



Learning objective	SWBAT understand the difference between consonants and vowels. SWBAT identify consonants and vowels.

NOTE	Slides have animations. Kindly rehearse before class and read the notes given below for all slides.
Slide 3	Start the class with a breathing exercise. <b>Move to Next Slide.</b>
Slide 4	SAY: Vidya wants to tell Alok a story. Would you like to listen to a story? <b>Note: Wait for children to respond.</b> Call out children randomly and ask, “What is your favorite story?” <b>Note: When the children answer, give them a big round of applause. Excellent!</b>
Slide 5 (Animation)	SAY: How many letters are there in the alphabet? <b>Note: Wait for children to respond.</b> SAY: Let’s listen to Vidya tell the story now. <b>Move to the Next Slide.</b>
Slide 6 (Animation)	SAY: What can you see in the picture? <b>Note: Wait for children to respond. Encourage multiple answers.</b> ASK: What are letters Ww, Uu, Dd and Zz doing? <b>Note: Wait for children to respond.</b> ASK: Which letter is playing on the swing? <b>Note: Wait for children to respond.</b> SAY: Very good! Let’s move on to the story! (click for the story) <b>Move to the Next Slide.</b>



Slide 7 (Animation)	<p>SAY: That picnic looked like fun!</p> <p>SAY: In this picture, which letters have climbed the tree?</p> <p><b>Note: Wait for children to respond.</b></p> <p>SAY: Let's see why only Aa, Ee, Ii, Oo and Uu are on the tree. (click for the story)</p> <p><b>Move to the Next Slide.</b></p>
Slide 8 (Animation)	<p>SAY: What are letters Aa, Ee, Ii, Oo and Uu called?</p> <p><b>Note: Wait for children to respond.</b></p> <p>(click for the story)</p> <p><b>Move to the Next Slide.</b></p>
Slide 9 (Animation)	<p>SAY: What is the letter Dd called?</p> <p><b>Note: Wait for children to respond.</b></p> <p>SAY: Which other letters are consonants?</p> <p><b>Note: Wait for children to respond.</b></p> <p>(click for the story)</p> <p><b>Move to the Next Slide.</b></p>
Slide 10 (Animation)	<p>SAY: Let's recap what we have learnt about vowels. Have students say "AaAa"; "EeEe"; "OoOo"; "UuUu". (click for the recap)</p> <p>SAY: Raise your right hand in a fist. Let's practice the vowels like Vidya and Alok have shown us!</p> <p><b>Note: Let children do this exercise in tandem with the teacher.</b></p> <p><b>Move to the Next Slide.</b></p>
Slide 11 (Animation)	<p>SAY: Let's recap what we have learnt about consonants.</p> <p>(click for the recap)</p> <p>SAY: Let's read the consonants out loud at the count of three.</p> <p><b>Note: Let children do this exercise in tandem with the teacher.</b></p> <p><b>Move to the Next Slide.</b></p>



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Slide 12 Slide 13 Slide 14 Slide 15	Explain Ex.1 on slide 12 and slide 13. SAY: Choose the correct answer. You can do it along with the person sitting next to you. Explain Ex.2 on slide 14. SAY: Look at the example. Now do the rest of the exercise on your own. Explain Ex. 3 on slide 15. SAY: Look at the example. Now do the rest of the exercise on your own. Ex. 4. Explain how the homework exercise must be done.
Slide 16	Practise saying the consonants and vowels. Encourage the children to say it in tandem with the teacher.
