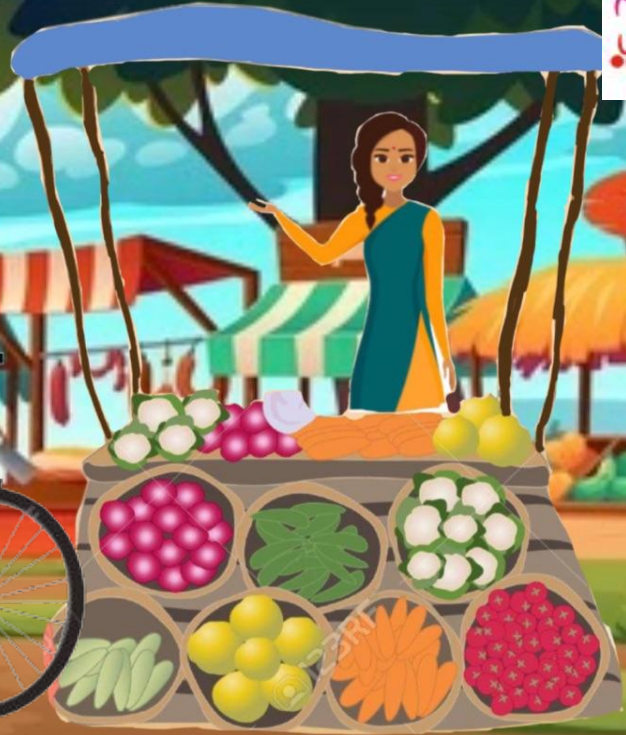
Shopping is Fun
