 50th percentile in the 'National Eligibility cum Entrance Test' for the undergraduate course' held for the said academic year:

Provided that in respect of -

- (a) candidates belonging to the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes, the minimum marks shall be at the 40th percentile;
- (b) candidates with benchmark disabilities specified under the Rights of Persons with Disabilities Act, 2016 (49 of 2016), the minimum marks shall be at 45th percentile in the case of the General category and 40th percentile in the case of the Scheduled Castes, Scheduled Tribes and Other Backward Classes.

18. No Authority or Institution shall admit any candidate to the Undergraduate courses in contravention of the criteria or procedure laid down in respect of admissions, and any admissions made in contravention shall be cancelled by the NCISM/NCH.

19. Any admissions made beyond/over and above the intake capacity sanctioned/permitted by MARBISM/NCISM/MARBH/NCH for the said academic session shall not be approved.

20. Vide Court order dated 30.11.2023 in SCA No. 19485/2023 at High Court of Gujarat, the Court has observed that the authority has not provided any guidelines to fill the seats that remain vacant after the Stray Vacancy Round (SVR). To comply with the direction of the court, it is requested to all Central/State/UT counseling Authorities to conduct sufficient phase- wise allotments in stray vacancy round to fill the seats, considering the number of available candidates in the Central/State/UT merit list, whichever is applicable, and availability of vacant seats till the seats get filled within the cut-off date of admission as notified by the NCISM/NCH. The guidelines for State/UT counseling Authorities to conduct the SVR are as follows:

- a) Publication of non-reported /not-filled seats after R-3 on the State/UT counseling portal (wide publicity by any other means may also be adopted)
- b) Publication of ineligible list of candidates who have not complied with the

Central/State/UT counseling rules/norms

- c) Registration facility for non-registered candidates on the State/UT counseling portal
 - d) Choice filling facility, as applicable.
 - e) Allotment of seats is based on the merit and preferences of the candidates.
 - f) Publication of result on the State/UT counseling portal
 - g) Reporting at the allotted institute
21. After the first phase of allotment in SVR, publish the non-reported/not-filled seats on the State/UT counseling portal and conduct subsequent rounds to fill the vacant seats, if any, as per the procedure mentioned in the first phase allotment considering the availability of candidates. Eligible non-registered candidates shall be provided the registration facility for all rounds of SVR; however, the whole process of SVR allotment be completed within the time frame, and no admission after the cut-off date decided by NCISM/NCH shall be allowed/approved. The schedule for the last round of SVR shall be conducted in such a way that the allotted candidates will get sufficient time to report to the allotted institute before the cut-off date of admission decided by NCISM/NCH.
22. It has been observed in past few years, that different Hon'ble Courts use to grant relief to the candidates taking offline admission just before cut-off date of admission on the ground of technical glitch in State/UT-Ayush Counseling portal. Therefore, State/UT-Ayush Counseling Authorities portal must be technically sound for seamless online counseling and admissions of eligible candidates, till the process of admissions last.
23. **There shall not be any institute-level counseling through any mode. Any admissions made at the institute level shall not be approved by the NCISM/NCH/Concerned University, and the institute shall be penalized as per the provision laid down under sub-section (1)(a)(f) of section 28 of the NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act 2020.**
24. There shall not be any offline admission or admission without counseling (Central/State/UT), and any admissions in contravention of this shall not be approved.
25. Admission made in violation of the NCISM / NCH directives will be treated as invalid, and action will be initiated under the NCISM Act, 2020 / NCH Act, 2020.
26. Institutes will be held responsible in case students face hardship due to admission irregularities such as offline admissions, admission without counseling, and admission beyond sanctioned intake capacity. In such case, students shall be discharged from the course and institution, and the institute will be subjected to face consequences as per the provision laid down under the sub-section (1) (a) (f) of section 28 of NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act 2020, and the person responsible will be prosecuted as per the section of IPC/BNS concerned, whichever is applicable.
27. **Admissions shall not be approved by any means after the cut-off date and time for admission as specified by NCISM/NCH.**
28. No authority has the power to extend or modify the cut-off date of admission specified by NCISM/NCH, and such admissions shall not be approved.
29. No authority has the power to modify the intake capacity for admission into UG courses in ASU&H colleges sanctioned by MARBISM/NCISM/MARBH/NCH.
30. State/UT Counseling Authorities may direct ASU&H colleges/institutes to ensure the eligibility of the candidate as laid down in respective NCISM (MSE-UG) Regulations 2022 and NCISM letter ref NCISM's letter no. BOA/2-B/UG/2026,11-76/2021-BUSS(Unani-U.G. Regl.), NCISM's letter no.18-12/2021-BUSS(SID-UG-MSE) dated 20.08.2026 for Ayurveda, Siddha & Unani for admissions in ASU-UG courses and NCH (Homoeopathy Graduate Degree Course – Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery (B.H.M.S). Regulations- 2022 and The National Commission for Homoeopathy (Homoeopathy Graduate Degree Course – Bachelor of Homoeopathic Medicine and Surgery (B.H.M.S.)

Amendment Regulations 2025 for admissions in Homoeopathy-UG courses by proper scrutiny of the relevant original certificates and documents at the time of admission.

31. AACCC will circulate the list of ineligible candidates to the State/UT counseling Authority during the 3rd & Stray Vacancy Round (SVR-I & II) of AACCC-UG counseling to prevent them from participating in the State/UT counseling. **State/UT Counseling Authorities need to ensure that such candidates have not been allotted any seat through any rounds of State/UT counseling for admission in ASU&H-UG courses.**
32. State/UT Counseling Authorities may direct ASU&H colleges/institutes to ensure the authenticity and correctness of the details of admitted students before completing the admission procedures. Further, the ASU&H colleges/institutes should be instructed not to allow admissions without original documents. No modifications/ corrections after the cut-off date and time of admission as specified by NCISM/NCH shall be entertained.
33. The State/UT Counseling authorities have to submit a list of admitted students (i.e. college-wise consolidated list of admitted students through all rounds of counseling) to NCISM/NCH within specified date as mentioned in the schedule from the cut-off date of admission in the format and in the manner as prescribed by NCISM/NCH.
34. All State/UT Counseling Authorities are requested to see the website of AACCC (www.aaccc.gov.in), from time to time for AACCC-UG counseling scheme & FAQs, Schedule, and any updates/notices uploaded regarding the All India Quota-ASU&H-UG counseling for the A.Y 2026-27.
35. The State/ UT counseling for ASU&H-UG Courses shall be started only after Central Counseling has commenced, in accordance with the schedule issued by NCISM/NCH.
36. In past few years, the student helpline center of AACCC, receive lot of grievances from candidates participating in State/UT-Ayush Counseling that is outside the purview of Central Ayush Counseling Authority. Therefore, State/UT Counseling Authority must run an effective Query Redressal System to facilitate the counseling and admission process of UG courses and provide the email ID & Phone no of the same on the State/UT Counseling Authority's website.
37. **State Ayush Admissions Reporting Portal:** All State/UT counseling Authorities are requested to upload the round-wise data on admissions made through State/UT counseling under 85% of State/UT Quota seats of State Govt./Govt. Aided colleges and 100% seats of Private Institutions of Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani and Homoeopathy streams all over the Country on the interphase of the AACCC-UG portal.

Determination of fees and other charges in case of ASU&H colleges/institutes under NCISM/NCH:

38. The fee for 50 percentage (50%) of total sanctioned/permitted seats in Private ASU&H medical colleges/institutes and deemed universities which are governed under the NCISM Act, 2020/NCH Act, 2020, is to be determined by Fee fixation/Regulatory Committee (FRC) of the respective State/UT/Deemed University as per the guidelines for "Determination of fee and all other charges" prescribed by NCISM (BUSS/Fee/ASU/2022-23 dated 16-09-2022), and NCH (F.No 1-11/2022/NCH/10322-10331 dated 23.11.2022) which has been implemented from the A.Y 2022-23 onwards.

Tuition fee:

39. All State/UT Counseling authorities are requested to ensure that the tuition fee, as laid down and fixed by respective governing or fee fixation committees as applicable, shall be charged in each academic session for four and half years only by the institutes. No tuition fee shall be charged for extended study duration in case of failing examinations or for any other reasons, and there shall not be any fee for internship training at the same institute.

40. All Central/State/UT Counseling authorities are requested to ensure that the college should display tuition fees, hostel fees, and other fees, if any, on the institute's website and the Institute profile while uploading to the Central/State/UT counseling Portal. The same is to be charged from the student at the time of admission. No other charges other than the displayed fees should be charged / collected.

II. Directives for State/UT counseling for admission in 15% of AIQ-UG seats under Private ASU&H colleges/institutes/State Universities (other than Deemed Universities established under the Central Act)

1. State/UT Counseling authorities shall conduct counseling for 15% of AIQ-UG seats under Private ASU&H colleges/institutes/State Universities (other than Deemed Universities established under Central Act).
2. State/UT Counseling Authorities have to conduct counseling for admission in 15% of AIQ-UG seats under Private ASU&H colleges/institutes/ State Universities (other than Deemed Universities established under Central Act) in adherence with guidelines/schedule provided by NCISM/NCH to avoid the overlapping of the schedule of AACCC counseling and State or UT counseling.
3. State/UT counseling authorities should give wider publicity among NEET (UG)- 2026 qualified ASU&H-UG aspirants regarding the registration process of counseling & provide sufficient time for registration before each round of counseling for admission in AIQ-UG seats of Private ASU&H Institutes.
4. State/UT may decide on an all-inclusive application Cost/Non-refundable Registration Fee for counseling for admission in ASU&H-UG seats for all category students. However, the maximum ceiling limit for this fee will be Rs **2000/-**.
5. State/UT may decide on refundable security money, which will be refunded to candidates after joining the allotted college or if the candidate does not get any seat during counseling. However, the maximum ceiling limit for this fee will be Rs. **50,000/-** for UG seats.
6. Central Govt. receives multiple grievances on non-refund of Security money to eligible candidates of State/UT-Ayush Counseling. State/UT Ayush Counseling authorities need to refund the collected security amount to the eligible candidates in time bound manner after completion of Counseling.
7. State/UT counseling authorities shall conduct 3 rounds of counseling for admission in 15% of All India Quota (AIQ) UG seats of Private ASU&H Institutes/Private State Universities (other than Deemed Universities established under the Central Act). The AIQ seats that remain vacant after the Third round of State/UT counseling may be transferred and converted to the State/UT quota seats, and the same shall be filled up in further rounds as per State Government norms/ rules.
8. No domicile certificate is required for allotment of AIQ-UG seats of Private ASU &H Institutes.
9. For PwBD candidates, the PwBD certificate should be as per the guidelines issued vide NCISM letter ref 1/2/2026-AACCC dated 20.08.2026/NCH letter ref 1-2/2026-AACCC dated 20.08.2026 (Available on counseling website (www.aaccc.gov.in)).
10. **The admission on any other reserved quota seats in State shall be through Counseling authority designated by Central/State/UT Govt. only. Admissions done through any committee/local body/private organization members shall not be approved by NCISM/NCH.**

B. DIRECTIVES FOR UNIVERSITIES

1. In case of admission in Ayurveda, Siddha, Unani, and Homoeopathy courses, the University shall approve the admissions made by any college/institute with proper permission from the MARBISM/NCISM/MARBH/NCH for the academic session 2026-2026.
2. The University shall not approve the admissions made by the colleges/institutes under the following conditions:
 - Offline admissions
 - Admissions without counseling(Central/State/UT);
 - Admissions after the cut-off-date,
 - Admissions beyond sanctioned intake capacity.
 - Admissions without original mandatory documents
3. There shall not be any institute-level counseling through any mode. Any admissions made at the institute level shall not be approved by the NCISM/NCH/Concerned University and the institute shall be penalized as per the provision laid down under sub-section (1)(a)(f) of section 28 of the NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act 2020.

C. DIRECTIVES FOR COLLEGES/INSTITUTES

1. No candidate who has failed to obtain the minimum eligibility marks in NEET (UG)-2026 shall be admitted to ASU&H Undergraduate courses for the academic year 2026-27.
2. There shall not be any institute-level counseling through any mode. Any admissions made at the institute level shall not be approved by the NCISM/NCH/Concerned University. Any such admissions made in contravention to the directives/guidelines issued by the NCISM/NCH, the institute shall be penalized as per the provision laid down under the sub-section (1)(a)(f) of section 28 of NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act 2020.
3. There shall not be any offline admission or admission without counseling (Central/State/UT), or admission beyond sanctioned intake capacity, and any admissions in contravention of this shall not be approved.
4. Admission made in violation of the NCISM/NCH directives will be treated as invalid, and action will be initiated under the NCISM Act, 2020/NCH Act, 2020.
5. Institutes will be held responsible in case students face hardship due to admission irregularities such as offline admissions, admission without counseling, and admission beyond sanctioned intake capacity etc. In such cases, students shall be discharged from the course and institution. The institute will be subjected to face consequences as per the provision laid down under sub-section (1) (a) (f) of section 28 of NCISM Act 2020/NCH Act 2020. The persons responsible will be prosecuted as per the section of IPC/BNS concerned, whichever is applicable.
6. ASU&H colleges/institutes should ensure the candidate's eligibility as laid down in respective regulations as mentioned in these guidelines and proper scrutiny of the relevant original certificates and documents at the time of admission.
7. It is requested that all participating institutes must visit Central (AACCC-UG portal : www.aaccc.gov.in), and the concerned State/UT counseling portal from time to time for counseling scheme & FAQs, Schedule and any updates/notices regarding UG counseling 2026-27.
8. ASU&H colleges/institutes should ensure the authenticity and correctness of the details of admitted students before completing admission procedures. No modifications/ corrections after the cut-off date and time of admission as specified by NCISM/NCH shall be entertained.
9. The colleges should follow the Central/State/UT counseling schedule and upload the details of admitted students and non-reported/vacant seats, if any, for each round on the concerned counseling authority portal, even on holidays.
10. The list of all admitted students with all details shall be uploaded and submitted to NCISM/NCH in the format prescribed by NCISM/NCH **on or before 06:00 PM on the cut-off date** (30th November, 2026) for admission as specified by NCISM/NCH.

11. The college shall display tuition fees, hostel fees, and other fees, if any, on the institute's website and on the Institute profile while uploading on the Central/State/UT counseling portal as applicable. The same is to be charged from the student at the time of admission. No other charges other than the displayed fees should be collected from the candidates.

In order to avoid it State/UT-Counseling authority/University need to begin their State/UT Ayush Counseling as per schedule specified.
- ❖ State/UT Ayush Counseling authority shall provide the data of vacant seat on the last day of reporting of every round to Central Govt. (AACCC, NCISM) to take analytical/calculative decision regarding counseling.
